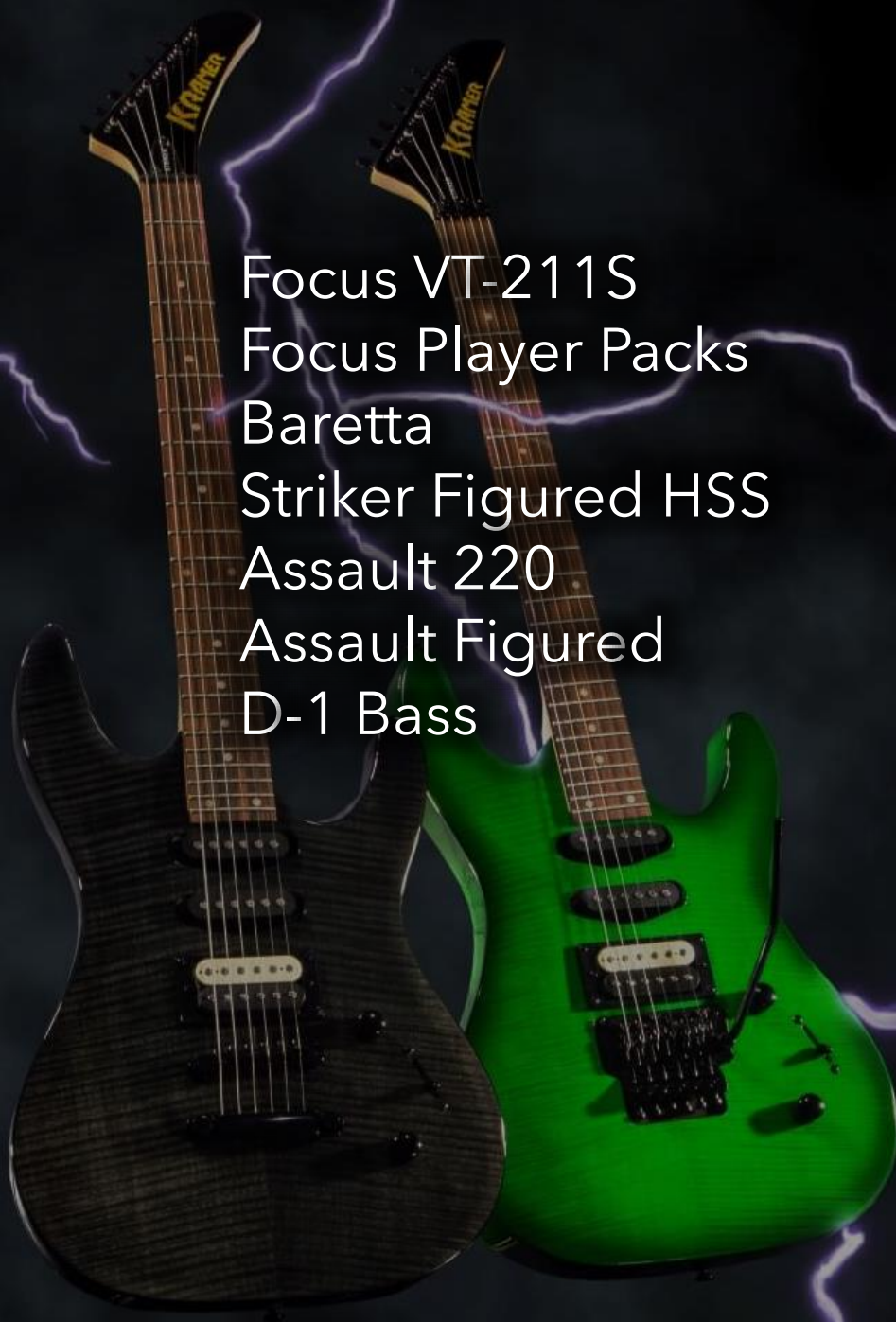

IT ALL STARTED BACK IN 1976...

