
A UNIQUE IDENTITY


Ateneo de Manila is truly Filipino, devotedly Catholic, and uniquely Jesuit.


ACADEMICS

Interdisciplinary

BFA Theater Arts exposes students to the range of theater activities, onstage and offstage, all of which require an individual and collaborative intelligence and a passionate interest in theater.

The program is seen as a way to increase the number of trained men and women in theater practices, and to provide a venue for the development of theater artists who intend to apply their knowledge of the theater craft for further studies and/or for work in professional theater, film, radio, or television, or in other fields where its processes and skills are valued.

AB Humanities is designed for students who are interested in combining tracks in the Fine Arts (Art Management, Creative Writing, Information Design, Theater Arts); Foreign Language and Culture (Chinese, French, German, Spanish, Japanese or Korean Studies); History; Philosophy; Literature (in English or in Filipino); Music Literature; and Education.

The course provides students with a strong foundation in the humanities as a whole and offers the choice of integrating two to three areas of focus. Students are expected to develop a critical appreciation of the arts and letters and to engage in questions of creative expression from a holistic perspective.

AB Interdisciplinary Studies is designed to train students in integrating insights, methodologies, and theories from two programs selected from the following: Fine Arts (Art Management, Creative Writing, Information Design, Theater Arts), Foreign Language and Culture (Chinese, French, Japanese, Korean, Spanish, or German Studies), Literature (English or Filipino), Music Literature, Computer Science (Management Information Systems, Programming, Multimedia), Philosophy, History, Education, Economics, Management, Sociology, Political Science, Communication, and Psychology.

Students craft their program of study under the direction of an academic adviser, and are expected to develop a capacity for analyzing and addressing complex problems from a holistic perspective.





AB History



AB Economics and AB Economics (Honors) are programs designed to provide a strong foundation in theory and a discipline in quantitative methods to understand the operations of the modern economy, the processes of economic growth and development, and the dynamics of global integration.

The courses are rigorous but practical enough to allow applied analysis. In their senior year, students will undergo practicum in an accredited host training establishment. Alongside this, they would culminate their studies by writing a thesis in which they apply concepts and techniques in economics.

AB European Studies is a multidisciplinary program where students gain competence in a continental European language and analyze the continent's politics, economics, society, and culture. Special focus is given to the European integration process, as well as to the links between Europe and Asia. Students can take either of two specializations: (1) International Relations, or (2) Business and Economics.

The European Studies Program has produced alumni that have become prominent in numerous fields, including diplomacy, law, business, academia, and the advocacy of environmental and social justice issues in international organizations. Many successfully pursue successful careers outside of the Philippines.

History is the study of the continuity we share with all human experience, past and present. It also makes available to us a range of options as we deal with our present and with the future.

Our students learn not only to understand our present society against the background of the past, but also to analyze how this understanding is itself shaped by the changing cultural, socio-economic, political, and environmental contexts.



AB Management Economics is a program designed to provide a balanced foundation in both business and economics. The dual orientation is the strength of the program as recent events have shown that business survival depends on both sound internal management and a solid understanding of economic forces. In their senior year, students will undergo practicum in an accredited host training establishment.

In addition to this, students pursue a strategic business project in which they are expected to apply not just management skills but also integrate concepts in economics. AB Political Science provides its students with a solid background in international relations, comparative politics, political theory, public management, and public law. The program is designed to train students in critical and analytical thinking and leadership required for studies in law and careers in government and development.

BS Applied Mathematics - Master in Data Science is Ateneo's response to the complex challenges of the 21st century, harnessing the abundance and the power of data. Students are equipped with strong mathematical, computational, and critical thinking skills to use data to make scientific analyses, draw conclusions, make decisions, and ultimately to do good.

Students obtain their BS Applied Mathematics (with Specialization in Data Science) degree after 4 years, and subject to academic requirements of the programme, may proceed to the Master in Data Science programme in the 5th year.

BS Applied Physics - BS Materials Science and Engineering Program is a 4.5-year doubledegree program that prepares students for new technologies. It provides a strong foundation on the physics of materials with courses on the fundamental laws involving the structure of matter, and radiation, with specialized electives on materials.

BS Biology is a 4-year honors program that provides an excellent training in the biological disciplines where specialized courses can be chosen as electives. Students choose from among four areas of specialization, namely: Biomedical Science, Cell and Molecular Biology, Ecology and Systematics, and Microbiology. Students are given rigorous training through innovative lecture and laboratory courses that are in line with the department's research thrusts and through the undergraduate Thesis and Practicum.



