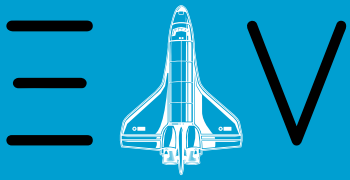

The weather held out and it turned out to be a beautiful warm day. What could be better than seafood and coconut drinks on the water?

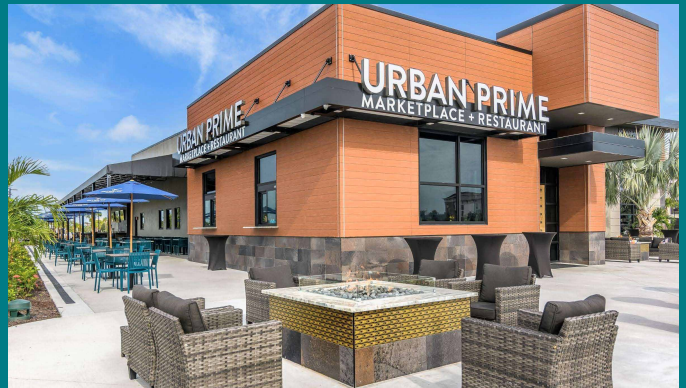

Tom, a much awarded driver himself, was preparing for an IGT Race to take place the end of June where he will have Ron Zitza as his co-driver in the Enduro.

Most recently, in early June, Zotz Racing was at Watkins Glen International, located on the southern tip of Seneca Lake, New York. "The Glen" is a renowned 3.45-mile Grand Prix circuit road course and the former home of the Formula One US Grand Prix and currently owned by NASCAR.

Zotz Racing and crew provided track support for two of my racing friends, Scott Leder, with his 1970 914-6 Porsche and Skott Burkland with his 1969 911 Porsche, who were at Watkins Glen for the IMSA/HSR Classic 6 Hour. Preparation begins with testing and qualifying days for the 3 Sprints and the Classic 6 Hour Enduro.



Scott Leder brought home 1st in class for all 4 races of the Classic 6 Hour, and Skott Burkland brought home some 2nd in class finishes in the historic sprint races. They both did great and had a wonderful time racing there in the cool temps and enjoying the beautiful area.

For those interested in thinking about driving your Porsche on the racetrack, Zotz Racing hosts an annual Tech Event every January to support HPDE and Racing with your Porsche for both new and advanced track enthusiasts.

THE CAYENNE GTS.

Over 20 years ago we asked ourselves if a sports car could celebrate more than the individual. The Cayenne provided the answer. And it continues to perfect it to this day. For people who want to tread their own path.

I'm BAAAACK!

After driving and instructing at HPDE events since 2010, in 2018 I obtained my Historic Sports car Racing license. I successfully competed in the BRM Endurance Series and WeatherTech Sprint Challenge, earning class championships in both. My 2019 racing campaign was cut short by a track incident (aka wreck) at Road Atlanta (not my fault) that totaled the highly modified 1995 Porsche 911 (993 version) that I was racing then. Since then, I have continued driving and instructing at HPDE events with the PCA and Chin Track Days. I have been getting faster and faster cars, now driving a Porsche GT4RS Club Sport, with its 9,000 rpm, 500 hp, GT3 engine. I am one of the faster drivers at a DE event. The next logical (perhaps insane) step for me was to try racing again. So, I got my International GT racing license and signed up for the first IGT race weekend at Sebring in February. Here we go!

It had been six years since my last race that ended poorly. I knew that racing was a lot different than a DE track day and thought I remembered what to expect. I was wrong. From practice, to qualifying, to my first race, I was on a steep learning curve. The speed and aggression of my fellow drivers took some getting used to. I caused a minor incident in my first race at Sebring and got put on probation right away. If I screwed up again, my racing license could be suspended. My confidence took a real blow. Maybe I didn't belong there. I finished the next three races at Sebring that weekend with two second and one first in class finishes. Maybe I could do this!

My next race weekend was at Road Atlanta in March. I felt much more comfortable about what to expect than I did at Sebring, but also a little anxious about racing there again. I had driven and instructed there since my wreck in 2019 but racing and DE are different, and I had never driven my current car there. We used the Chin DE event the weekend before to get some extra seat time and dial in the car for the upcoming racing.

The race weekend went perfectly! I qualified reasonably well but started poorly in my first sprint race. I eventually passed my competition and finished first in class. My best lap time in race one positioned me on grid of the next race ahead my competition. The same thing happened in the next two sprint



– first in class finishes and fastest in class lap times. The last race was a one-hour enduro. It was the feature race on Sunday with a fan grid walk, driver interviews and an opening ceremony. I felt like a racing celebrity! The race proceeded without any caution flags allowing my co-driver Ron Zitza to drive the final twenty minutes of the enduro and help secure another first in class, podium-topping finish! Woo-hoo!

