## SHIFTING LANDSCAPES BUILDING THE HOLISTIC TREATMENT MOSAIC

Service deliverers are becoming increasingly aware that to deal with consumer needs and complexity effectively, a holistic approach can bring significant benefits. The recent Royal Commissions into Victoria's Mental Health System and Family Violence have prioritised reform headlined by holistic approaches. This includes implementing reforms to embrace the intersection of multiple issues and the means to address them. Focusing narrowly on formal diagnosis or treatment plans, be it in mental health, family violence or other areas, fails to address the complexities impacting an individual's circumstances.

## PRACTICE ENGAGEMENT EDUCATION

& RISK (PEER)

#### WHAT IS THE PROGRAM?

PEER is an education initiative designed to assist opioid prescribers and practice teams to optimise prescriber capacity and patient care.

**PRACTICE ENGAGEMENT** - Orticare can visit your practice and discuss how we can support you as an opioid and/or MATOD prescriber. This discussion may include referral pathways, resources, clinical mentors and changes in policy and practice.

**EDUCATION** - One of the main ways we support practitioners is by providing quality, evidence-based, education. The PEER activity will optimise safe prescribing by assisting prescribers to identify at-risk patients and potential treatment options. As an RACGP CPD Accredited Activity, the education component will earn you 40 CPD points. The five hour activity includes an online learning module and case study discussion.

**RISK** - A short clinical audit can be conducted, this will inform the education component of the activity. This also attracts 40 RACGP CPD points, giving you the opportunity to earn 80 CPD points in total, while identifying risk and improving patient care.

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# TRENDS IN THE AVAILABILITY OF DRUGS SOLD ON THE INTERNET VIA CRYPTOMARKETS

From 1st October 2021 to 30th September 2022, 27 cryptomarkets were monitored, of which 11 closed before the end of the reporting period. We began monitoring 10 new cryptomarkets during this period.

Cannabis comprised the greatest percentage drugs listings from October 2021 to September 2022 (30%), followed by cocaine benzodiazepines (7.6%),**MDMA** (7.5%),(7.5%),meth/amphetamine (illicit) (6.1%), opioids (excluding heroin) (6.1%)and PIEDs/weight loss drugs (6.1%).

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## COVID-19 WITH ENDOCARDITIS IN PATIENTS WITH COCAINE OR OPIOID USE DISORDERS IN THE US

The incidence of endocarditis in the US is increasing, driven in part by the rise in intravenous drug use, mostly opioids and stimulant drugs (cocaine and methamphetamine). Recent reports have documented that individuals with COVID-19 are at increased risk for cardiovascular diseases. However, it is unknown whether COVID-19 is associated with increased risk for endocarditis in patients with opioid or stimulant use disorders.


A fixture of the Australian drug landscape for over half a century, cannabis is our most widely consumed illicit drug. Despite its prevalence, a lack of reliable data paired with conflicting messages from our government and media mean that community understandings of cannabis remain poor. What are the health risks of cannabis use? Is there a viable market for medicinal cannabis?

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# CHANGE TO CLASSIFICATION OF PSILOCYBIN & MDMA TO ENABLE PRESCRIBING BY AUTHORISED PSYCHIATRISTS

From 1 July this year, medicines containing the psychedelic substances psilocybin and (3,4-methylenedioxy-**MDMA** methamphetamine) can prescribed by specifically authorised psychiatrists for the treatment of certain mental health conditions.

The Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) will permit the prescribing of MDMA for the treatment of post-traumatic stress disorder and psilocybin for treatment-resistant depression. These are the only conditions where there is currently sufficient evidence for potential benefits in certain patients.
