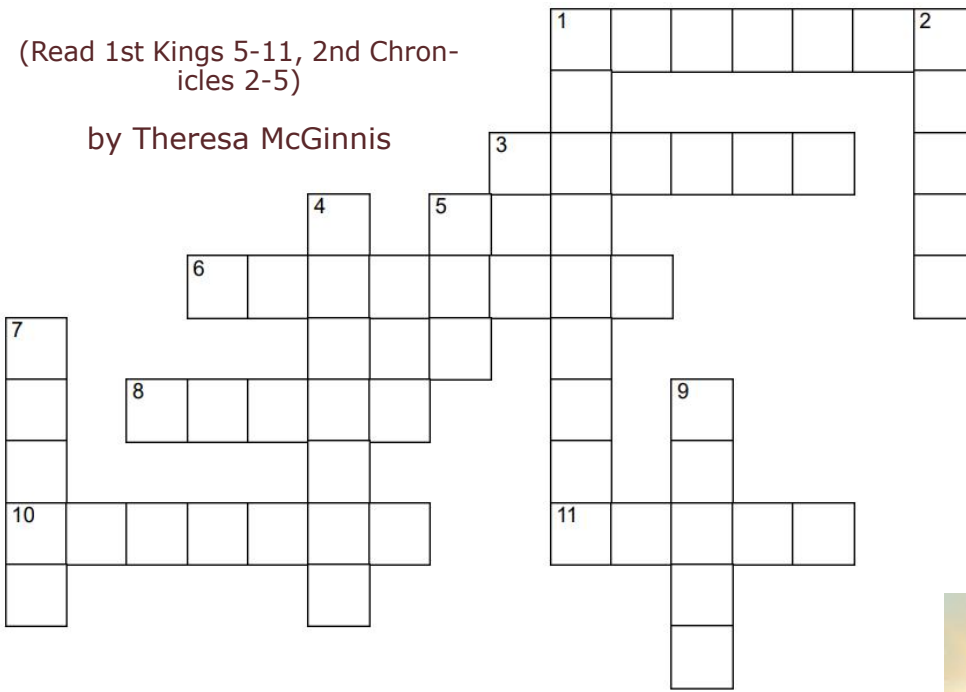

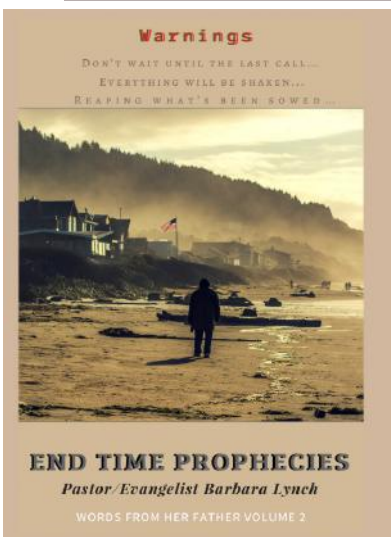

Things to be Thankful for...

Being thankful is part of God's will.

Be thankful in every circumstance, for this is God's will for you who belong to Christ Jesus.

God has an individual plan for each of us, but part of His will also includes that we are grateful. Thankfulness is an important biblical theme.

1 Thessalonians 5: 16 - 18 says, "Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus."

Give thanks in all circumstances. Gratitude should be a way of life for us, flowing naturally from our hearts and lips.

Looking at the scriptures deeper, we understand why we should be thankful and how to have gratitude in different circumstances.

Psalm 136: 1 says, "Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his great love

endures forever (NIV)."

Here we have two reasons to be thankful: God's abiding goodness and his constant love. When we recognize the nature of our depravity and understand that, apart from God, there is only death (John 10:10; Romans 7:5), our natural response is to be thankful for the life He gives us.

Psalm 30 gives glory to God for His deliverance. David writes, "I will glorify you, O Lord, because you have exalted me, and have not allowed my enemies to rejoice over me. Lord my God, I cried out to you, and you healed me.

Psalm 28, for example, describes David's anguish. It is a cry to God for mercy, protection, and justice.