I am grateful to have the opportunity to drive with IGT and to compete with fellow Porsche drivers there. All four of our IGT races went from green to checkered flag without any car-to-car contact. That could not be said for any of the other racing that was happening there that weekend as part of the SVRA Speed Tour. I also appreciate the help and support from the Zotz Racing team of Ron, Jason and Chris who keep me and my car in top racing condition.

Next stop Mid-Ohio.

The Pink Pig

Hello, my name is David Schnorr. I am an artist. I have been designing, manufacturing and installing graphics on racecars since the mid 1980s.

However, like most living artists today the public recognizes the artwork, but not necessarily the artist. This is the case with me. Some of my racecars are very well known for the designs that they display, but my name is not known at all.

So is such with probably the most famous livery (race car design) ever put on a Porsche road racing car. In addition, this racecar design was only on the racecar for 1 race!

Everybody sees a picture this now famous racecar and he or she immediately says... PINK PIG...

However if you ask anyone "who is the creator of that famous car design?" you will just get a blank stare.

What was the Pink Pig?

It was a Porsche 917/20 racecar. A one-off prototype created by Porsche to race at the famed 24 Hours of Le Mans in 1971. Reinhold Joest was one of the drivers. He never did win as a driver at the Le Mans race. However later as a team owner, Joest Racing has won the 24 Hours of Le Mans fifteen times during the last 25 years.

This racecar was originally going to be sponsored by Martini Rossi in their now famous red and blue stripes. However when they saw the new wider and shorter aerodynamic look they refused to put their name on such an ugly car. You see when people coming

to the track saw this Porsche 917 they all said that the car looked like a pig. The front end of the car had the look of a short wide snout and the car itself looked very fat.

Porsche had to think fast and design a new racing livery quickly. In the end, it was Porsche designer Anatole Lapine who stepped in to save the day with a now celebrated livery.

The Porsche team painted the car in pink and applied markings resembling a butcher's diagram of pork cuts. The livery included names for different meat cuts like "snout," "ham," and "pork knuckle." The Pink Pig's livery, while bold and memorable, was not a deliberate marketing stunt, but rather an in-joke among the team.

My interaction with the pink pig was a partial restoration done at Gunnar racing back in the early 90s. I traced out all of the lettering on the entire vehicle and saved it. Then I was able to make my own font table of that letter style on my first computer. That way I could reproduce it easily. I also kept the paint samples in my file cabinet.

Let me zip up to 2010 when a gentleman in a Chicago Porsche dealership wanted to sell more Cayman's. He decided to make a racing series for street legal Caymans and turn them into racecars. The twist was they would have unique liveries which are designs of the past racecars.

During that time, I did a pink pig design on one of the Caymans. I did not use the original pink color because the lady driver and owner liked bright pink instead.





Porsche saw that the public loved all the cool retro designs and so they decided they were going to get in on it. From 2014 until 2020 I worked with the Porsche factory race team and did quite a few retro designs on the factory race cars.

Then In 2018, I worked with Gunnar racing on a pink pig tractor for the Rennsport reunion Porsche tractor race. Yes, Porsche made tractors. We had John Oates (Hall & Oates musical group singer) drive the tractor.

I have been also fortunate in my artistic race car career to come up with a few iconic and memorable race car designs. But that is story for another time..

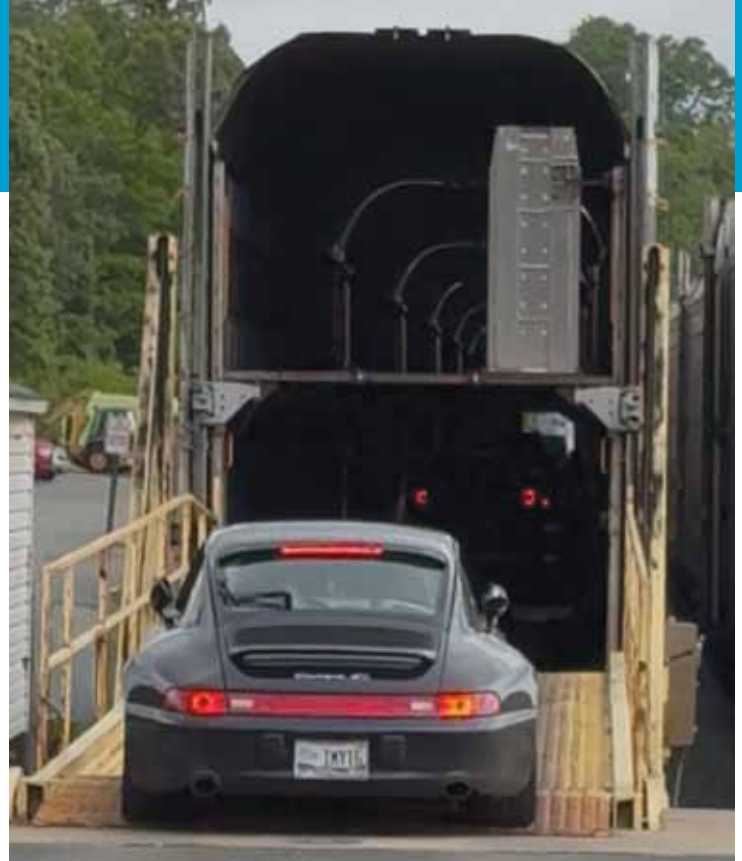
The elevation changes, and incredible views were worth the price of admission. And there's nothing quite like a cool morning drive in the mountains in the best cars in the world with your good friends.