Core courses provide an intensive background in writing complex software systems and the design and interconnection of computers. The 4.5-year BS Electronics Engineering program aims to train engineers who have a competent grasp of both the science and technology of modern electronics and telecommunication. The students participate in research projects that demand scientific rigor and technical skills that are demonstrated within an environment of innovation and entrepreneurship.

A first for the Philippines, the 4-year BS Innovation Design Engineering program aims to produce world-class design engineers. Multidisciplinary courses prepare students to become futureready, with subjects covering aeronautical, chemical, civil, computer, electrical, electronics, industrial, marine, materials and mechanical engineering. Complementing technical aptitude with organizational skills, students gain experience in project management and implementation through community engagements, academic output and work placements. Globalization and cross-cultural learning are essential aspects of student formation, with the program including a mandatory academic year spent abroad at a partner university.





BS Health Sciences is a 4-year honors program that seamlessly prepares students for further training in the Ateneo School of Medicine and Public Health and in other institutions offering medical and public health education. To provide holistic orientation to health, the 163-unit curriculum is an integration of the Ignatian thrust in education and the fundamental, scientific, and technical background necessary for entry in the health sciences as well as of the disciplines that intrinsically influence the health sector.

BS Life Sciences is a 4-year honors program that provides an exciting, dynamic, and highly interdisciplinary application-based approach to the life sciences. 

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


Information Technology Entrepreneurship







ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

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APPLYING TO ATENEO

Admission to Ateneo de Manila University is open to qualified young individuals, regardless of nationality, creed, gender, residence, or financial capability.

Admission to Ateneo's college programs is determined by the applicant's fitness and preparation for undergraduate study; ability to contribute toward the enrichment of the Ateneo academic community; and potential to be of service to others.

The Committee on Admission and Aid is responsible for selecting the new members of the student body. It bases its decisions principally on the applicant's past academic performance, on the recommendations of teachers, and on information in the application form.

The admission cycle takes almost a year. Applicants are highly encouraged to apply as early as August while in their 12th Grade in senior high school.

Your Path to Admission

STEP 1: PREPARATION

All applications for admission into Ateneo College are filed at the Ateneo College Application Portal (ateneo.edu/college/apply). Review your degree program and scholarship options carefully. Prepare all the required supporting documents beforehand. Depending on your school and graduation status, you will belong to a particular applicant type.

- You are considered a **first year applicant** if you are still in the last year of senior high school.
- If you have already graduated from senior high school, you will be considered a **first year applicant** if you have not yet taken any college or university units/courses before and/or during the application period.
- You are considered a **transfer applicant** if you have already taken units/courses in college or university.
- You are considered a **local applicant** if you are studying in, or graduated from, a school inside the Philippines
- You are considered an **international applicant** if you are studying in, or graduated from, a school outside the Philippines.

STEP 2: APPLICATION AND TESTING

There are several application pathways, depending on your applicant type.

Fill out the application form and upload your supporting documents in the Application Portal. The application portal will contain more detailed information on the requirements. You may then Ateneo College Entrance Test (ACET), if applicable, at your scheduled date.

STEP 3: PROCESSING AND REVIEW

Admission to Ateneo de Manila University's college degree programs is determined by the applicant's fitness and preparation for college, ability to contribute toward the enrichment of the undergraduate school community, and potential to be of service to others within the context of national development.

The Committee on Admission and Aid is responsible for selecting the new members of the student body. It bases its decisions principally on the applicant's past academic performance, ACET test scores, the recommendations of teachers, essay, and on information written down on the application form..

STEP 4: ADMISSION

Results will be released directly to your registered email. You will get one of three decisions: accepted, waitlisted, or not accepted. Once you are offered a place in the incoming first year batch, you will be asked to confirm your slot. You will become an official student once you enroll for the first semester.

Financing Your Ateneo Education

TUITION & FEES

Tuition and fees are charged on a semestral basis. For School Year 2024-2025, you may find the average tuition and fees charged per semester, in Philippine Pesos, below:.

Tuition 104,420Basic Fees 16,574Other Fees 7,200

Additional fees are charged for laboratory use, or for overload, depending on the student's program of study.

Tuition and Fees may be paid through online payment facilities of major banks or over-the-counter transactions. Students may pay in two or four installments. Payment methods and schedules are made available during enrollment.