After David cries out to God, he writes, "Blessed be the Lord, who heard the voice of my prayers. The Lord is my fortress and my shield; my heart trusted in him, and I was helped, so my heart rejoiced, and with my song, I will praise him" (Psalm 28: 6 - 7).

Amid difficulties, David remembers who God is, and thanks to knowing and trusting God, he gives thanks.

Job had a similar attitude of praise, even in the face of death: "Naked I came out of my mother's womb, and naked I will return there. The Lord gave, and the Lord took away; be the name of the blessed Lord" (Job 1: 21).

Paul was being persecuted, yet he wrote, "But thanks be to God, who always leads us in triumph in Christ Jesus, and through us manifests in every place the savor of his knowledge" (2 Corinthians 2: 14).

The writer of Hebrews says, "Therefore, since we receive an unshakable kingdom, let us have gratitude, and through it let us serve God by pleasing him with fear and reverence" (Hebrews 12: 28).

Peter tells us that we should be thankful for "various trials," saying that, through difficulties, our faith "may be found in praise and glory and honor when Jesus Christ is revealed" (1 Peter 1: 6 - 7).

God's children are grateful people because they realize how much they have received from us. According to 2 Timothy 3: 2, one of the hallmarks of the last days is a lack of gratitude.

Animal Farm

I recently read George Orwell's "Animal Farm" as it was a relatively short book, but filled with principles worth realizing. The plot synopsis is that a farm is taken over by its overworked, mistreated animals. With flaming idealism and stirring slogans, they set out to create a new paradise of progress, justice, and equality. It records the evolution from revolution against tyranny to a totalitarianism just as terrible. In a sense, what the animals sought to prevent they became in themselves, and all of their works returned to square one.

How true of human thought and effort. Without God, all our plans and ideals seem great and mighty. Pride always begins in a petri dish awaiting the right environment to grow and thrive. Our lifestyle is the petri dish, and whatever we say and do is the environment in which different things can grow. Is our environment rich with God and all of His attributes, or is it something less than favorable? There is no condemnation intended – but just a question for thought.

I have always believed that there is time for reflection, for analysis. You don't know what you don't know, but we are responsible for using brain power and effort to 'find out'. We have a spiritual responsibility to learn where we are with God. Don't you check your gas gauge in your car every so often? Check your balance in your bank before making a purchase?

I can't speak for other people, but every so often I get a little nudge inside of me that says it's time to check where I really am. Am I getting wrapped up in the hype of the world, am I starting to think along the lines of what sounds good and makes sense,

or am I actually aligned with what God has spoken over my life? Suffice it to say, I am not totally aligned. It's not necessarily a bad thing, so long as it gets corrected properly.

We're human beings and we have an immaculate ability to go off course. It's one of our greatest abilities. It's in your DNA to make mistakes. Don't crucify yourself over it. Repent and keep moving forward. I always tell people, the Holy Spirit's job is to convict you of your sin. Once you actually acknowledge it and truly repent – that conviction stops. Anything else after that moment is condemnation from the enemy. Jesus isn't whipping you after you repent. God isn't blowing cigar smoke in your face as you await your ultimate judgment for your mistake. This is the devil not wanting you to walk out your repentance.

The God I serve has always told me that the slate has been wiped clean, especially when I didn't deserve it. But have you wiped your slate clean? Countless times God has opened the prison door for us, but how often do we actually walk out of it? Sometimes we keep our own selves in there by trying to hang on to something God has forgiven and washed away. Believe me, I know all about it. Sometimes it takes total faith to even forgive yourself – but when you do, you'll walk out of the prison for real. I could be wrong, but I don't think you can really serve God to your fullest capacity if you are still echoing the whispers of the enemy over yourself.

Don't always listen to what sounds good, to what seems right, going after the popular opinion or "standard" of fairness – without first consulting God for His version. You might be surprised at what traps lay just beneath the surface of the golden streets.



Unique Obedience

God is lining us up for a true life of unity and obedience with His Spirit. Let us not despise the paths that we have walked down with God, but let's look at the deeper purpose that produces a unique obedience.