Marine Discovery Center Eco Tour

A boatload of SPC and Citrus member from Ormond Beach to Vero Beach and Orlando met in New Smyrna Beach on Saturday, June 7th to enjoy a delicious lunch and then board our private charter to cruise the Indian River Lagoon and learn about the marine environment and New Smyrna Beach history.

We enjoyed a special lunch at The General Public House on Canal Street in New Smyrna Beach. The restaurant prepared the center of the restaurant for our group and a special menu. The chef visited with us and shared fun stories and laughter. To show what a small world it is, one of our members knew the restaurant the chef had worked at in Ohio before coming to Florida!

Our next stop was Marine Discovery Center boat ramp where we boarded m/v Discovery. Captain Doug (a prior 914 owner) and Lisa, our Master Naturalist guide, welcomed us aboard for our two-hour narrated cruise north on the Indian River / Intercoastal Waterway.

We crossed the Ponce de Leon inlet which is the beginning of the Indian River Lagoon (IRL). Notably the IRL spans from the inlet south to Jupiter – 156 miles – nearly the entire Space Coast Region! The IRL is the most biologically diverse estuary in North America. We saw and learned about nesting shorebirds, dolphin, manatee, sharks (fortunately we did not see them), mangroves and conservation efforts designed to protect the IRL.

A short distance past the inlet we were treated to a great view of the Ponce Inlet Lighthouse, the tallest lighthouse in Florida and second tallest in the United States. Along the way we enjoyed also learning about some of the history and folklore of New Smyrna Beach along with insights into some of the areas restaurants and attractions.

Two new members were welcomed, and Doug and Carol Schrank were celebrated for their 29 years with PCA!

Spending the day with old friends, meeting new ones and making great memories made for a perfect afternoon.

Deep Dive at Triton Subs

On Tuesday, June 3, 2025, twenty-two members of the Space Coast Region had the opportunity to visit and tour the Triton Submarines facility in Sebastian, receiving a "deep dive" briefing and facility walk through from the Triton team.



Our visit began with a briefing in the boardroom delivered by Triton Submarines Executive Director, Sophie Bentham-Wood. Sophie shared some of the history of the company, and highlighted the incredible feats of undersea exploration Triton Submarine owners have accomplished since the company introduced its first personal submarine in 2008. Records held by Triton subs and their proud owners include the deepest, longest duration and most-repeated journeys ever accomplished by leisure, commercial, professional and ultra-deep certified submersibles.

By 2016, Triton had revolutionized superyacht-based exploration. In fact, Paul Allen, the late co-founder of Microsoft, had a 10-passenger sub built named Pagoo, which was housed aboard his 413-foot yacht Octopus.



We had the rare chance to get up close and personal with a variety of submarines, ranging from 2 passengers all the way up to 10 passengers, which the Triton team of technicians and engineers were hard at work on.

Triton Submarines deliver an average of 2 submersibles per year, ranging in price from \$4 million up to \$40 million, with 27 submarines delivered to customers to date. From the earliest consultation with the sales and engineering teams through delivery, the average length of time a client has to wait is 4 years. That's even longer than waiting for an allocation for a GT3 RS! So, if you're interested, you better order now. All client submarines have maintained their annual certifications and are still in use today. Additionally, every 3 to 5 years, each submarine is completely disassembled, inspected, updated and recertified.

Our group had a very memorable day learning about some of the most sophisticated undersea vehicles in the world. If you'd like to learn more, please visit www.tritonsubs.com.



And best of all, the proceeds from our event will be helping support the Ocean Research & Conservation Association (ORCA) in Vero Beach (www.teamorca.org), an organization that Triton Submarines works very closely with.

Our wonderful excursion wrapped up with a lunch at the Sebastian Saltwater Marina Restaurant.

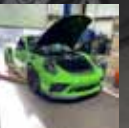

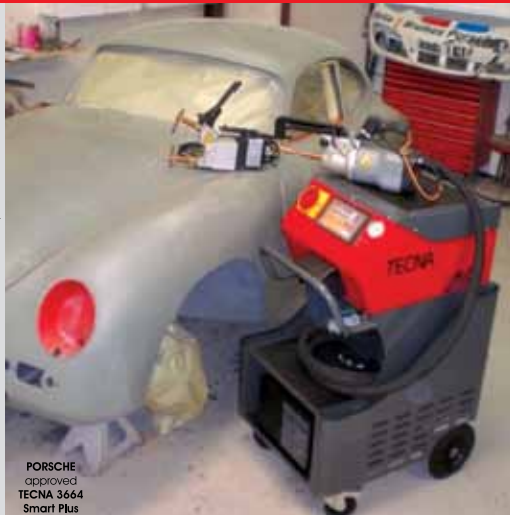
