District Governor's Installation - RID 3192

A well attended and innovatively curated District Governor's Installation Ceremony was held on 29th June 2025 at Hotel Taj, Yeshwantpur where RI Director Ft. Lt. K.P. Nagesh as the Installing Officer, formally inducted Rtn. Elizabeth Cherian as the First Lady District Governor of RI District 3192 and the 3rd District Governor of RI District 3192 in the presence of the Chief Guest Past RI Director Rtn. Dr. Manoj Desai.

The outgoing District Governor Rtn. Mahadev Prasad addressed the gathering with heartfelt thanks to the "Josh Presidents" and fellow Rotarians for their exemplary contributions during RY 2024–25.

In her acceptance speech, DG Rtn. Elizabeth Cherian expressed gratitude for the trust and confidence placed in her, pledging to uphold and enhance the District's rich legacy through inclusive leadership. She outlined her priorities for RY 2025–26 which include:

- Enabling clubs to scale up impactful projects and Assisting clubs in securing global grants.
- Launching a holistic wellness program for Rotarians and making Rotarians' health a priority.
- Organizing online Kannada classes to enable the use of the local language to effectively communicate and serve local communities while working towards the global vision of Rotary International.
- She also mentioned that we will be collaborating with the Government of Karnataka in providing smart classrooms and supporting other verticals in schools through the Rotary Club of Bangalore which will be the lead club.
- She spoke on engaging members and keeping minds active through regular online quiz programs.
- She also mentioned the formation of two new type of clubs - Rotary Planet Earth focusing on protecting the planet and Rotary Innovators - which will focus on applied innovations and social engineering.
- A privilege card for Rotarians at various establishments with discounts will be issued in association with IEEE we will be supporting the specially designed vehicle that will reach calamity affected areas and at other times this vehicle will be moving to schools for climate education. Rotary will support the climate education kits. This project will be led by the Rotary Bangalore Heritage North.
- Partnering with NGOs and the State Government to advance Bangalore's Climate Action Plan.
- She also highlighted the need for Membership Development, active member engagement and robust contributions to The Rotary Foundation (TRF), in line with the ambitious goals set by the RI Director Ft Lt KP Nagesh.

Concluding her inspiring address, DG Rtn. Elizabeth envisioned RY 2025–26 as a groundbreaking year of Love, Friendship, and Compassion, calling upon all Rotarians to "Unite for Good."
