About **CASA of Central VA**

The nation's first CASA program was developed in Seattle, Washington in 1977 by Judge David Soukup. Judge Soukup realized that he needed help in determining what was in the best interest of the children whose cases he had before him in court. Since then, over 940 CASA programs have been established throughout the nation.

The late Judge Dale Harris helped CASA of Central Virginia get started in 1989. CASA of Central Virginia is now one of the top three programs in the state of Virginia, supporting more than 80 volunteers who advocate for 200-225 children each year.

Court Appointed Special Advocates, or CASA volunteers, are appointed by Juvenile and Domestic Relations Court Judges to cases of children who have been abused or neglected. They assist the Court by (1) thoroughly investigating the child's situation; (2) submitting to the Court a written report regarding the child's best interests; (3) monitoring the case to ensure that the child receives the services ordered by the court; (4) aiding the guardian ad litem (GAL); and (5) serving as a Mandated Reporter of child abuse/neglect. CASA volunteers are authorized by the Code of Virginia, Sections 9.1-153 to perform the five duties listed above.

The Honorable Dale H. Harris

The Honorable Dale H. Harris passed away on October 21, 2022. She served as a Juvenile and Domestic Relations judge for 21 years plus seven additional years as a substitute judge. Judge Harris was instrumental in the creation of our program here at CASA of Central Virginia back in 1989, and our Hall of Fame award is named in her honor. We are forever grateful for all she did to bring our program to fruition which has now served over 5,000 children in our community. Lisa's Story of Impact

"My recent CASA case involved a single mother with three children. The mother spoke Spanish and limited English. In order to communicate with the mother, I enrolled in Duolingo Spanish for the duration of the case. I spent 30-60 minutes a day refreshing my high school Spanish. I also used Google Translate in order to communicate effectively with the mother by text and during my in-person visits. In talking with the mother, it seemed she was appreciative of my effort in working to communicate with her. My mispronounced words were especially amusing to her. The mother's eight-year-old child was bilingual and enjoyed 'correcting me.' At each home visit, I would bring the family fresh strawberries and blueberries and a craft they could do together as a family. This case was a 'WIN' when all parties involved agreed that the children should be returned to the mother's custody."

