# About Curbside Collection in Dedham



## COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Curbside collection services are provided based on the following schedules:

- **Trash Collection:** Weekly
- **Recycling Collection:** Bi-Weekly
- **Yard Waste Collection:** Seasonal (please see page 3 for 2026 calendar)

To confirm your collection day and recycling collection week, please refer to the street listing on pages 6 through 9.

Other disposal services (please see page 4 for more information):

- White Goods, Bulky Items, Mattresses: By appointment only; Fee per item
- Textiles and Household Items: CMRK/Big Brother Big Sister

## COLLECTION GUIDELINES

**Place materials at curb by 7:00 a.m. on collection day**

- Bag all household trash and place inside your 96-gallon maroon cart with lid closed—nothing sticking out
- Keep recyclables OUT of the trash cart
- We cannot accept: dirt, sod, rock, concrete, construction debris, hazardous waste, hot ashes, or flammables (oil, gas, paint)

### Excess Trash - Yellow Overflow Bags

If trash doesn't fit in your cart, use official 30-gallon yellow overflow bags (Town seal).

**Purchase bags at:** Star Market (795 Providence Hwy), Stop & Shop (160 Providence Hwy), or Terri's Market (12 Louise Road)—\$2.00/bag in sleeves of five



## CARTS

**Each household receives ONE trash cart (96-gallon) and ONE recycling cart (96-gallon).**

# Curbside Yard Waste Collection

The Town of Dedham provides 22 weeks of seasonal collection in 2026 (11 gray weeks and 11 maroon weeks) on your regular recycling day. The schedule **focuses on peak Spring and Fall months** when collection is typically at its heaviest.

## WHAT WE ACCEPT:

- Leaves, grass, and easily raked material
- Branches and brush: under 3" diameter, cut to 3' lengths, bundled and tied (max 60 lbs.)

## HOW TO PREPARE:

- Separate yard waste from trash and recycling
- Use open barrels or biodegradable bags only
- No plastic bags

# Seasonal/Holiday Information



## HOLIDAY COLLECTION DELAYS

When holidays fall on a collection day, all collections shift one day later for the rest of that week.

### 2026 Holidays with One-Day Collection Delay:

## EXCESS RECYCLING COLLECTION - TWO WEEKS

Additional recycling will be collected on your regular recycling day during the following weeks:

- **Gray week:** December 28, 2026
- **Maroon week:** January 4, 2027

For these **two weeks only**, residents can place extra cardboard, paper, and recyclables outside your cart in open barrels, paper bags, or boxes.

## CHRISTMAS TREE COLLECTION

The DPW team collects trees starting in January at no additional cost to Dedham residents.

- **Preparation:** Remove all decorations, lights, and plastic before placing at curb.
- **Note:** Collection may not occur on your regular day - leave it at the curb, we will get it as soon as we can!

## TEXTILE & HOUSEHOLD ITEM RECYCLING

### FREE curbside pickup by CMRK/Big Brother Big Sister

- Accepted items: Clothing, shoes, dishes, small household items  
Not accepted: Furniture or mattresses
- How to prepare: Seal in plastic bags labeled "CMRK/BBBS" (clothing/shoes) or boxes (breakables, max 30 lbs). Place curbside on pickup day.

### Drop-Off Bins Around Dedham

You can also bring accepted items to one of the blue collections bins located at the ECEC, Avery School, Greenlodge School, Oakdale School, Riverdale School, or Middle School.

# Bulky Items, White Goods, HazWaste

## BULKY ITEMS AND WHITE GOODS

**Schedule pickup:** Call Boston Carting Services at 1-800-338-3867

### Fees:

- Bulky Items = \$34.04 until June 30; \$35.50 as of July 1, 2026
- White Goods = \$39.71 until June 30; \$41.42 as of July 1, 2026

### What are "Bulky Items"?

The MassDEP defines "bulky items" as waste items unusually large in size WITHOUT a plug, including but not limited to:

- upholstered furniture
- grill
- desk
- bed frame
- dresser

### What are "White Goods"?

The MassDEP identifies "white goods" as large appliances, including but not limited to:

- washing machine
- dryer
- refrigerator
- air conditioner
- stove

**Note:** Please call Boston Carting, LLC for a complete list of items.

# Recycling Collection, Tips and Guides



Recycling in Dedham begins at the curb. By recycling everyday items, tons of raw materials, time, energy and money are saved.

## Follow These Simple Steps

1. Empty loose recyclables directly into cart—no bags
2. No plastic bags or styrofoam in cart
3. Flatten cardboard boxes
4. Place cart at curb by 7:00 a.m. on your collection day

### ✓ YES - IN YOUR CART

Newspapers, magazines  
Glass bottles & jars  
Metal & aluminum cans  
Plastic bottles & jugs (#1-#7)  
Milk/juice cartons  
Cereal boxes, paperboard

Styrofoam/polystyrene  
Food waste or liquids  
Greasy pizza boxes  
Clothing or textiles  
Electronics  
Batteries  
Hazardous materials

# Composting Options in Dedham

## OPTION 1: Backyard Composting

Earth Machine Compost Bins are available to Dedham residents at reduced rate of \$25.00.

### What are Earth Machine Compost Bins?

Earth Machine Compost Bins are an at-home, durable backyard compost bin designed to compost food and yard waste, effectively diverting it from landfills. These compost bins are designed for food and yard waste only.

## OPTION 2: Curbside Food Waste Collection with Black Earth Compost

Add food scraps to your bin and place curbside on collection day—no backyard work required!

**What's accepted:** All food scraps (meat, bones, dairy) and food-soiled paper

### Subscription rates:\*

- Weekly: \$21.99/month or \$119.99/6 months
- Every other week: \$16.99/month or \$94.99/6 months

\*Prices decrease up to 17% once 300 households enroll

## FREE Starter Kit for new Dedham participants!

This kit includes a 13-gallon bin with lid and wheels (as shown in photo) and comes with compostable liners/bags.

**WHY COMPOST:** Composting is a powerful way to reduce waste, diverting up to 30% of your trash from landfills. The nutrient-rich finished compost is used to enrich soil for local farms, community gardens, and your own backyard.

**Where:** DPW, 55 River Street

### What to Bring:

- Flattened cardboard boxes
- Mercury items (fluorescent lamps, CFLs, thermostats)
- Automotive waste (tires, lead acid batteries, motor oil)
- Household batteries (all non-alkaline types)
- Fire extinguishers
- 20-lb propane tanks
- String lights

**Note: We CANNOT accept antifreeze, paint, or electronics at these events.**

## Annual Recycling Day

**When:** Saturday, April 25, 2026

**Time:** 8:00 AM – 12:00 Noon

**Where:** Dedham Middle School Parking Lot

### What to Bring:

- Metal items (remove liquids and gas)
- Electronics, batteries, bulbs, hazardous waste (fees apply\*)
- Old documents (FREE shredding!)
- Items for REUSE: clothing, shoes (no rips/stains), DVDs, CDs, vinyl records, video games (functional, original packaging)

**Note: Unfortunately, we CANNOT accept Styrofoam at this event.**
