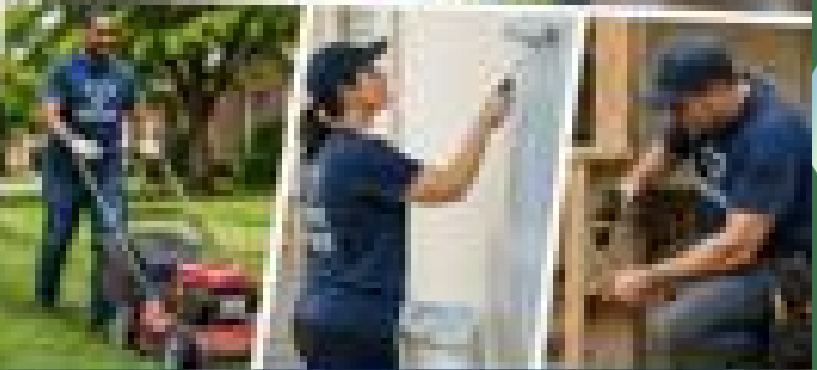

I asked God, what do you want me to remember while I wait for direction. He said in Jeremiah 29:11,

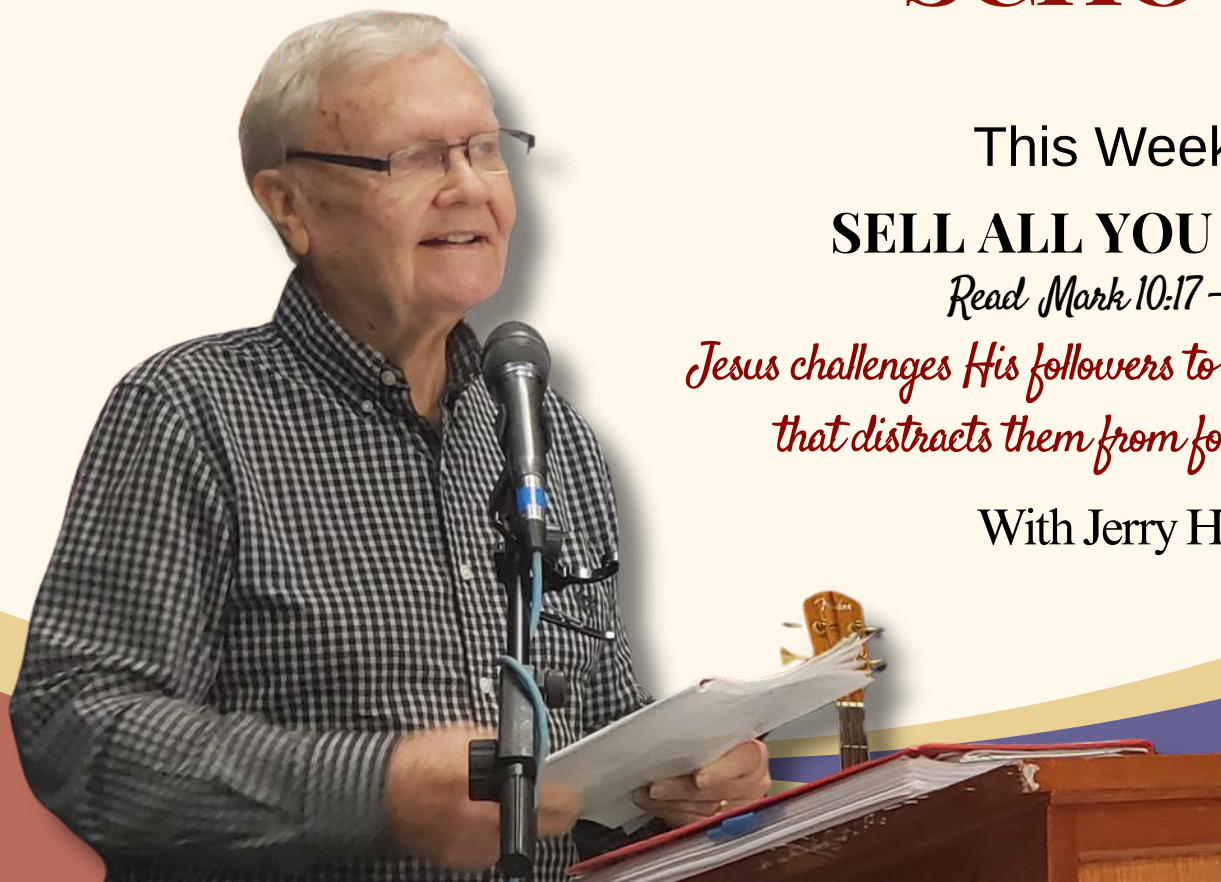
"Even when you cannot see where the road is leading, you can trust that I'm guiding you toward a future filled with hope, purpose, and peace."

