One day in October, Felipe shows up at the beach. He hadn't told anyone. One day in October, Carlos and Eduardo bury their friend.

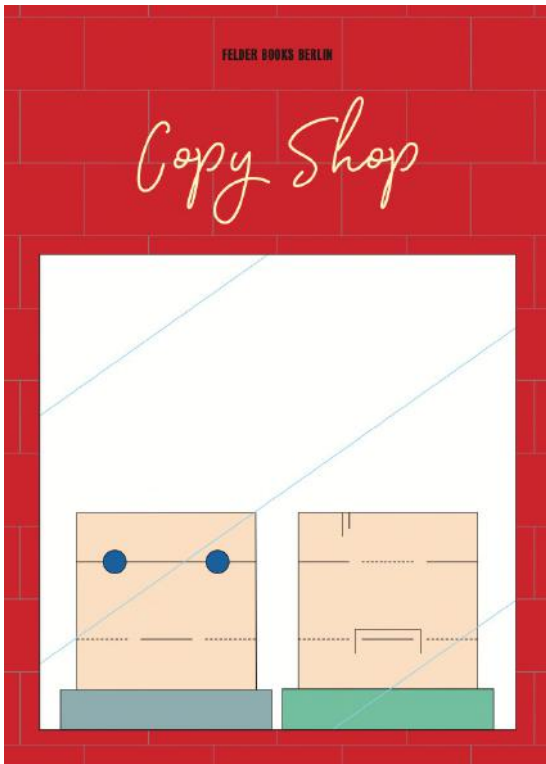

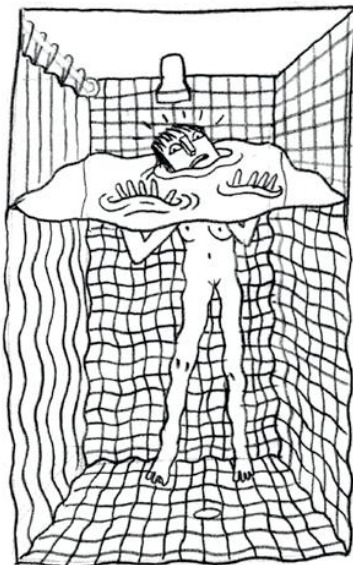
PANIC

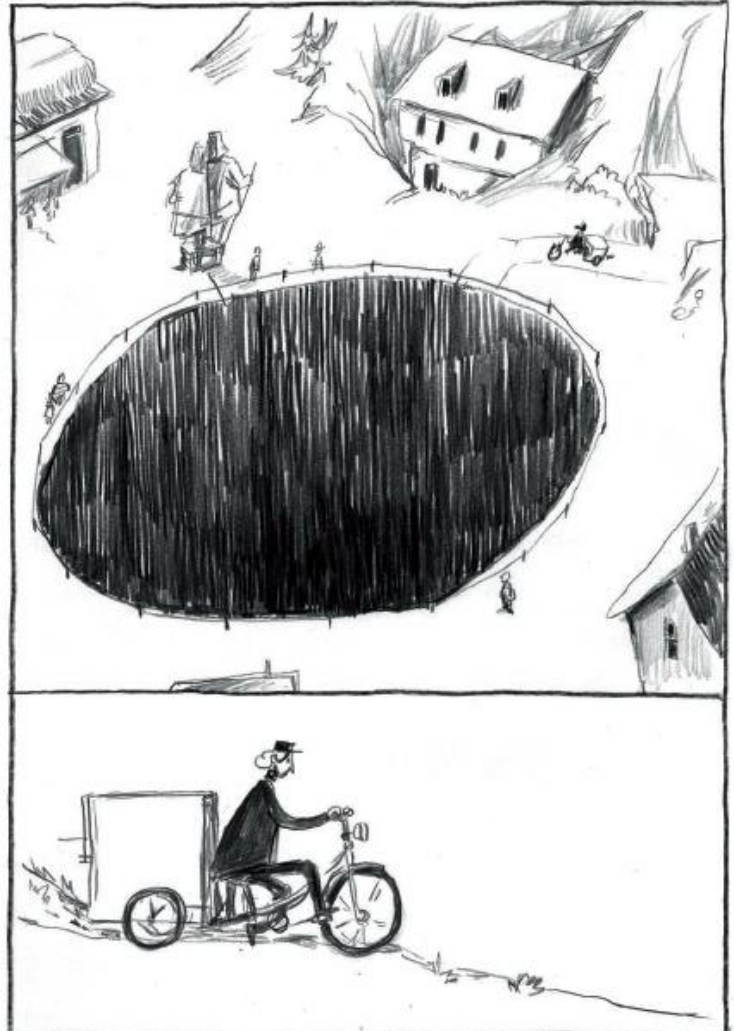

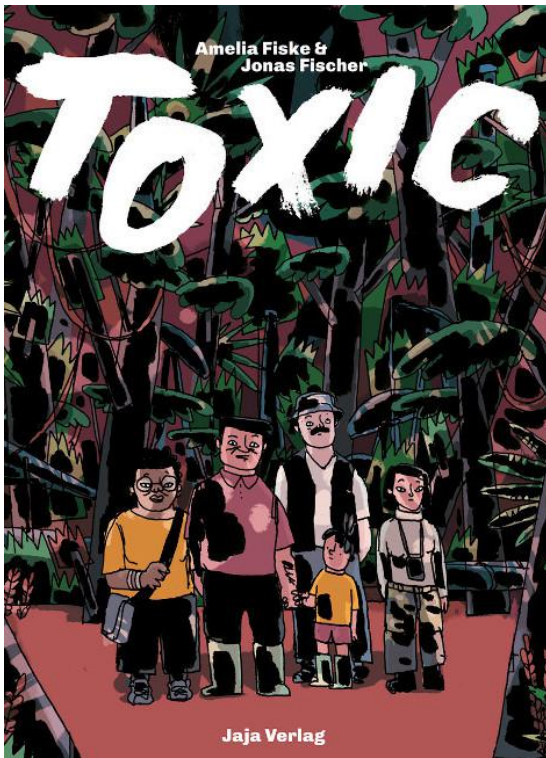

No consideration was given to damage to the environment or to the health of the indigenous population and the settlers, with whom the region was urbanized around the same time.

Donald Moncayo, an activist from Lago Agrio, offers guided tours for scientists, politicians, activists, tourists and journalists. During these "Toxic Tours", he shows active and inactive boreholes, poisoned areas and huge flames. Meanwhile he tells the story of the region and explains the practices of the oil companies.