Kindly note that the fees indicated above may vary depending on the degree program that the applicant plans to pursue. The fees for the degree programs under the School of Science and Engineering are slightly higher compared to other degree programs because of their laboratory fees.

SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

We believe that everyone has the right to receive quality education and Ateneo is here to help.

Scholarships for deserving but financially challenged students continue to thrive - thanks to the university's firm commitment and the constant support of many generous alumni and other benefactors. One out of every four college students enjoys a form of scholarship or financial aid support.

There are several categories of scholarships available: merit, academic, athletic, financial aid, and government and private.

ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIPS

An academic scholarship recognizes a student's great promise and a vast potential to contribute and enrich the university community and the Philippines. In and through them, Ateneo de Manila hopes to continue its tradition of excellence in academics and service to God and nation.

MAGIS SCHOLARSHIP

The Magis Scholarship is an all-expensespaid scholarship designed to help the most financially-constrained but deserving students receive a world-class, holistic college education and formation in Ateneo. It covers the following:

- ▶ All-expenses-paid college scholarship
- ▶ 100% tuition and fees for any 4 or 5-year course
- ▶ Food and living allowance
- Books, supplies, and printing allowance
- Dormitory scholarship or transportation allowance
- ▶ Miscellaneous allowance for other needs
- Round-trip airfare every semester (as applicable)
- ► Cellphone and laptop provision (given)

The scholarship is open to all incoming college students who have demonstrated excellence in academic and non-academic endeavors, and have the potential to become the servant-leaders our future truly needs.



MERIT SCHOLARSHIPS

The top applicants in each first year batch are awarded the **Ateneo Merit Scholarship.** For SY 2025-26, the award will be based on their performance in the ACET and their individual academic performances and leadership roles in their respective senior high schools.

The recipients of the Ateneo Freshman Merit Scholarship (AFMS) are identified as the top 60 first year applicants.

The recipients of this scholarship can take any four or five-year degree program of their choice. They are awarded a full tuition and fees grant and a P50,000 annual allowance. In addition, those from outside Metro Manila will receive an additional transportation allowance and an on-campus dormitory scholarship.


DIRECTOR'S LIST SCHOLARSHIP


FR THOMAS B STEINBUGLÉR SJ ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

ATHLETIC SCHOLARSHIPS

Athletic Athletic scholarships are awarded to student-athletes who have excelled in sports and academics. Applicants who wish to enter Ateneo through an athletic scholarship must coordinate with the Ateneo de Manila University Athletics Office.

Aside from being financially challenged, applicants must have outstanding athletic ability and must be a recipient of awards in their specific sport. Applicants must also secure the recommendation of the Ateneo coach and program head for their sport.

SCHOLARSHIPS FOR WOMEN

GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE SCHOLARSHIPS

All applicants are encouraged to take qualifying examinations given by various government agencies, private groups, or foundations, specifically, Science Education Institute of the Department of Science and Technology (DOST-SEI), the Commission on Higher Education (CHED), and the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS). Awardees may come to Ateneo under such scholarships.

FINANCIAL AID GRANTS

For more than six decades now, the Ateneo College Scholarship Program for deserving but financially challenged students continues to thrive. Financial aid grants are awarded to students in all programs of undergraduate study in Ateneo.

With limited slots each year, financial aid grantees are selected on the basis of the following general criteria:

- Financial need as clearly evident in the scholarship/financial aid questionnaire
- Intellectual ability and proven consistent academic performance
- Service to the community and potential for greater service in the future

APPLYING FOR SCHOLARSHIPS AND FINANCIAL AID

Scholarship and financial aid applications do not influence in any way the decision concerning acceptance into college. Applicants, therefore, should not wait for the decision on their application for admission before securing or submitting a scholarship application form.

LIVING IN METRO MANILA

FOR STUDENTS FROM OUTSIDE METRO MANILA

Most Ateneo students who come from outside Metro Manila stay in the vicinity of the Loyola Heights campus, either in on-campus residences, off-campus housing, condominiums, or rental houses, either on their own, with friends. Many also live with family or relatives, which significantly lowers the cost of living.

The cost of living will depend on your housing situation and your lifestyle. Your budget should take into account housing and utilities (electricity, water, and communications); food; clothing; transportation; daily educational expenses such as purchase school supplies and printing; and other expenses, such as entertainment and leisure.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

VISA MATTERS

If accepted, international students must inquire from the Philippine Embassy/Consulate at their country of origin for student visa requirements and processing.

The Office of International Relations handles all foreign student matters, including assisting you with visas and documentation requirements.
