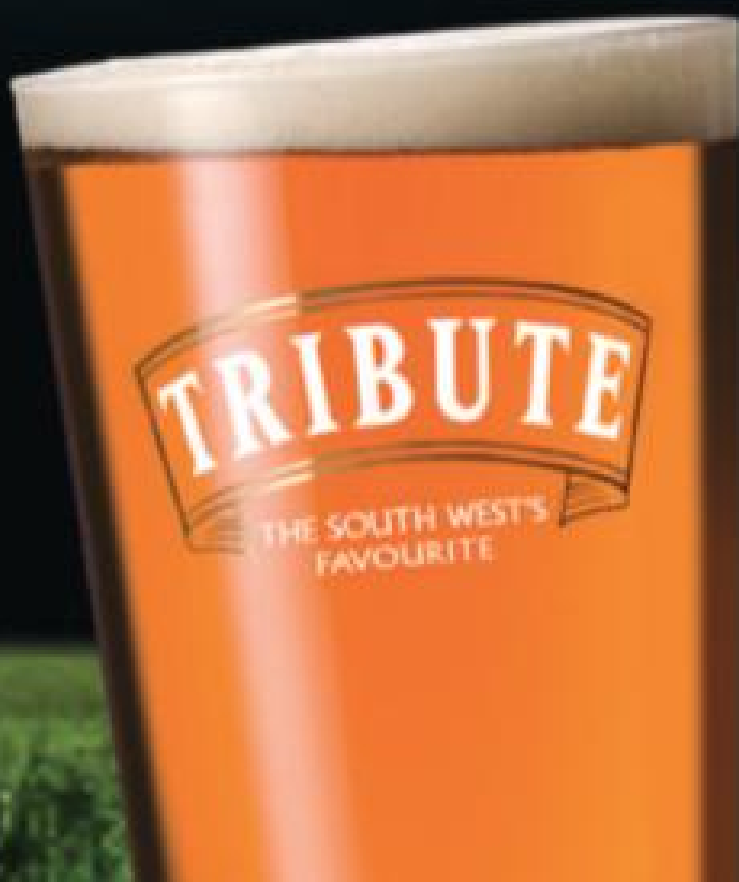

So please, make some noise, enjoy both finals — because they are going to be spectacular events — and soak up every minute of this brilliant day.

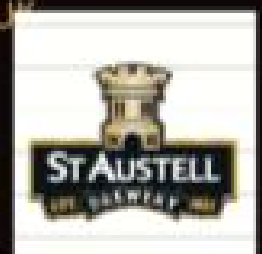

Good afternoon, and it's a pleasure to be here today at Barnstaple RFU for the final of the Devon RFC Intermediate Cup Final, and we look forward to a great game.

In the 1996–97 season, Barnstaple RFC won the Devon Senior Cup final against Okehampton RFC. The Result: Barnstaple 31 - 18 Okehampton. The match was played at the Showfield, in Okehampton. Okehampton, who were playing in the Western Counties league at the time, made a significant achievement by reaching the final, but lost to the overwhelming favourites, Barnstaple. This was one of two occasions where Okehampton hosted the final and lost, having also lost to Plymouth Albion in 1988.

Finishing fourth in Regional 2, we have narrowly missed out on promotion back to Level 5 while simultaneously integrating a wave of talented former Colts into our senior setup. A formidable home record, combined with a knack for winning high-scoring shootouts, has cemented us as one of the clear contenders to claim the Regional 2 title next season.

Impressive victories over close rivals Wadebridge and Tiverton have only strengthened our confidence heading into next year's campaign.

In the pack, veteran players such as Tom McGrattan continue to deliver dominant performances, while emerging leaders Sonny

Luxton and Brad Curtis are reaching significant cap milestones. Those players are now being bolstered by exciting county talent in the shape of players like Callum Arnold and Will Holland.

In the backline, the Horn brothers have once again showcased their try-scoring prowess, supported by the reliable boot of captain Luke Simmons, who has amassed an impressive 191 points across the season.

With former Plymouth Albion stalwart Brett Luxton secured to drive the club forward again next year, we are heading into the new season full of optimism.

Barnstaple Vets v Teignmouth Vets

After watching their side condemned to the bottom of the tournament table with a 25-15 defeat to Ireland at Lansdowne Road during the 1983 Five Nations Rugby, five England supporters seeking solace in a Dublin bar were presented with a wooden spoon, wrapped in an Irish scarf, on a silver platter.

Accepting the gift with good humour and grace, the group, which included Wooden Spoon's now-president Peter Scott, resolved to hold a golf match to see who would have the honour of keeping the tongue-in-cheek gift.

