## A Message from Our CEO

### 2025 was a year I won't soon forget.

As we marked our 25th anniversary, I had the privilege of gathering with members of the Impact Nations family in Australia, Canada, and the United States. Those moments made the year especially meaningful.

It came with real challenges, however. Some of our partners faced serious health struggles, while others navigated increasing persecution and political tension that kept us from standing with them in person.

And yet, even at a distance, their resolve did not waver. As local leaders, they continued to press forward, faithfully stewarding the vision God had entrusted to them and multiplying its impact in their communities.

What struck me most this year was this: even as revenue declined for the first time in several years, **the impact of our work multiplied.**

More than 3,600 vulnerable young people graduated from nine vocational centers, each one stepping into a new future.


Today, the vast majority are earning income, providing for their families, and building lives marked by dignity and purpose.

# Journeys of Compassion



Journeys of Compassion put the Gospel into action.

Move from empathy to active compassion—healing the sick, preaching the Word, and meeting urgent humanitarian needs.

## Journeys create space for the Kingdom to **break in**.

Malawi is one of Africa's poorest nations, where many families face limited access to nutrition, medical care, and clean water.

In July 2025, our team traveled to Southern Malawi, bringing practical aid and the hope of the Gospel.

Over 12 days, they conducted medical clinics, distributed water filters, and helped dig gardens in a crowded prison where men often go **days without food**.

Each day, partnering with local pastors, members of the team walked the streets of Malawi's poorest villages, stopping to pray with people along the way.

One unforgettable moment came when Steve met a man in his 50s, **paralyzed by a stroke**, sitting beneath a tree.

After prayer, the man raised his arm above his head, stood to his feet, and **began walking**. Within 30 yards, he was moving on his own—faster than Steve—as his amazed family looked on.

As they proclaimed the Good News and healed the sick, our team watched as over 700 people came to Christ during this Journey of Compassion. Since then, **sixteen churches have been planted**, and dozens of pastors are receiving ongoing training and mentorship.

# Skills and Business

A crisis may begin with vulnerability, but it doesn't have to end there. Skills training gives young people and vulnerable women the chance to earn income, support their families, and build a more prosperous future.

## Thanks to you, the future **Edward** once couldn't see is taking shape.

Edward's parents abandoned him at just seven years old. With no home, no education, and no clear future, he found shelter in an abandoned house.

Everything changed when George, an era92 Elevate alumnus, introduced him to one of Impact Nations' local programs.

Today, Edward is back in school. He is surrounded by supportive friends and mentors, and finally has access to the tools and encouragement he needs to rewrite his story.

What once looked like abandonment is giving way to belonging, stability, and hope.

Edward's story reflects a larger reality: young people across Uganda carry enormous potential, but many have never received the opportunity to develop it.

Through Impact Nations' Skills & Business initiatives, including vocational training, education support, and mentorship, local leaders are helping vulnerable youth move toward dignity and purpose.

## Your compassion reached Assunta before fear had the final word.

Assunta was six months pregnant when a typhoon struck the eastern Philippines.

Her family **lost everything** in a matter of moments. Their home suffered severe damage, and she, her husband, and their two children lacked the strength and financial means to secure even the basics.

When Impact Nations' local partners arrived to distribute relief packages, the community warned them that Assunta was a known persecutor of the local church.

But the team didn't turn her away. **Everyone deserves relief**, regardless of religion or creed.

After receiving food, Assunta was deeply moved. She began asking questions about the ministry.

Today, she is connected with local pastors, has a community to support her, and regularly attends a Bible study.

Her story is a picture of what happens when compassion is offered freely: walls come down, **dignity is restored**, and hope enters places once ruled by fear.

**Lasting change looks like communities growing stronger from within.**

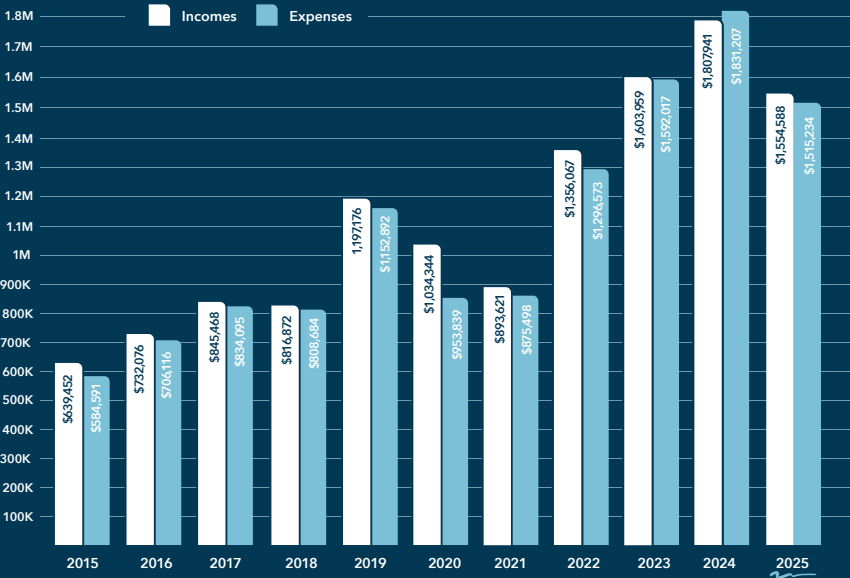

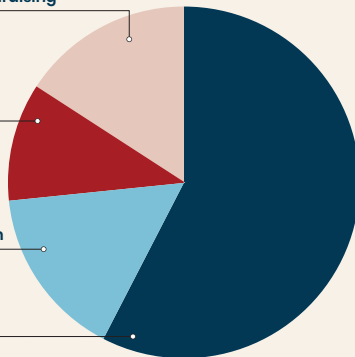
