Thank you for joining in on our mission to improve the health and wellbeing of everyone in our community.

Here's an example of the work our community outreach dental team does: In the 2024-25 school year, they performed screenings in 34 schools, 20 of which get dental services. They conducted a total of 12,427 screenings, 447 cleanings, 504 fluoride treatments and 1,279 sealants.
