Llŷr Williams plays Chopin

The famed Welsh pianist plays a glorious selection of music by one of the greatest composers for the instrument, Frédéric Chopin. Included in the programme are several of his Mazurkas, his take on the Polish dance - mini masterpieces that can take the listener by surprise in their abrupt changes of mood. Some of the composer's most fiery music can be found in his Scherzos, with No.3 being no exception. Your evening closes with the Polonaise-Fantaisie, which moves in a flash from introspection and melancholy to ecstasy and celebration.



Schubert's Trout Quintet

Schubert's Trout Quintet has been an audience favourite since its premiere and it's not hard to see why, full of irresistibly feel-good music including a soulful slow movement and an ending that's infused with the sounds of Hungarian folk music. It shares the bill tonight with Dohnányi's Sextet; turbulent, heroic and playful, plus delightfully sunny music by Duchess Anna Amalia and the nervous energy of Mark Simpson's evocation of the night.

For those travelling by car, parking is available at Heol Maengwyn car park.



Sir John Tomlinson in Conversation *Sgwrs gyda Sir John Tomlinson*

John Tomlinson is one of the most admired basses of his generation, notably as a Wagnerian. He performed at every Bayreuth Festival from 1988 to 2006 taking the roles of Wotan, Hagen, King Marke and Gurnemanz. He has sung for English National Opera and at the Royal Opera House in London where he created the role of the Minotaur in Harrison Birtwistle's opera. "I owe my enthusiasm for singing to the Lancashire community and family I grew up with, where we regularly sang round the piano at home, and where many members of my family were singers, conductors, organists and pianists, all strictly amateur of course and proud of it." John Tomlinson talks to Christopher Cook about singing and Wagner, Birtwistle and teaching a new generation.

When you are not playing, you're rehearsing; and when you are not rehearsing then you're probably on the road together. Someone once suggested that if the wife of the leader of a string quartet should contemplate divorce, then the quartet could be cited as a 'third party'! A string quartet is an intimate conversation, conducted by four musicians overheard by an audience. Johannes Marmen, who leads the Marmen Quartet and the cellist of the Doric Quartet, John Myerscough talk to Christopher Cook about those intimate conversations, about life in a string quartet, choice of repertoire, music-making and friendship.


Tabernacle Art Competition 2024

Llio James works from her studio in Cardiff, Wales, using a traditional dobby loom – designing the cloth in the studio to be produced at local mills in Wales and England. She also creates unique commission pieces which are hand woven. Llio's inspiration comes from the feeling of belonging to country and culture and this is strongly expressed in her work.



Terence Lambert has created a collection of observational drawings of fauna that has inspired him over the last six months of this year.

After the inspiration of observation in the field, seeing birds as they are, Terence strives to capture not just the details but the personality of his subjects in his paintings. He also refers to his extensive collection of specimens.
