Our Accreditation



Transcript Information

GPA is based on a 4-point scale. All courses are calculated in the GPA except those graded on a Pass/Fail basis. IB/AP courses are awarded an additional 0.33 in the GPA. Language courses at the Intermediate B/C levels are weighted. Starting in the 2020-21 school year, the GPA is rounded to the 100th place to provide more accuracy in final GPA calculations.

In Grade 12, some students are tutored for IB ab initio courses not taught at school. Those students are enrolled in a world language course during the school day for credit and an ab initio course not for credit outside of school.

Class Rank

AIS Vienna has determined that class rank does not provide useful comparisons for a variety of reasons. Due to the transient nature of our school's population, each student's cumulative GPA is calculated based on a different number of classes. The weighted system only applies to students taking AP and IB Classes and Language Courses at the Intermediate B and C level taken primarily in grades 11 and 12.

The AIS Vienna Counseling Office encourages students to apply to no more than 10 universities.



Classes are seventy-five to eighty minutes in length and meet on an eight-day rotation. There are four academic periods per day and students take a maximum of eight courses per semester. (Some IB courses meet additional times during the week.) One credit is earned per full-year course; one half-credit is earned per half-year course, not including Study Skills.

Standardized Test Scores

recent years, AIS Vienna students have had less access to SAT and ACT tests because of fewer test dates abroad. fewer sites offering the test, score cancellations, technology difficulties, and higher fees. With the trend of many universities choosing to go test optional and the low number of test takers at AIS Vienna, standardized testing data is no longer meaningful or reflective of our student body. We ask that all higher education institutions take this into account when evaluating our students' applications.

Impact of COVID-19 at AIS Vienna

In the 2021-2022 school year, AIS Vienna ran as normal with occasional periods of virtual learning in different grade levels as needed. Students who have had a more significant personal impact as a result of Covid have been encouraged to share that in the Covid prompt under the Writing Section in the Common Application.

In the 2020-2021 school year, AIS Vienna started in person and transitioned to synchronous virtual learning in November of 2020. Grades 9-11 completed virtual learning through February of 2021. The High School ran a combination of hybrid and virtual learning through March and April and returned completely to in-school learning in May. Through both virtual and in-school learning, AIS Vienna was able to successfully complete its full curriculum throughout the school year. All IB and AP exams were administered in person in May of 2021.

In the 2019-2020 school year, AIS Vienna began virtual learning in mid-March and the teachers used both synchronous and asynchronous learning approaches. The majority of High School students were able to return to the classroom in June for the last three weeks of the school year and met with their core classes in person on an every-other-day rotation. IB exams were not administered, however AP exams were administered virtually.
