Benefits of Children Learning a Musical Instrument

- Brainpower: Scientists have proven that music helps to enhance brainpower and memory functions. Children exposed to music excel in academics. Music helps stimulate the part of the brain that is responsible for reading, math and emotional development. Children can improve memory skills at a young age by learning to play an instrument. Music teaches them to create, store and retrieve memories, like a workout for the brain.

- Self-expression: Skills such as songwriting, singing and stage performance will help children develop skills to express themselves. Learning to play an instrument gives them an outlet for creativity and making their own choices. Music is one way to express emotions. Learning to play an instrument can convey emotions in a healthy and productive way.
- Responsibility: Instruments require maintenance to keep them looking and sounding like they should, giving
 children something to take pride in and be responsible for. Another responsibility is following a practice
 schedule.
- Coordination: Playing an instrument requires the brain to work at advanced speeds. It improves hand-eye
 coordination because a child must concentrate on reading music and converting the notes into the physical
 motion of playing.
- Listening: Playing an instrument requires listening carefully to a collection of different things. A child needs to listen to instructions, rhythm, pitch and speed. This concentration will improve skills in music and in life.

This will remove the largest particles of salt and clumps of unmelted snow. Place additional mats inside for guests to dry their feet.
- Keep old towels or cleaning rags near the door. Wipe up puddles immediately. Standing water can damage your floors.
- If your office floors become slippery quickly, consider laying down plastic runners. Not only will these keep your floors clear of snow and salt, but they may prevent slip and fall injuries.
- Increase the frequency of your regular home or office floor cleaning. If you normally clean your floors with a damp mop once a week, you may need to clean them two or three times per week depending on foot traffic.

Which legendary guitarist played the solo on "Beat It" by Michael Jackson?

Answer: (B) Eddie Van Halen

In a piece of music history fit for Hollywood, the virtuoso rock guitarist recorded one of the most famous solos in pop history as a last-minute favor. In 1982, producer Quincy Jones called Eddie Van Halen on a whim and asked if he would play guitar on the record he was working on with Michael Jackson, then a 24-year-old who had yet to reach massive international stardom as a solo artist. On the other hand, Van Halen had already released four albums and Eddie was an established rock star. He later told CNN in an interview, "I said to myself, 'Who is going to know that I played on this kid's record, right? Nobody's going to find out.' Wrong!" He was very wrong, in fact: "Beat It" went on to be one of the best-selling singles in music history on one of the best-selling albums of all time, "Thriller." Eddie Van Halen, who passed away in October 2020 after a long battle with throat cancer, also told interviewers that Jones compensated him for his efforts with two sixpacks of beer.
