# Northern Lights and the Wildlife of Northern Manitoba

SEPTEMBER 19-24, 2024

Journey to the great Canadian north for a once-in-a-lifetime eco-adventure, featuring evenings under the stars to observe the northern lights.

# The Galapagos Islands – Northern Itinerary

JANUARY 20-27, 2024 (optional: Mashpi Lodge pre-tour Jan. 17-20, 2024; Machu Picchu post-tour: Jan. 27 - Feb. 1, 2024)

- Explore secluded inlets and stroll sweeping white coral beaches, such as Darwin Bay. See tidal pools and pass by colonies of various bird species.
- Visit the lush highlands of Santa Cruz Island, the perfect habitat to see the Galapagos Giant Tortoise, and Puerto Egas on Santiago Island the site of a former salt mine and where you're most likely to see the Galapagos fur seal.
