We look forward to welcoming you to Cheers for Charity 2022.







We have also helped those organizations raise millions of dollars by introducing them to our generous friends and working with them to help even more children. Over the past six years, with your help, we have raised over \$2 million through our Cheers for Charity event. Because we've only scratched the surface of need, we are committed to continuing to make significant contributions by hosting our sixth annual Broadrick Family Foundation fundraiser.

In 2020 we were forced to cancel our event like so many others. Last year, we were excited to welcome you back despite challenges that included Tami out with COVID, rain and storms, and even power outages! It was an evening to remember because, even with all that, our friends made it the most successful Cheers for Charity ever! And, we even had a fly over! We were honored and grateful that we have been able to fund so many more projects this past year. We have provided food, beds, wheelchairs, clothing, support and even birthday parties to the most vulnerable... children. We know that you will be proud of what your generosity has accomplished. We continued to support primarily children's causes, focusing on safe places to live, nutrition, special needs, and education. As before, our long-term goal is to ensure that every child lives in a safe, loving environment and then has the opportunity to break the cycle of poverty through education.

hanks TO YOUR GENEROSITY

The Broadrick Family Foundation has been able to:

- Provide 93.094 children with a snack pack for the weekend, helping to alleviate food insecurity.
- Offer school readiness and positive learning outcomes for over 250 at risk children and parents.
- Create 2 computer labs for more than 200 foster children to be able to attend school during quarantine.
- Maintain an emergency supply closet stocked with diapers, formula, car seats, pack and plays, and clothing for foster children & their caregivers.
- Sent over 300 foster children to summer camp.
- Help provide school uniforms and emergency clothing to over 8,800 elementary and middle school students.

BUT THERE IS STILL SO MUCH MORE WE CAN DO...

- There are still over 35,000 children in foster care throughout Florida, with 66% of them under the age of 10 years old.

- These children will be placed in up to 20 foster homes throughout their lifetime.
- There are 2.07 MILLION students eligible for free or reduced lunches state-wide, with 71% of those living in Hillsborough, Pinellas, Pasco, and Hernando counties.
- On any given night in Florida there are over 34,210 homeless unaccompanied youths, with 50% of them sleeping outside, in cars or someplace not meant for human habitation.
- Between Hillsborough and Pinellas counties, there are over 10,000 homeless teenagers (unaccompanied youth).



THE KIND MOUSE PRODUCTIONS, INC.

Thanks to the generosity of our guests last year, the Broadrick Family Foundation was able to aid The Kind Mouse Productions in providing thousands of food insecure children with "Mouse Nibbles" backpacks filled with non-perishable foods to take home each weekend. These packs provide the children with much needed nutrition while away from school.



ONE COMMUNITY NOW, INC.

One Community Now, Inc. is another organization that has benefitted from last year's generosity. Thanks to our donors, the Broadrick Family Foundation and One Community Now have partnered to fight food insecurity for Pasco school children by providing Pack A Sack bags for their weekend feeding program. They have been able to expand this program throughout the county to reach even more children.





CELEBRATE BIRTHDAYS

The goal of Celebrate Birthdays is to ensure that every foster child and other underserved children in the community can celebrate their birthday and receive a present, regardless of personal or financial circumstances. They believe that every child deserves to have a special day to call their own. Celebrate Birthdays partners with local agencies throughout the Tampa Bay Area to put as many smiles on children's faces as possible. The Broadrick Family Foundation is dedicated to helping them achieve this goal.

THE JOSHUA HOUSE

The Joshua House provides a safe haven for the abused, neglected, and abandoned children in the Tampa Bay community. They offer a therapeutic residential group care program that provides a protected, nurturing, family-like environment. These children have been removed from their homes due to crisis and many have been through multiple foster homes. The Broadrick Family Foundation has partnered with The Joshua House to provide these children with a safe and fun environment to aid in their healing.

WHEELCHAIRS 4 KIDS

Owheelchairs 4 Kids

The Broadrick Family Foundation is proud to continue our work with Wheelchairs 4 Kids to aid in providing wheelchairs, home and vehicle modifications and other assistive and therapeutic equipment for physically disabled children. This equipment will help these families in adequately caring for their children in a safe and loving manner.



CHAMPIONS FOR CHILDREN

For the second year in a row the Broadrick Family Foundation has worked with Champions for Children to fund a project that brings evidence-based parent educational and developmental playgroups to low-income and dual-language learning families in the Town-N-Country and West Tampa communities. The hope of this project is to build stronger families in the Tampa Bay area and aid in preventing child abuse through family education.

A KID'S PLACE OF TAMPA BAY

The mission of A Kid's Place is to provide residential care for children in crisis from birth to age 21 who have been removed from their homes due to abuse, neglect or abandonment. Their primary focus is keeping sibling groups together. Recently they have been able to expand their services to include an Extended Foster Care home for youth aging out of the system. This enables them to remain close to their siblings and the support system they need to transition successfully to independence. The Broadrick Family Foundation was able to aid in outfitting that home with bedroom furnishings as well as completing the living room.



SUNCOAST VOICES FOR CHILDREN

The Broadrick Family Foundation continues to help Suncoast Voices to achieve their vision of providing the unmet physical, psychological, education and social needs of abused, abandoned and neglected children in Pinellas and Pasco counties. We work together to reach these goals by providing beds, bedding, pack & plays and car seats in emergency situations.



WOUNDED VETERANS RELIEF

The mission of the Wounded Veterans Relief Fund (WVRF) is to ease the distress of disabled Florida veterans and their families as they face the challenges of civilian life. With the support of the Broadrick Family Foundation, the WVRF is able to provide emergency financial intervention for housing needs, transportation, and other essentials for the veterans of the Tampa Bay area.



FUND A NEED

THERE ARE APPROXIMATELY 10,000 HOMELESS AND UNACCOMPANIED STUDENTS IN OUR HOMETOWN.

Could this be possible? Unfortunately, it is true.

On any given night in the US, there are approximately 41,000 unaccompanied homeless minors, which adds up to about 700,000 children a year. Unaccompanied youths endure living without stable housing, food and healthcare, a caring adult, hygienic facilities, and transportation. Statistics show that 1 in 3 kids on the street are lured into prostitution within 48 hours of leaving home. It's called "survival sex." It's a horrible situation that we rarely, if ever, hear about. These children become invisible, because they need to be, in order to escape an environment that is even worse. Family dysfunction, substance abuse, pregnancy, parental neglect and abuse, incarceration, deportation and even rape are the reasons they leave their home.

For the past 14 years, Starting Right, Now has been committed to addressing the roots of poverty for unaccompanied homeless youth in Tampa Bay and breaking the cycle of poverty one child at a time. This is not a quick fix. It is a life changing relationship that provides mental health counseling, academic support, help with scholarships, and stability. Each child that lives in the Starting Right, Now home, is matched with a personal mentor and taught to budget and save. They attend life skills training like Dale Carnegie, anger management and meditation to build self-esteem. They finish high school. They are taught to give back. The Starting Right, Now program saves lives by changing lives. The Broadrick Family Foundation is proud to have helped this amazing organization for the past few years.

It costs \$3,500 per month to house, feed and provide the comprehensive care that Starting Right, Now offers. While this is a lot, the alternative is this:

\$5,890 for Foster Care \$12,397 for Incarceration

Help us get these children off the streets and in a safe home where they have a chance. These children don't need a second chance, they need a first chance. A chance to be a child and a chance at being a productive adult.
