How I Learned to Stop Worrying and Love the Deck-out



2 Restands vs 2 Calls

Biggest difference is the NUMBERS. They're big to start and just keep getting bigger.

Where the first 2 hits from Baro's RGs will struggle to hit, Schar's will demand far more than 5k or so. The last 2 RG hits are often big enough to demand 2 sets of 20k with Hope on Damp.



Scharhrot

- 12000 base
- + Protect Gift
- + Reaches 40k guard for Hope on Damp
- + Much higher power on rear guards
- Bad against denial chickens, etc.
- + Less CB reliant due to 1st skill

Baromagnes

- + 13000 base
- + Persona Ride
- + Can call Hope on Damp from soul
- + Non-targeting board removal
- + Crit on VG skill
- Limited RG power
- Does nothing without CB

Other choices/notes:





Exchange soul triggers and sentinels in a balanced way for the deck

> -Shirley +draw PG

-Sentinel crit +D soul crit

More strongly recommended for Baro deck

Flowering March *8

recipe by @dragon8blade

Ingredients:

- · Crushed Ice
- White Tea Leaves
- Herbal Tea Blend of: Marigold, Hibiscus, Rose Hips, Blue Cornflowers, Lemon Grass, Echinacea, and Apple Pieces
- Peach Popping Boba
- Strawberry Popping Boba





Steps:

- 1. Steep white tea at ~85°C for about 3 minutes.
- 2. Steep herbal tea at ~100°C for about 5 minutes.
- 3. Let the teas cool for a bit.
- 4. Add both flavors of popping boba to a tall glass.
- 5. Add crushed ice to the glass.
- 6. Pour the slightly cooled herbal tea into the glass, filling it roughly 3/3 full.
- 7. Pour the white tea to fill the rest of the glass.
- 8. Add sugar or syrup if needed to sweeten to taste.

Black Sky-Shattering Crimson recipe by @alterskyfall

Ingredients:

- · 1.5 oz Vodka
- 1-3 drops Black-food coloring
- Ice
- 0.5 oz Amaretto
- 2 oz Cranberry Juice
- 1/2 tsp Grenadine
- · Several Blackberries
- Several Maraschino Cherries
- Rosemary (for garnish)





Steps:

- 1. Chill serving glass in a fridge or freezer.
- 2. Combine 1.50z of vodka, 0.5 oz of amaretto, and 1-3 drops of black food coloring in a separate glass. Add drops of food coloring 1 by 1 until desired color is reached.

- 3. Add 2oz of cranberry juice and ½ tsp of grenadine to your chilled serving glass. Stir with a spoon to mix.
- 4. Add ice to your chilled serving glass
- 5. Layer the black alcohol mixture in the serving glass using the back of a spoon.
- Garnish with several blackberries and maraschino cherries on a toothpick, and a sprig of rosemary.

Jewel of the Four Flames

Ingredients:

recipe by @alterskyfall

- 8 oz of Rum (Enough for 4 cocktails)
- Butterfly Peaflower
- · Baking Soda
- Sugar
- · 0.5 oz of Simple Syrup
- Edible Pearl Luster dust
- · 0.5 oz of Lemon Juice
- 0.5 oz of Raspberry lemonade
- 0.5 oz of Peach Schnapps
- High proof alcohol, such as 150 proof rum (optional)
- · Pinch of cinnamon

Steps:

- 1. At least 3 hours before, add 1 cup of rum and ~5 butterfly peaflowers in a glass jar. Seal, and leave to infuse at room temperature for 3 hours to overnight.
- 2. Strain the butterfly pea flowers out, and observe color.
 Add a pinch of baking soda to turn the infusion to more of a blue color (from purple). Continue adding baking soda (should only take a couple of pinches) until desired color is obtained.
- 3. Dampen the rim of your serving glass with water or lemonade, and dip it in a plate with sugar to create a sugar rim.





CONT.

- 4. Combine 2 oz of infused rum, 0.5 oz of simple syrup, and a pinch of edible pearl luster dust in a small serving glass (6-8 oz).
- 5. In a separate small glass (such as a large shotglass), combine 0.5 oz of lemon juice, 0.5 oz of raspberry lemonade, and 0.5 oz of peach schnapps. Stir to combine.

FIRE HAZARD WARNING

- 6. OPTIONAL: Layer a small amount (1-2 tsp) of high proof alcohol over the rum mixture in your serving glass, using the back of a spoon. Use a long lighter or match to light
- 7. CAREFULLY pour the lemon juice/lemonade mixture into the serving glass to change the color of the drink from blue to purple.
- 8. Take the pinch of ground cinnamon and sprinkle over the flame to make sparks.
- 9. Smother the fire using a glass or plate to cover the serving glass until extinguished.
- 10. Stir the drink, wait for the glass to cool enough to handle, and serve.

Take proper precautions when soul charging setting things on fire! Use heat-proof glassware / have a fire extinguisher on hand.