The 49th book of the Bible - Paul's Epistles (Letters)
Unity in Christ and the Church's Spiritual Growth



DISCOVERING THE BIBLE

Chapter Outline

1 - 3: Spiritual Blessings

Paul discusses the spiritual blessings found in Christ and elaborates on the church's unity as part of God's salvation plan. He highlights the significance of God's grace and the mystery of the gospel unveiled through Christ.

4 - 5: The Christian Life

Guidelines for living as Christians are provided, with an emphasis on unity, purity, and love in relationships within the church. Paul encourages walking in the light and upholding holiness in daily life.

6: The Believer's Defense

In his concluding exhortations, Paul presents the well-known passage about the Armour of God, focusing on spiritual warfare and the believer's defense. He wraps up with a strong reminder to stand firm in faith and remain vigilant in prayer.

Ephesians was written between 60 - 62 AD during Paul's imprisonment in Rome to show believers what it means to be a follower of Christ and to encourage them in their spiritual walk.

SYMBOLISM & IMAGERY

The Body of Christ - The church is illustrated as the body of Christ, with Jesus serving as the head. This representation highlights the unity and interdependence of believers as they collaborate under Christ's guidance.



The Armor of God - Paul employs the metaphor of armor to illustrate the spiritual tools Christians require to resist evil. These tools include truth, righteousness, faith, and the word of God, representing preparedness for spiritual warfare.



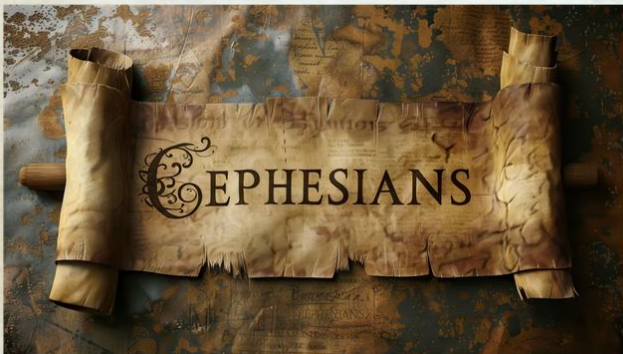
Building a Temple - Paul describes believers as being united to create a temple where God resides. This underscores the church as a spiritual community that fosters God's presence.

