

6-9 Months Before:


- **Coordinate Groomsmen:** Choose outfits for your groomsmen and arrange gifts for them.

We wanted a timeless and elegant look with a modern, luxurious flair, and thanks to our suppliers, we achieved it.




7. Please discuss your choice of flowers and décor, etc.

11. Briefly list or describe your wedding highlights.








13. Please share any of your most unique wedding ideas and advice with our readers.