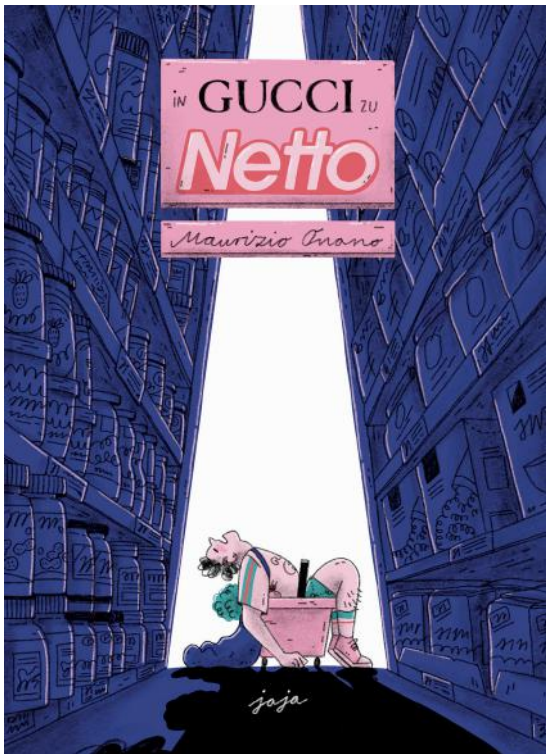

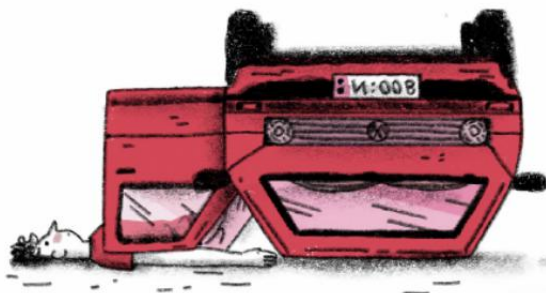


IN GUCCI at Netto

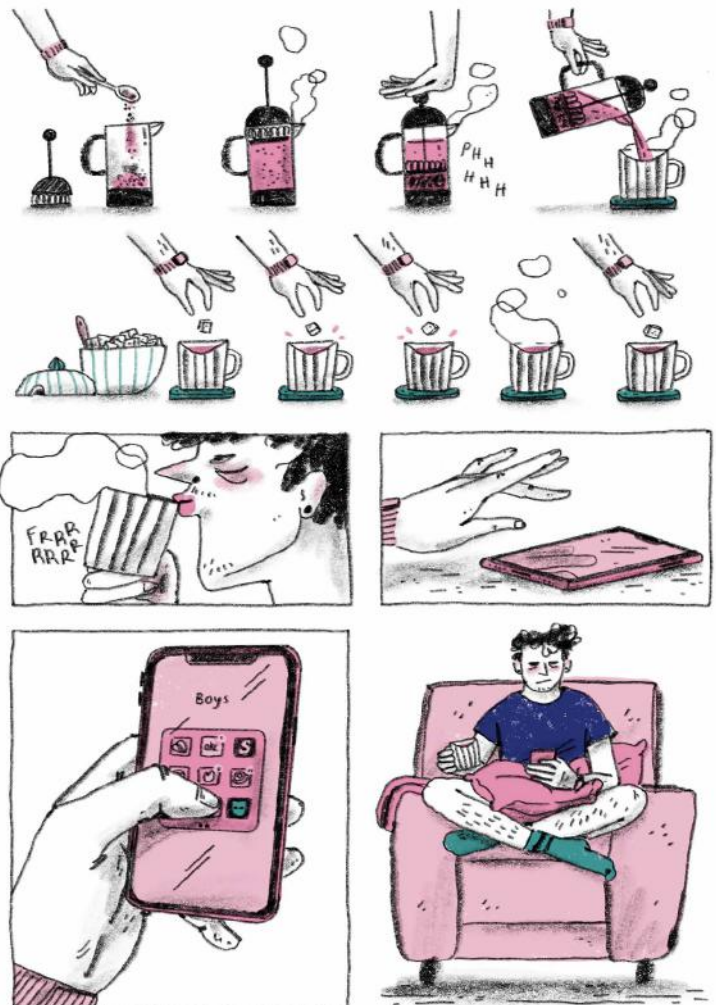


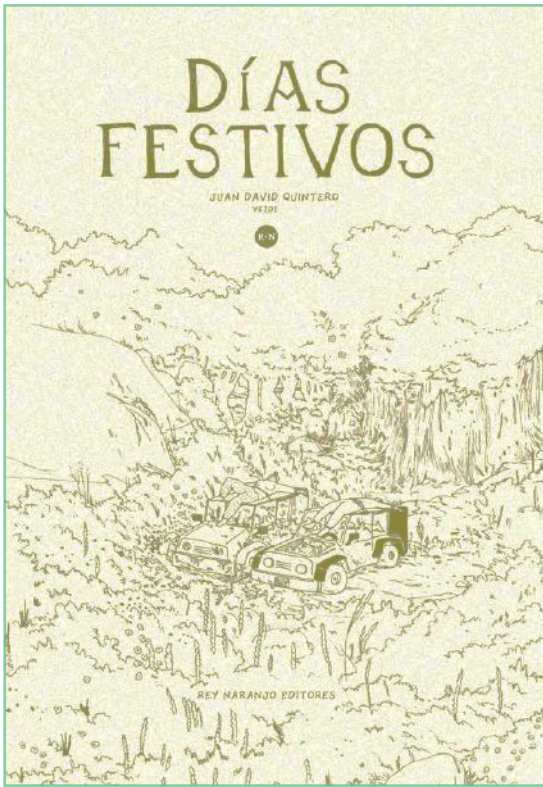
Maurizio was born in Lippstadt. He studied at the Folkwang University and never but never lost sight of his great (self-imposed) mission : to find out how the human clockwork ticks, why some turn the other way round, run faster or slower, are set to a different time zone or have stopped.