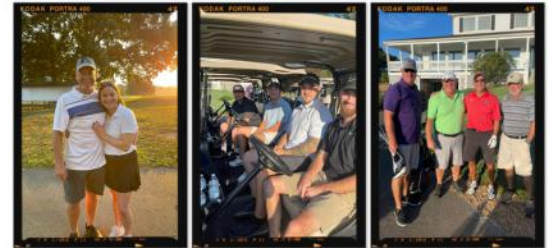

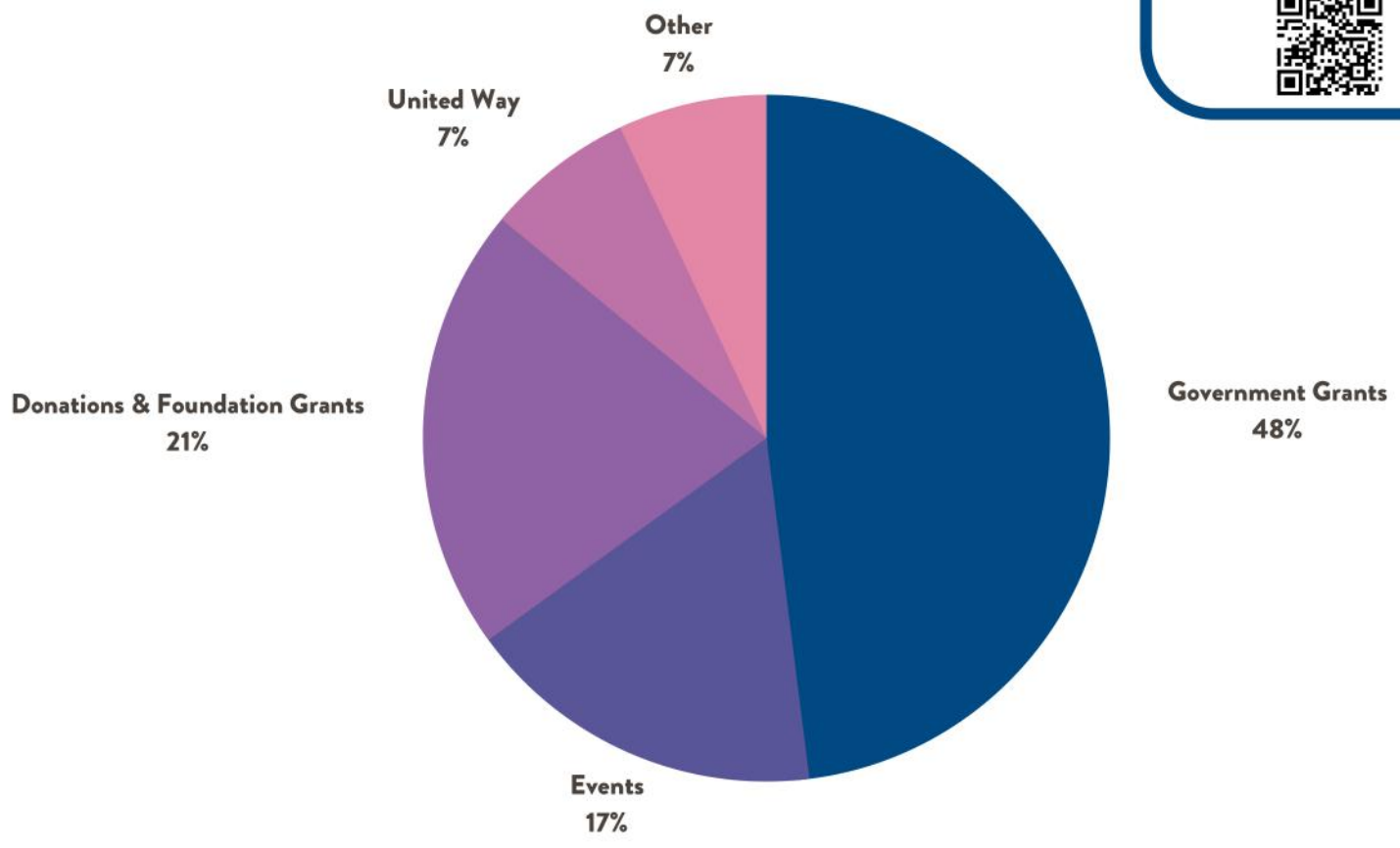

The Virginia Department of Criminal Justice Services issues state and federal funding to CASA programs based on the number of children served by a volunteer in the prior fiscal year.



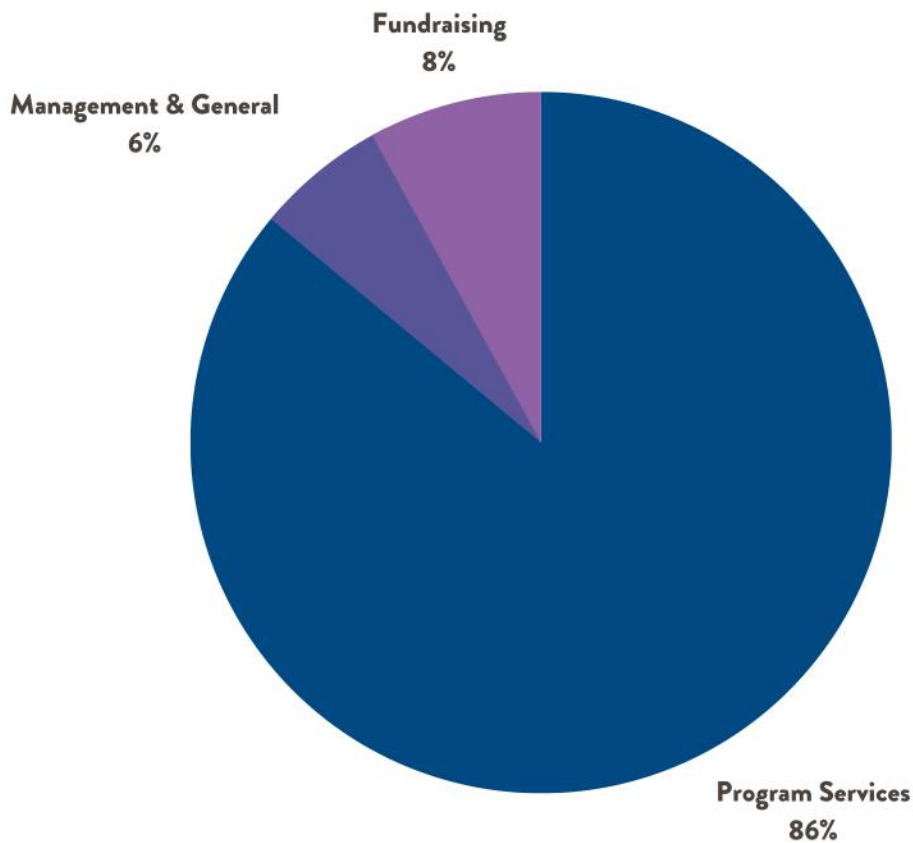
