They might bring a recipe to life in Food & Nutrition, try a new language or improve their ICT skills by coding a computer game.

Whilst pupils are taking part in the Taster Day, parents will listen to a presentation from our Headmaster, Michael Bond, Head of Admissions, Debbie Cook and Head of Transition, Suzanne Bond. Folloing this, parents can attend a carousel of academic and co-curricular stands where you can meet and chat to Heads of Departments and members of our Senior Leadership Team. Optional tours with our Sixth Form Praeposters and refreshments will also be avaliable. Our Admissions Team will also be on hand to provide information on the application process including Bursaries & Scholarships, our admissions timeline and answer any questions you may have.

What to bring?

Pupils are not required to wear uniform and they need not bring anything extra with them. On arrival, they will be given a Brentwood School bag, pencil, ruler, water bottle and paper for use during the day. Staff will provide extra equipment where necessary

A popular part of the Taster Day is experiencing a Brentwood School lunch. Before departure, pupils will be taken to the Dining Halls where they can choose from a wide selection of healthy hot and cold lunches, including vegetarian and free from options. Pupils will also be provided with refreshments during morning break time.