Just a few months later, the round at Farnham Golf Club in Surrey raised more than £8,500, with the money used to provide a new minibus for a local special needs school.

Stirred into action by a rugby routing, Wooden Spoon was born and they have been supporting disadvantaged and disabled children ever since. It is now a series of County based charities that sit across the whole of the United Kingdom and Ireland.

the Devon Vets league sponsored by the Wooden Spoon charity is for 'old hand' (35 and above) players to continue playing the game they love whilst supporting a children's charity. The Devon based charity seeks to use the fundraising done by Devon clubs to help disadvantaged children in Devon. The charity believes that every child regardless of their background should have access to the same opportunities.

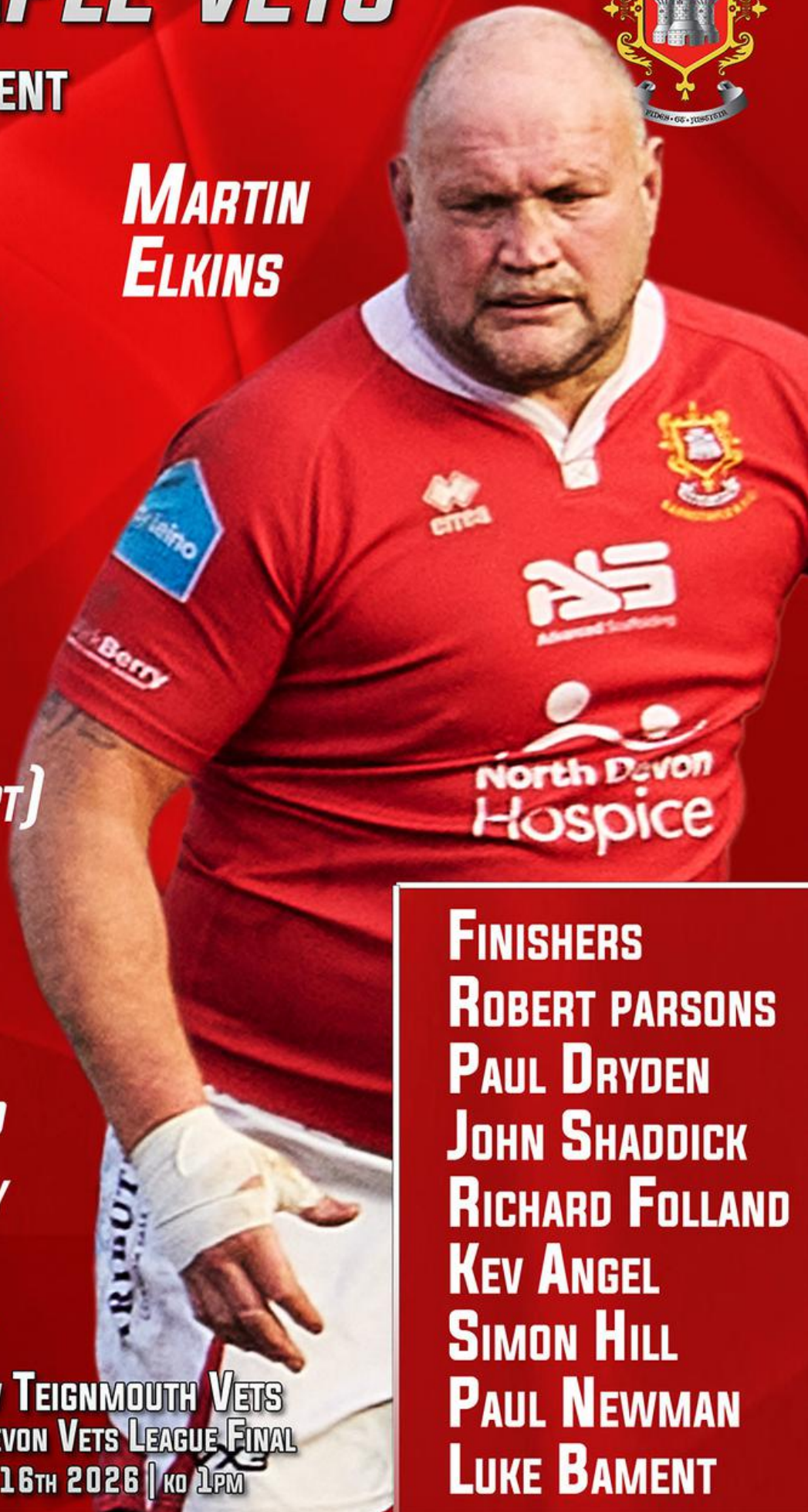