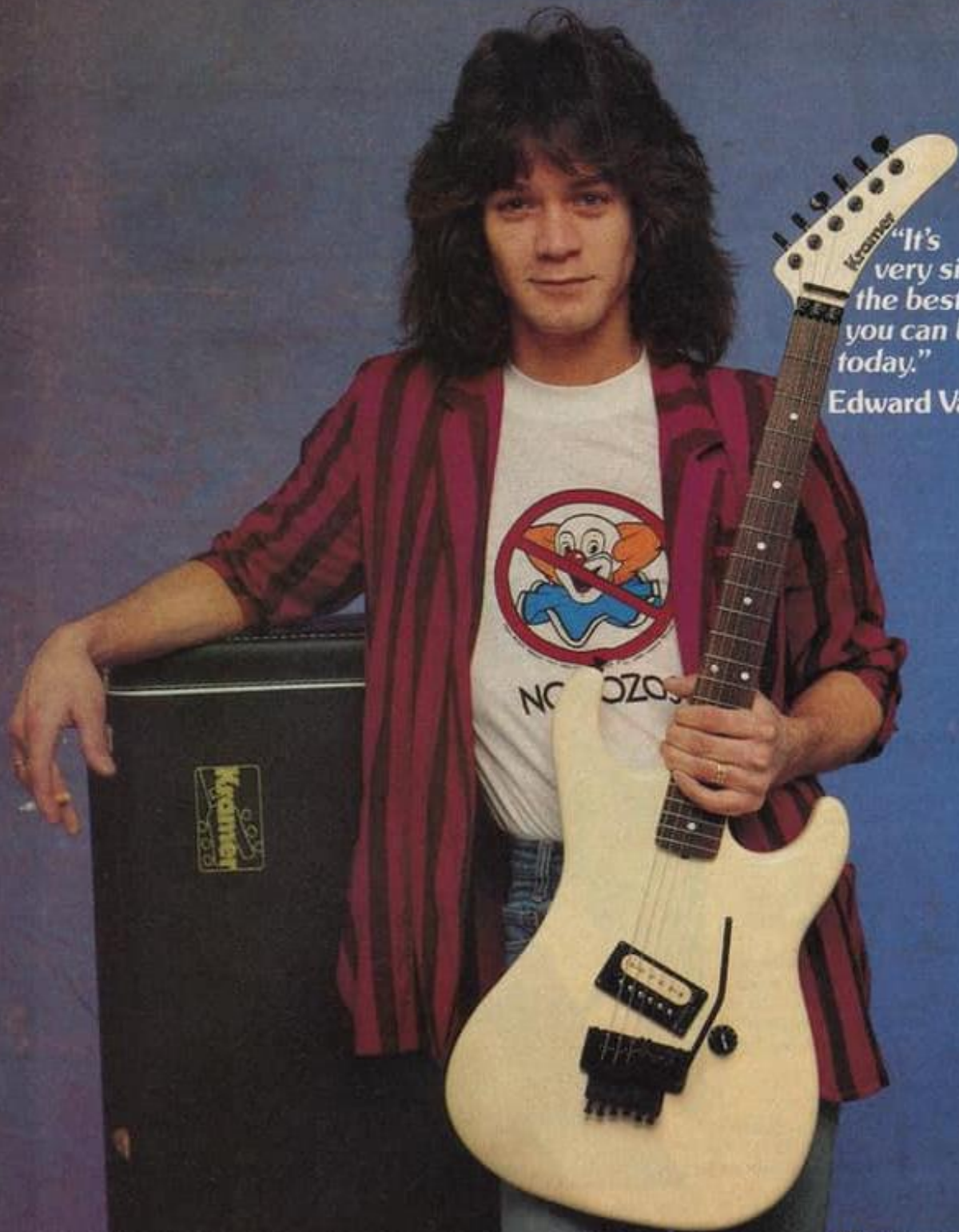
