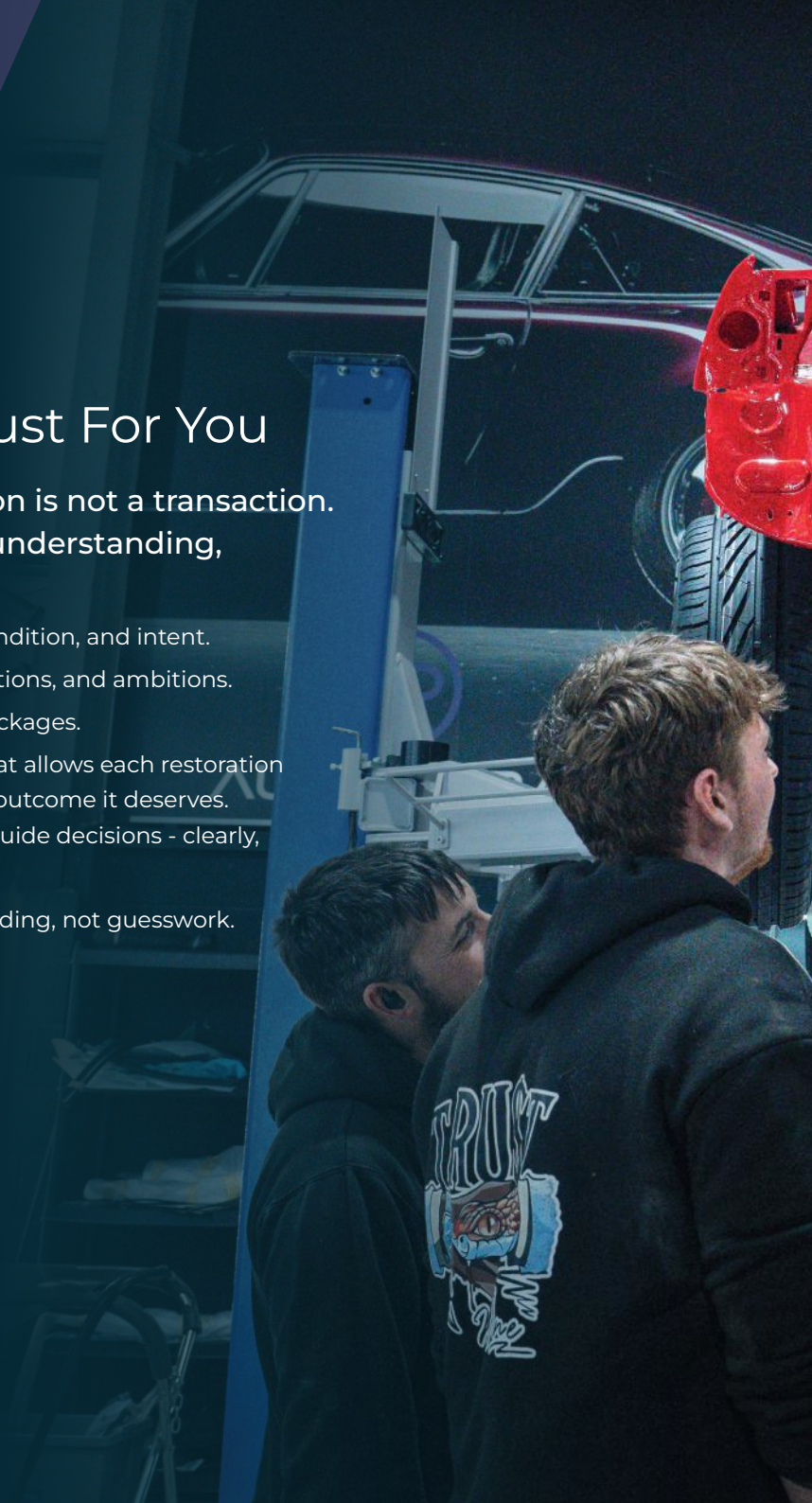
At Auto RARA, classic car restoration is not a transaction. It is a considered journey built on understanding, structure, and trust.

Our Philosophy

Understanding before action.

Traditionally, restoration has meant handing over the keys and waiting, often with little visibility and limited understanding of what unfolds along the way.

The Restoration Journey™

A framework, not a formula.

Every Auto RARA restoration follows a clear framework - but never a fixed script.

Structure is essential in complex restoration work. It creates clarity, supports quality control, and enables informed decision-making. At the same time, no two cars - or owners - require the same path.

The Restoration Journey™ balances both.

It provides a structured foundation that adapts to the condition of the vehicle, the intended outcome, and the choices made along the way.