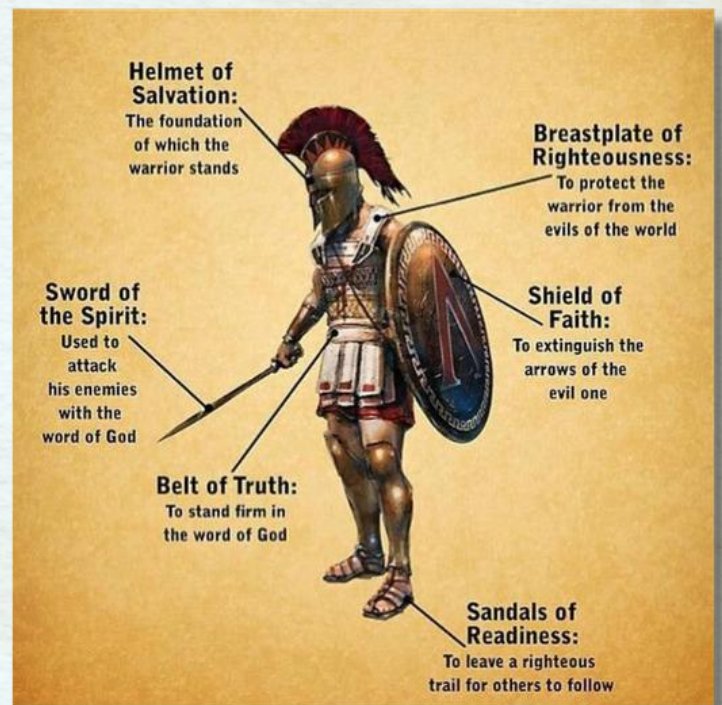


PRACTICAL APPLICATION

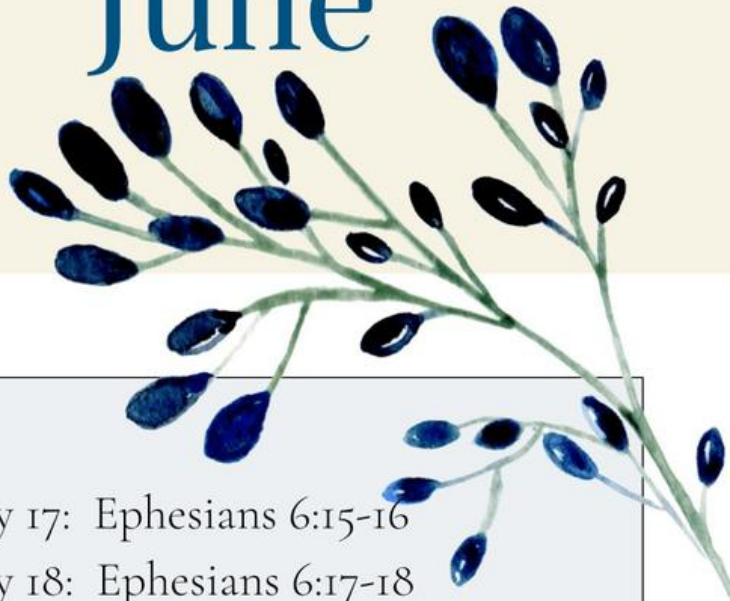

Neighbors Helping Neighbors



On behalf of our neighbors we serve, thank you from the bottom of our hearts for continuing to support your ministry of providing food to our neighbors who are experiencing food insecurity in our local community.

As of 6/23/26, 4,261 individuals representing 1,420 families have visited our food bank.

(1/27 and 2/3 closed due to the ice storm, and closed early on 4/28 due to the thunderstorm).

Ninety-eight percent of our neighbors live right here in Bellevue!

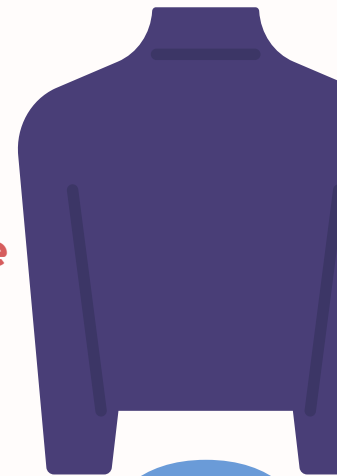

Each client welcomed at The Next Door Recovery receives a **Welcome Bag** which is the first touch of encouragement from the TNRD community. They are filled with items to help ease a client's transition from addiction to a life transformed in recovery.



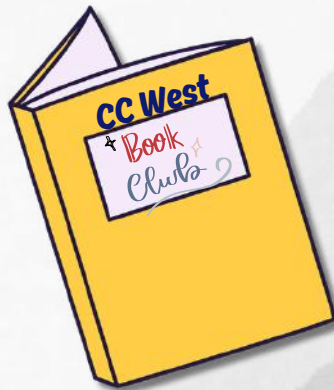
