EDITORIAL

A very eventful financial year came to an end in March. When we look back at the year gone, it makes us feel extremely proud of our achievements. We did surpass our targets when it came to achieving numbers. Under our 'Center Model' we trained and gave 100% placements to over **4700** youth. This happened through 28 centers across 7 States in the country. Our UNXT program which has been rapidly growing, has changed lives of over **24000** youth during this year, across 2 States largely and through pilots in 3 other States. The total numbers during the year was over **28000**, as against our plan for 25000 youth. We executed a few projects on the behest of our partners which gave us some mileage and a great feeling. We installed **solar power plant in KR Puram Govt hospital**. We are maintaining the



Metro median between 382 to 437 pillars, after successfully getting it painted and creating a nice garden between the pillars. We made available RO plants in 10 villages to help over 10000 villagers get access to safe drinking water. We started an apprenticeship program for 25 women in a multinational, paving the way not just for these girls but also establishing a model for the future. The icing on the cake has been the Social Stock Exchange listings in the BSE and NSE. Unnati is among the few organizations in the country which can be counted on your fingers to get listed.