Fabian is in his mid-20s, a florist, gay, single who doesn't think much of himself. Lost, he stumbles from one humiliating one-night stand to the next, while his friends seem to have made the leap into adulthood and babies and weddings around him add to the inner pressure.

Maurizio Onano talks about his own experiences as a gay, single adult and the homophobia he is confronted with in everyday life.

Gender clichés and internalized sexism are parodied in the comic. The whole thing is charmingly packaged in a funny, modern dating story. With uninhibited dialog and uncensored imagery, Maurizio Onano gives even the most uninitiated heterosexual a little insight into the queer world of the 21st century.





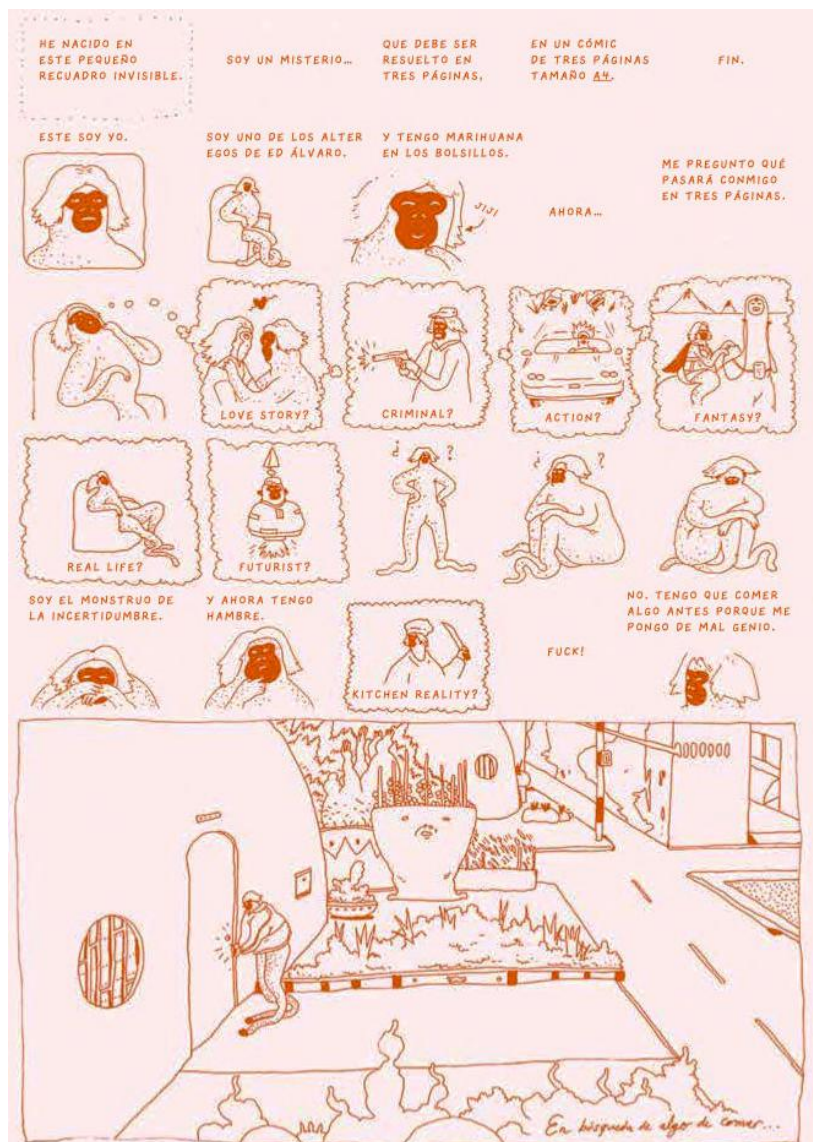
HOLIDAYS

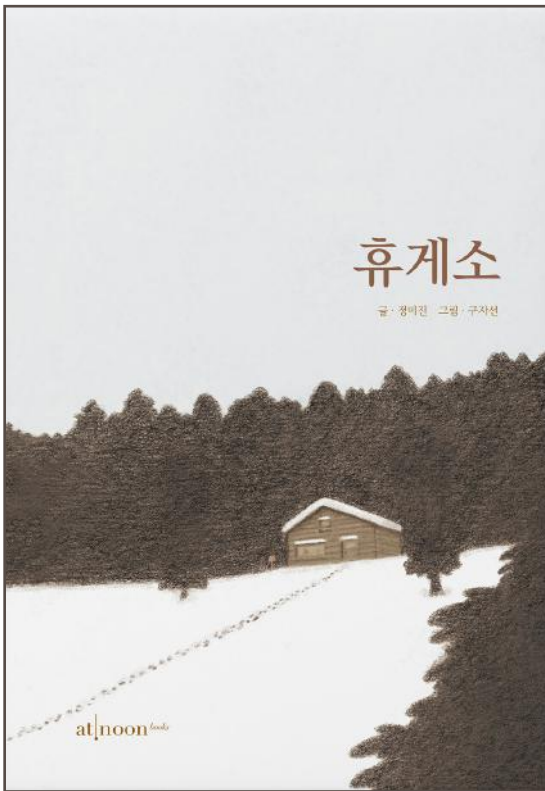

Here, the rather shy girl is suddenly on her own and has to learn to assert herself. But something feels strange and Jet tries to find out what exactly is going on with her. And very slowly she comes to the realization that she is perhaps more of a boy than a girl. But is that possible?

A beautiful, funny, authentic story, inspired by author's experiences and composed with a keen sense of the inconsistencies in the lives of teenagers facing up to adulthood. In addition, there is the topic of transgender identity, captured and treated with care, creating an empathetic, entertaining story with his light stroke and subtle use of colours.

