

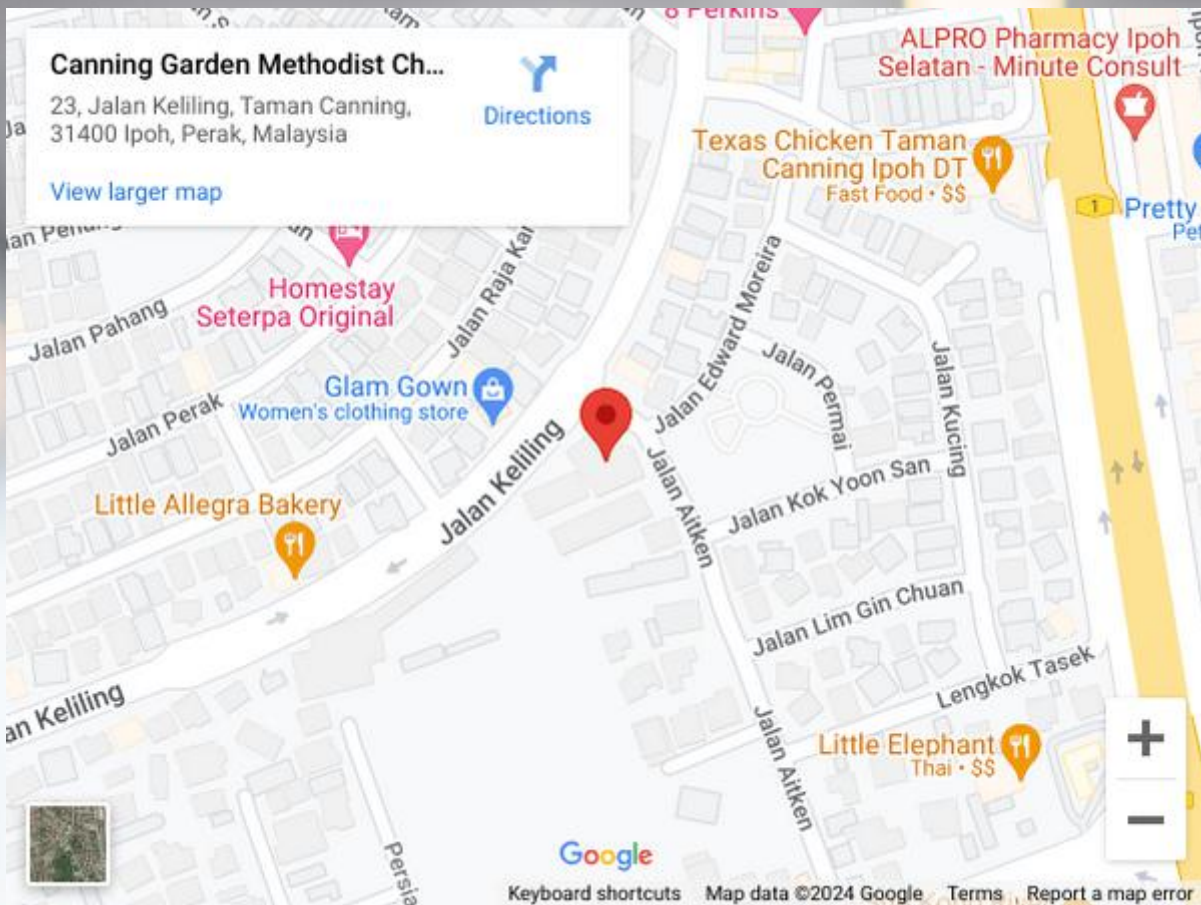

# CELL GROUPS

Worship flaggers help shift the spiritual atmosphere, making each dance a beautiful offering to the Lord. Worship movements are meant to focus on the Lord rather than the dancer performing them.

The colors of each flag carry specific meanings. For instance, red symbolizes the blood of Christ, signifying His love and redemption, while purple represents royalty, kingship, majesty, and divine authority.

# HOPE HAEMODIALYSIS SOCIETY

Hope Haemodialysis is dedicated to providing high-quality haemodialysis treatment to disadvantaged individuals afflicted with Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) and/or End-Stage Renal Disease (ESRD), driven by their deep sense of compassion.

As a charitable organization, Hope Haemodialysis depends on donations from kind-hearted individuals, financial support from Canning Garden Methodist Church, and subsidies granted by the Ministry of Health to sustain its vital services.

Patients who face financial difficulties receive assistance through a subsidy program that covers the expenses associated with additional injections and medications.

The center is staffed by qualified nurses with specialized training in renal care, and volunteer doctors from CGMC visit the facility on a regular basis.

# PERSATUAN DAYBREAK

Established in 1992 by the Canning Garden Methodist Church and officially recognized by the Registrar of Societies in 1996, Daybreak is a charitable organization that enjoys tax-exempt status.

The acronym DAYBREAK stands for Disabled Adults and Youths Being Rewarded, Encouraged, and Accepted in Kinta.

Daybreak's primary focus is to provide support and assistance to individuals with physical, learning, or mental disabilities. Since its inception, Daybreak has successfully registered over 1,000 trainees in its programs, many of whom have secured meaningful employment. Notably, trainees are not required to pay any fees for the duration of their two-year training period.

# LIGHTHOUSE HOPE

The Lighthouse Hope Society (LHS) has come a long way since its humble beginnings 17 years ago. Reaching out to the hungry, homeless and helpless in our society has been such a joy with provision of free meals, free medical care, haircuts, clothing, shower facilities, counseling and drug rehabilitation assistance.

This work would not be possible without the Vineyard Keepers who assist in cooking and cleaning of our soup kitchen, our volunteer medical doctors, hairdressers and meal servers who have given their time, effort and prayers towards this labor of love.

An expanding part of the LHS are the Orang Asli Economic Empowerment Projects in providing fruit saplings along with chicken rearing.

Additionally, we have embarked on providing free solar lighting installation for kampungs without electricity under our "LightUp Our Kampung " solar project. We are so thankful to God for leading us to where we today in reaching out the needy in our society.
