Keep this guide in your vehicle or by your phone for quick reference.

1. Immediate Local Area (Clifton Village & City)

Managed by Nottingham City Council For potholes, broken streetlights, or debris on village streets and roads heading into the city.

Quick Reporting Checklist

When reporting a fault, providing these three details will get it fixed faster:

1. **The Precise Location:** Use a house number, junction name, or the **What3Words** app address.
2. **The Type of Fault:** Is it a pothole, a faded marking, or a dangerous "ironwork" (manhole) issue?
3. **The Severity:** Is it causing an immediate danger to cyclists or drivers?
