

Happy New Year! It is an exciting time not only for Racquets, but the club as whole, with much of our Building A New Future project complete or in the final phases! With the addition of the bubble and year-round Racquets offerings for our members, along with all the golf and club upgrades and renovations, I truly believe Bent Creek Country Club will be the best it's ever been!

Project Update

With the bubble going up this past November, most of the work has been completed for our first full, year-round season!

Most recently, we had a deep cleaning of the courts, which is particularly dirty due to the ongoing construction and landscaping while the bubble was down. We brought in a special machine specific for tennis courts, that cleaned much of the debris, while still maintaining the integrity of the paint and playing surface. We also had our new shed delivered! It is between the retention pond and the bubble, tucked away, where we will keep our service cart, tools, racquets equipment, etc out of sight (finally)! With the arrival of our shed, that also means we will be getting rid of our "wonderful" pod in the side parking lot!

Still to come will be the final removal of all dirt in that same side parking lot, as well as the construction entrance, to have it looking back to it's original state and much needed additional parking. We hope to have that completed over the coming weeks.

Come spring we will be finishing up final touches on the landscaping surrounding the courts and Racquets building, touch up concrete work as it warms up, and do a deep cleaning of the bubble.

Once again, I'd like to thank all the members for your patience and understanding over the past two years. We're finally at the finish line and have completed something we can all be proud of!



Pickleball Playbook - Tip of the Month

The most common rule violations that I see are foot faults on the serve and momentum taking a player into the kitchen after a volley. As we welcome 2025, I feel it is important to mention some rule changes that come with the new year. USA Pickleball reviewed 133 rule change submissions and fully approved 25 while approving another 20 with amendment. The following are the more important changes affecting recreational players:

No More Spectator Input on Line Calls

Rule 6.C.4 has been updated to make it absolutely clear that players are not allowed to seek or accept input from spectators regarding line calls.

The new wording states: "Spectators shall not be consulted on any line call," aiming to prevent any influence from enthusiastic onlookers, whether solicited or unsolicited.

Clarified Not Ready Signals

Rule 4.C.2 allows players on the non-serving team to use verbal signals like "stop" or "wait" to indicate they are not ready, even after the server has begun calling the score.

This adjustment aims to support fair play, ensuring that the rally doesn't start if players are obviously not prepared.

Redefining the Volley and Momentum

Changes to Rules 9.B.1, 9.B.2, and 9.H clarify what constitutes a volley. The updated rule now states that "The act of volleying begins when the ball is struck out of the air before bouncing and ends when the player's movement from the follow-through action stops."

Notably, the "swing" has been removed from the definition, making it consistent with other rules. The update also specifies that partners, including their gear, cannot touch each other during a volley.

Calling Faults and Partner Responsibilities

Several updates address fault calls. **Rule 13.D.1.c** now states that if there is any disagreement among teams, rather than players, about a called foot fault, a replay will occur. Additionally, **Rule 7.0** dictates that any disagreement between partners on a fault call will be decided in favor of the opponents.

Rule 13.D.1.a has also been updated to include partners: players must now call faults on themselves or their partners as soon as they detect them, ensuring fair play is upheld.

New Guidelines for Serving

Rule 4.A.5 has been revised to allow players to release the ball for a serve using their paddle as well as their hand. However, imparting spin during the release is still prohibited.

Players using the drop serve may now let the ball roll off the paddle's face by gravity only, with no additional force.

I hope this helps everyone better understand some rule changes. I do encourage everyone to read the rulebook which can be found at https://usapickleball.org/what-is-pickleball/official-rules/.