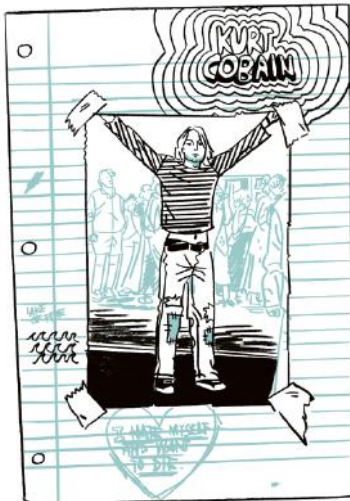

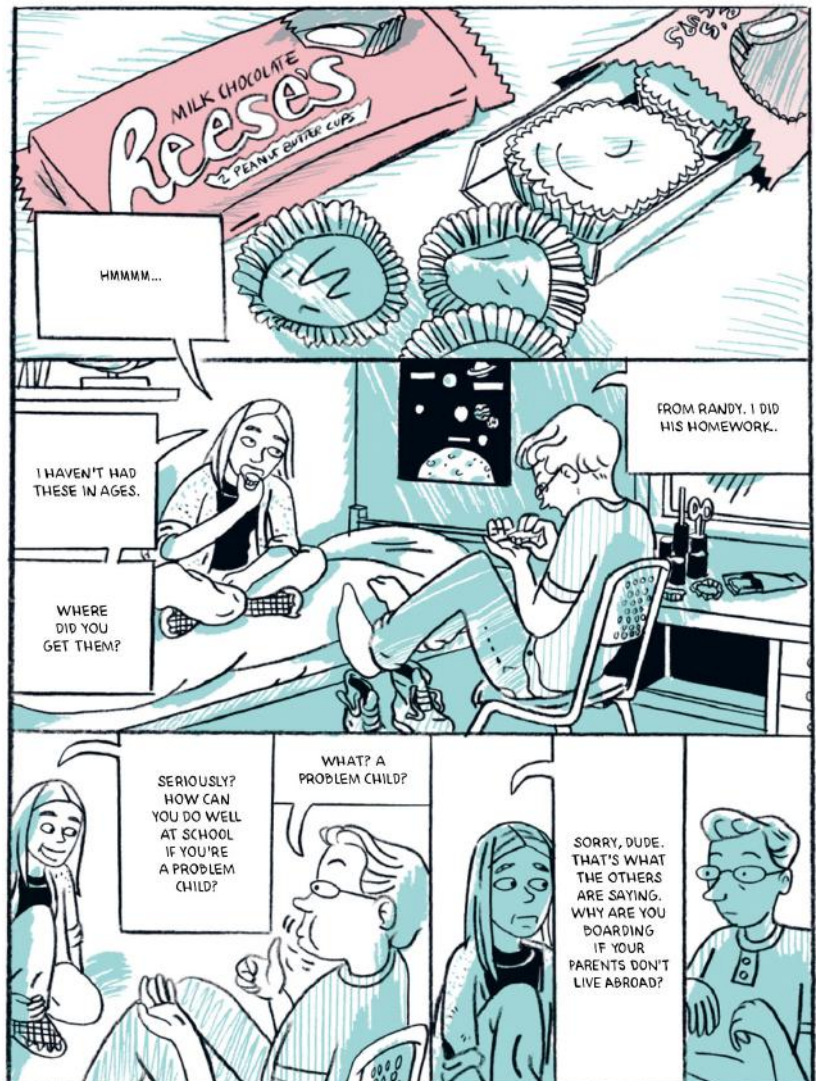

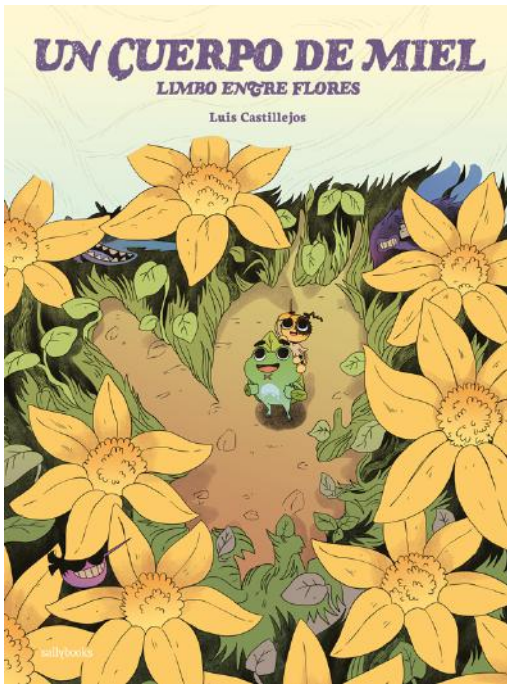
The character has not defined features. Following their everyday life, we'll witness that their walk leads them to review how they think and act within the territory.

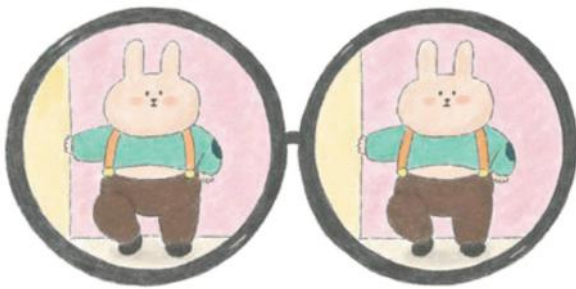
The Magic Glasses
