V'Shavu Banim L'Gvulam: A History of the Modern Borders of Israel

Thereafter, Wednesdays: November 13th; November 20th and December 4th



Although the State of Israel was established in 1948, its borders began to take shape as early as 1906. The state's southern, northern, and eastern borders have fluctuated over time. Factors influencing these changes have included UN resolutions, demographic shifts, bilateral negotiations, military conquest, and occasional military failure This four-part series will cover: a) the southern frontier with Egypt and Gaza (and Saudi Arabia), b) the northern border with Lebanon and Syria, c) the eastern border with Jordan

and the PA, and **d**) the unique status of Jerusalem. This course will raise critical questions in the study of modern Israel: What are the territorial aims of Zionism? How did those ideological goals impact state policy?

As Co-Founder & CEO of the MirYam Institute, Benjamin Anthony brings considerable experience and expertise to his position in the areas of substantive, policy-driven dialogue and debate about the State of Israel throughout the international community. Rescued hostage Almog Meir Jan has spoken of the emotional and mental support he shared with fellow captives while they were held in the Gaza Strip,

including keeping up their spirits by reminding each other daily of the things they were thankful for. Almog spent eight months in Hamas captivity, from his abduction from the Nova music festival by the terror group on October 7th to his rescue by Israel security forces on June 8th, from an apartment in central Gaza.

Rav Shay Schachter currently serves as Rabbi and Rosh Beit Midrash at the Young Israel of Woodmere, overseeing its extensive adult educational programs. He is the Rabbi and spiritual leader of Yachad, the Orthodox Union's international program for individuals with disabilities. Since the summer of 2017 he has served as the Rabbi of Camp Simcha, Chai Lifeline's camp for children battling cancer and chronic illnesses. He formally served as

the Assistant Rabbi at Congregation Knesseth Israel "The White Shul" in Far Rockaway, from 2012 – 2015. Rav Shay received his rabbinic ordination from RIETS after studying together with his father, Rabbi Hershel Schachter, for 9 years. He also received an additional Rabbinic ordination from his teacher and mentor, Rabbi Asher Weiss of Jerusalem. Rav Shay holds an MA in Jewish Education and Administration from the Azrieli Graduate School of Yeshiva University. Rav Shay has been at the forefront of advocacy efforts and support for hostages and their families in DC, at the UN, and around the world. We will be joined by YIS Chazzan Johnny Shlagbaum for this Shabbat.

Nadav Eyal is one of Israel's most prominent journalists and a winner of the Sokolov Award—Israel's equivalent of the Pulitzer Prize. He writes columns for *Yediot Ahronot* and Ynet, Israel's most widely circulated newspaper and news website, respectively. He also serves as a senior commentator for Channel 12, one of Israel's two commercial channels. Beginning on October 7, 2023, he has focused his work on stories and analyses related to the Hamas attack and the subsequent war in Gaza and the northern border of Israel,

including reporting multiple times from the field and writing the accounts of victims. Nadav has been a regular guest on Dan Senor's popular "Call Me Back" podcast. **We will be joined by YIS Chazzan Mordy Weinstein for this Shabbat.**
