Hae eHa HIRE AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE 2025

HIRE AWARDS OF EXCELLENCE 2025

Two new award categories introduced as the industry comes together to celebrate achievements.

he Grosvenor House Hotel
at Park Lane in London
once again served as
the venue for all those
in the hire industry, along with
their suppliers, partners and
colleagues, to come together for a
key industry event – the 2025 Hire
Awards of Excellence.

The annual event hosted by Hire Association Europe and Event Hire Association (HAE EHA), celebrated the outstanding achievements of individuals and hire companies whom judges felt had gone 'above and beyond' in their offering to clients, staff and the industry as a whole over the past year.

The awards gave a much-deserved opportunity to acknowledge those whom the judges felt had consistently stood out from the crowd since the last event in April

2024, by achieving some of the highest standards in the hire sector.

HAE EHA Chair, Phil Leahy, who has spent more than 40 years working in the hire industry, said: "The Hire Awards of Excellence is a celebration of our industry at its best, and all the finalists and winners are playing their unique part in helping to move the economy forward, supporting the building of homes, roads, cities - the very foundations of modern life. Well done to all."

HAE EHA CEO Paul Gaze went on to add: "This was a fantastic celebration of the excellence within the hire and rental sector. We had some inspiring finalists across the business and various product and service categories. However, the individual award finalists were truly a credit to themselves, their families, and their employers."

New categories

This year marked the first occasion that two awards were handed out for outstanding achievement. After introducing himself as the new HAE EHA Chair, Phil Leahy, who has spent more than 40 years working in the hire industry, said: it gives me great pleasure to recognise individuals who have made a lasting contribution to the hire and rental sector and this year is something quite extraordinary. For the first time, we are recognising not one, but two, individuals who have each made a significant impact in their respective fields."

He then presented Phil Hemsworth from HSS with the Outstanding Contribution to Hire and Lord Bamford of JCB with the newly-launched Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence.

Paying tribute to the attributes of both winners, he described Phil as "a tremendous contributor to the wider hire industry" and said Lord Bamford's leadership had led to JCB becoming "a global manufacturing powerhouse whose machines are used by nearly every hire company across the UK and Ireland".

As Lord Bamford was in the Caribbean on the night of the awards presentation, Paul Mabey of JCB accepted his award in his place.

Another new award category was introduced for 2025 recognising Health and Safety Champions.

Chairman Paul Gaze said: "These HSEQ individuals and teams make a significant difference to your organisations but at times their contribution may be overlooked."

Achievements and work acknowledged

Hosted by actor Alex MacQueen, the 2025 event was attended by people from the UK's plant, tool, equipment and event hire sectors, who came together to support the finalists and learn who the ultimate winners



were, while the evening's finalists were made up of outstanding individuals, companies and products, across 18 award categories.

Chairman Paul Gaze spoke about the Hire Association's achievements over the past year when he took to the stage to address all those present.

He noted that 2024 had marked the 50th anniversary of the organisation, with two of the founding six committee members, Mike Dingley-Jones and Andy Griggs joining a celebratory event, of which he played a video.

Speaking about the past year's activities, he outlined the lobbying work carried out with governments, agencies and law enforcement bodies by Director of Public Affairs Mark Bradshaw and spoke about the recently-launched Crime Portal on the HAE EHA website, which allows information to be shared and viewed in a secure area.

He went on to talk about the work carried out by Director of Certification Services Carl Bartlett and his team, who are delivering a range of accreditations such as SafeHire, SSIP and HITS.





"Carl is working with members to look at additional developments and enhancements to SafeHire. This will include reviewing opportunities to recognise additional accreditations and is in addition to the enhancements already completed to the Certification Services Integrated Management System, streamlining the desktop audit and improving the overall audit experience," said Paul.

At last year's awards former Chairman Neil Bravery had reflected on his three years in the role, but this year he attended in a different capacity, having become the association's new Commercial Director in September.

"Neil has transformed the business and brought in more than 30 years' previous experience in the hire sector leading both independent hirers and working for the nationals," said Paul. "Neal has created a real buzz and made sure the offer to all of our members is both relevant and valued."

Paul went on to speak about ongoing conflict in Eastern Europe and the support HAE EHA members have provided to assist the people of Ukraine in their time of need.

"Hopefully, a meaningful resolution can be found to end the suffering and bring lasting peace," he said.

A solid history

Having first been staged in London since 2008, the awards ceremony had to be held virtually in 2020 and 2021 because of the Covid-19 outbreak but returned to a successful in-person format in 2022 and has continued to grow in popularity since then.

The Hire Awards of Excellence event is an award-winner itself, having previously been awarded 'Best Longstanding Event By An Association' gong at the Association Excellence Awards.

The HAE EHA event has grown and evolved since its inception and is now regarded as an outstanding example that is professionally produced and sustainably funded. <<

DOUBLE-DOSE OF OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENTS

Chair pays tribute to the health and safety legend and "industry visionary" who were the recipients of this year's Outstanding Contribution to Hire award and Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence.

Chair of HAE EHA, Phil Leahy, took to the stage to announce that 2025 would see two, instead of one, awards being handed out to those who had made a lasting contribution to the hire and rental sector.

"This year is something quite extraordinary because, for the first time, we are recognising not one, but two, individuals who have each made a significant impact in their respective fields," he said.

First, he invited Phil Hemsworth from HSS to join him on the stage. Having joined the hire sector in 1979, Phil's 46-year career began as a fitter. He progressed through the roles of branch manager, area manager and logistics leadership positions before joining the HSEQ team.

"For the last 12 years, he's led the way in health, safety, environmental and quality," said Phil Leahy. "He's ensured safety is more than just a policy. It's part of the business culture."

Phil Hemsworth has been a key player within the Hire Association, serving on the Technical Health & Safety Committee, including time as Chairperson, and has mentored many HSEQ professionals across the sector.

Phil Leahy said he had helped to raise the bar for safety across the industry.

A Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence was then awarded to Lord Bamford, Chairman of JCB. As he was unable to attend in person, the award was accepted by Paul Mabey of JCB.

Phil described Lord Bamford as "a visionary who has quite literally changed the face of our industry".

"His organisation has been a long-standing, active member of the HAE and, under his leadership, has become a global manufacturing powerhouse. His machines are used by nearly every hire company across the UK and Ireland," said Phil.

Paying tribute to the JCB magnate's passion for progress, Phil said he had driven the development of battery-powered equipment and led the way in hydrogen-powered machines.

"He is an industry icon. It is a privilege to present the very first Lifetime Achievement Award for Excellence to Lord Bamford," he said. <<