The journey is built around three core elements:

1. The Assessment

Understanding before commitment

2. The Build Diary

Transparency throughout the restoration

3. The Build Book

Permanent provenance beyond completion

Individually, each adds value. Together, they form a restoration experience designed to remove uncertainty, support informed decisions, and protect the long-term integrity of the car.



The Assessment

Understanding before commitment.

Every restoration journey begins with an Assessment.

Before major work is commissioned, each vehicle entering the Auto RARA restoration programme undergoes a structured, non-invasive assessment. This process establishes clarity - for the car, the project, and the owner.

Classic cars often carry decades of use, repair, modification, and compromise. What is visible rarely tells the full story. The assessment allows us to evaluate the vehicle as it exists today, not as it first appears.

During the assessment, we consider:

- Structural condition and corrosion risk
- Evidence of previous repairs or modifications
- Mechanical condition and originality
- Intended use, ownership goals, and expectations

These findings are brought together to form a shared understanding of the project ahead.

The assessment does not attempt to eliminate every unknown. Instead, it is designed to reduce uncertainty, identify risk areas early, and define appropriate, staged options for moving forward.

Clients receive:

- A clear digital assessment report
- Project-specific recommendations and priorities
- Defined decision points to support informed planning

The assessment forms the foundation of the Restoration Journey™ - ensuring each project begins with alignment, transparency, and confidence before irreversible decisions are made.





Restoration Service Pathways

Clear choices, defined direction.

Following the assessment, each project moves forward along a clearly defined pathway, shaped by the condition of the vehicle and the intended outcome.

Rather than fixed packages, Auto RARA offers service pathways - allowing restorations to scale appropriately while remaining disciplined and controlled.

Typical pathways include:

Preservation & Correction

Focused intervention to stabilise, correct, and preserve existing originality.

Ideal for vehicles with strong fundamentals requiring targeted structural, mechanical, or cosmetic work.

Partial Restoration

A structured programme addressing defined systems or areas of concern, sequenced to support longevity and usability without unnecessary scope expansion.

Full Restoration

A comprehensive, system-led restoration addressing structure, mechanical systems, body, paint, trim, and assembly - delivered through staged phases with documented decision points.

Each pathway remains flexible. Findings uncovered during the journey may inform revised priorities, sequencing, or scope - always reviewed with context, evidence, and recommendation.

Technical accountability remains with Auto RARA at every stage.

The Build Diary

Transparency throughout the journey.

Restoration should never feel hidden.

Throughout your project, the Auto RARA Build Diary provides a clear, structured view of what is happening to your car as work progresses.

It is not a highlight reel. It is a working record of the journey, shared openly and honestly.

Through the Build Diary, clients can expect:

Regular progress updates at key stages

Photographic records of work undertaken

Clear explanations of technical decisions

Visibility of inspections and milestone reviews

Where decisions are required, they are presented with context and options, allowing informed discussion without transferring technical responsibility to the owner.

The Build Book

A permanent record of the restoration.

When a restoration is complete, the work does not simply end at handover.

Every full Auto RARA restoration concludes with a Build Book - a physical, curated record of the journey the car has undertaken.

The Build Book documents:

- The story of the vehicle and its restoration
- Key stages from assessment to completion
- Significant technical decisions and milestones
- Photographic documentation of work carried out

Each restoration is documented through three identical Build Books:

- One remains with the car as part of its permanent history
- One is retained by the owner
- One is held by Auto RARA for continuity and long-term reference

No two Build Books are the same, because no two restorations follow the same path. The document records not only what was done, but why it was done.







Environment & In-House Capability

Built to support the journey.

The quality of a restoration is shaped as much by its environment as by the hands that carry it out.

Auto RARA operates from purpose-designed facilities created to support complex, multi-discipline restoration work. All core disciplines are delivered entirely in-house, eliminating external handover risk and supporting close collaboration between teams.

Our facilities include:

- Dedicated assessment and inspection areas
- Controlled lighting quality inspection bays
- Fabrication, paint, trim, mechanical, and engine build departments
- Secure parts storage and project management infrastructure

This environment exists to support restorations that are carefully planned, expertly executed, and transparently delivered.

Quality Inspection & Assurance

Standards applied at every stage.

Quality in restoration cannot be inspected in at the end. It must be built in from the beginning.

Inspection routines are applied at defined stages throughout every restoration, including:

- Post strip-down and initial findings
- Structural and fabrication completion
- Mechanical and system rebuild stages
- Paint preparation, finish, and correction
- Final assembly and commissioning

All inspections are documented within the Build Diary, ensuring visibility and accountability throughout the journey.

This disciplined approach ensures every Auto RARA restoration is delivered to a consistent standard, aligned with the intent of the project and the responsibility we accept as custodians of historic vehicles.
