FROM THE PRESIDENT

Board Update

After an amazing 3-week trek in Nepal hiking up to Everest Base Camp, I returned this week, really pleased to see the Club buzzing as we approach another summer season. Next Wednesday, we see the return of our popular Twilight 9 & Dine, which I know is eagerly awaited by many members.

The Board met last evening, and I am pleased to report the following update for members:

Membership

Over recent months, we have been monitoring field sizes as our membership numbers continue to grow. At the end of September, we had 1559 members, and October has seen a further 20 new members already join.

Whilst we currently have availability in competition fields, the Board has agreed to pause our membership intake until the 1st of April 2026, which is our next renewal date.

We have not taken this decision lightly and hope that our members understand this is to ensure course access is maintained for existing members.

If you have relatives or friends considering joining, please encourage them to register their interest in Green Acres with administration.

In the meantime, you can still have them enjoy the facilities as your guest.

Course Enhancement Plan

Last week, we received the second draft of the course design from Clayton Kruse following consideration of member feedback.

We will evaluate this report further and are currently completing a Course Enhancement Plan Governance Protocol document to guide how this project will be undertaken and the decision-making process associated with this important project.

The next step is to appoint an agronomist to provide guidance as to the most suitable grass for our greens and surrounds for our environment.

This project requires careful consideration in a number of areas, and we will report on progress in the new year.

Sub-Committees

Each of the Sub-Committees has met and is finalising its respective priorities for the year ahead. In particular, the Governance & HR Sub-Committee has been formally approved with Bob Crowley as Chair.

We look forward to seeing you at the Club again soon.




HERITAGE GROUP

Please feel free to bring items to the office or contact us if you have something to share. Every contribution helps us preserve and celebrate the story of Green Acres.





If there were any nerves, they didn't show. Luke Newman was first to finish, wrapping up his match early with an emphatic 9&8 win, barely needing to see the back nine. Will Duncan, with dad (Rohan) on the bag, overcame adversity in true matchplay style. After breaking his putter mid-round, he calmly putted with his 7-wood to seal a gritty 3&2 victory.

Angus Wohlers looked right at home, playing solid golf throughout to post a strong 5&4 win.

Her standout moment came on the 150m par-3 17th, where her tee shot missed a hole-in-one by just 2 inches! Emily clinched her match 5&4, an incredible debut.

This is a popular event, so places are limited. Book as early as you can to avoid disappointment.

With the new handicapping system, don't be surprised if your daily handicap for 9 holes is around 50% of your usual 18-hole handicap.

Don't worry too much about the numbers, just get out there, have fun, play 9, wine and dine, and let the good times and hopefully good scores roll in!

Golf Connect

Our software provider, MiClub, has requested that we defer handicapping for competitions held between Friday, 10th October and Sunday, 12th October. These rounds can then be submitted retrospectively for handicapping from Monday, 13th October.

This short delay will help ensure the system performance stabilises as the Golf Australia CONNECT course data synchronisation and handicap recalculation processes are finalised.

2025 Family Trophy

The 2025 Family trophy will be played on Sunday, the 19th of October. This event is played in conjunction with the daily 4BBB Stableford competition, with the best registered score being deemed the winner.

Course Safety


When finishing the 12th hole, please use caution as you need to cross the approach area of the 18th green.
