Beauty of the Cucumber

Cucumber is an excellent source of silica, which is a trace mineral that contributes to the strength of our connective tissue. Connective tissue is what holds our body together. Cucumbers are effective when used for various skin problems, including swelling under the eyes and sunburn. They also contain ascorbic and caffeic acids. These acids prevent water retention. That may explain why when cucumbers are applied topically they are often helpful for swollen eyes, burns, and dermatitis.

As a beauty aid, the cucumber provides immediate relief to puffy eyes; a fresh cucumber can be cut into thin slices, and these placed on the eyes for 5-10 minutes. This works incredibly well after a tiring day at work in front of the computer, and helps to relieve stress and dark circles around the eye area as well. Grated cucumber can be used as a mask and tonic for the entire face and neck.

Recipe Corner

This easy to make, tasty fruit salsa and cinnamon tortilla chips recipe will be great as an appetizer at this year's Cinco de Mayo party!

PREP 15 mins, COOK 10 mins, READY IN 45 mins, SERVES 10

INGREDIENTS

- 2 kiwis, peeled and diced
- 2 Golden Delicious apples
 - peeled, cored and diced
- 8 ounces raspberries
- 1 pound strawberries
- 2 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 tablespoon brown sugar
- 3 tablespoons fruit preserves
- any flavor

10 (10 inch) flour tortillas Butter flavored cooking spray 2 tablespoons cinnamon sugar



DIRECTIONS

In a large bowl, thoroughly mix kiwis, Golden Delicious apples, raspberries, strawberries, white sugar, brown sugar and fruit preserves. Cover and chill in the refrigerator at least 15 minutes. Preheat oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C). Coat one side of each flour tortilla with butter flavored cooking spray. Cut into wedges and arrange in a single layer on a large baking sheet. Sprinkle wedges with desired amount of cinnamon sugar. Spray again with cooking spray. Bake in the preheated oven 8 to 10 minutes. Repeat with any remaining tortilla wedges. Allow to cool approximately 15 minutes. Serve with chilled fruit mixture.


Grub Worms in Your Lawn

Spring is in full swing, and chances are as you dig around in your lawn, you may come across some grub worms either in the turf, or in your flower beds.

Here's How Grubs Operate:

Grub worms are the larvae of the Japanese beetle or "June Bug." In July & August they begin laying eggs in well irrigated lawns like yours, and those eggs develop into larvae called grub worms.

Grubs chew up the turf's root system, causing dead areas that begin to appear in early Fall. Most lawns can withstand



Even if your lawn was severely damaged last year by grubs, the ones that you find this Spring won't do any more damage. It's their offspring this July and August that post the biggest threat. The best advice is to keep your lawn properly fertilized and mowed, and you'll be fine. If you do have noticeable damage from last season, then grab your rake and grass seed and get to work repairing.

If you are still worried about grub worms, then this summer you should put down a grub worm preventative product that is long lasting in the soil such as Merit. Japanese beetle populations have been very high in the Midwest in the last few years, so get the treatment... but wait until summer!

Craigslist Job Hunting & Safety Tips

Craigslist did not start out as a job hunting site, but it has evolved over the years to include a very active job forum. Since it offers its services free of charge,

Craigslist has become extremely popular, particularly for people trying to find work in that particular area. Here are some tips for getting the most out of a job search on Craigslist.

The Basics

A legitimate job posting should include a detailed job description and all of the required qualifications. While it is not unusual for employers to post the same job more than once in the course of a month, be wary of those who post the same job multiple times in a single week. Do not ever send the would be employer money, and avoid giving any identifying details other than name until you have determined that the individual is legitimate.

Getting Responses

One of the ways that you can set yourself apart is by writing a clear and convincing proposal which lays out precisely what it is that you can do for your client. Most of the time, applicants think about the matter through their own eyes. They forget to look at it like their potential employer would be looking at it.

Avoid Desperation

Do not send in an application or respond to every single job out there. Even if you are feeling desperate, scrutinize the listings carefully. Not everyone is a scammer, and not everyone is going to try to use you. But remember that you are also likely to run into people who are looking to get the best deal they can for the lowest price, and that means that they may saddle you with a lot more work than what you would otherwise be paid. Keep in mind what you could be making at another job and try to keep within a comparable range. Don't let desperation convince you to take on a difficult client who barely pays anything.
