

JOINING FORCES




In 2014, we officially became the first Government recognized safe home on the Thai Burma Border, partnering with the Kingdom of Thailand on behalf of vulnerable, trafficked, and exploited children. They quickly adopted our Prevent, Rescue, and Heal model, wrote a book about it and patterned it along the borders of Thailand!

In 2022, we recommitted to join forces with the government and other local NGO's that are doing rescue work on the Multidisciplinary Task Force. We are a part of this large, government recognized, anti-trafficking network that continues the fight to protect the borders where as many as 60 women and children are trafficked daily and to rescue as many children as possible.

We also renewed our contract with the government to be the government recognized safe home (watchtower) for our border. We are a voice for the voiceless and vulnerable not only for their rescue but also their placement and future!

One cold night, their father beat Wan and Su so badly that they ran for their lives. These little survivors had to run almost 13 miles to get to the closest hospital.

The hospital called us the next morning and we picked them up and brought them to where they will be safe forever!

YOUNG GIRL RESCUED

AND GIVEN A NEW LIFE



Abandoned by her mother when she was barely a year old, this innocent little girl was left to be raised by her alcoholic father until she was eight.

He would work daily labor jobs and sometimes wouldn't even come home at night, leaving her alone in an open-air hut with only her dogs to keep her company and protect her. When the father did come home, he was often drunk and would bring his friends home with him where the drinking would continue.

The environment this girl was forced to live in was an incredibly dangerous one.

In addition to her terrible home life, she has never been to school or received any kind of education at all. Because she was left alone all the time and had little to no outside interaction, she simply did not know how to respond to normal human interaction.

It will be a place of healing, wholeness, security, hope, and Jesus for the beautiful children of Burma!
