5,875 volunteers faithfully served across all campuses and our community! HOPE AND RELIEF

Flowing Through Our Community

We're better together when we go together. This year, your generosity played a part in changing lives in our community forever through the Relief & Restoration fund. Because you answered the call to assist those in need, those who have suffered this year received the support they needed. These funds provide safety and assistance to those in need. Here's how your offerings gave hope this year:



BACKPACK OUTREACH

More than **\$23,000** was raised and **1,660** backpacks full of school supplies were donated to kids in vulnerable communities in partnership with Broward County Public Schools, Prevention Central, Purpose Academy, Broward Sheriff's Office, Innovation Charter School, Every Mother's Advocate (EMA), local foster homes, and Firewall Ministries.



THANKSGIVING OUTREACH

Approximately **20,000** pounds of food was given to over **1,100** families. In addition, over **\$23,000** was raised to give these families a Thanksgiving dinner they'll never forget. All of this was made possible through the partnerships of over **10+different organizations**.











LOCAL CHURCH AND MINISTRY ORGANIZATION SUPPORT

\$247,000 was sent to Fellowship of Christian Athletes, First Care, Sheridan House, First Priority, Every Mother's Advocate (EMA), Hope Women's Center, Hope South Florida, City Changers Movement, Church United, Village Hymns, Alpha, and schools in Broward county.

BLESSING THOSE WHO SERVE IN OUR COMMUNITY

During our Vision Outreach in 2021, you came together to pack boxes of goods to bless the first responders in our community.

In September 2021, Calvary was able to provide encouraging notes and more than **200** meals to our local nurses and healthcare workers who work hard to keep our community healthy and safe.

CHANGING SCHOOLS FROM THE INSIDE OUT

Through our partnership with North Lauderdale Elementary School, your investment helped provide resources such as GED, job placement, and legal assistance, and hot meals to families in their school.

CARING FOR THOSE WHO CAME BEFORE US

Seeking to bless our friends in local convalescent homes, you provided care such as a hand to hold, a conversation with someone who was lonely, and met needs of our aging community. And best of all, because of you, the residents and staff at elderly care facilities were given the greatest gift: the gospel of Jesus shared through quality time.



REACHING OUR COMMUNITY THROUGH RENOVATE GROUPS



In February of 2022, Calvary Men hosted a special event called Renovate. Since then, 85 men have been engaged in Renovate groups designed to reach people by serving the community. These groups completed over nine projects in the community, serving others and spreading the gospel. Through this mission, these men helped paint a special needs adult home, completed home repairs for a foster family, and built 30 bicycles for Westwood Heights Elementary.





REACHING OUR COMMUNITY THROUGH OUTREACH GROUPS

LISA CERVERA'S STORY

My husband and I bought a condo in Pompano Beach in March 2020 when COVID-19 brought the world to a screeching halt. We still had our home in New York, but spent most of the year here in Florida. I retired early from teaching English as a Second Language (ESOL) at a community college where I taught for 26 years. I had a very hard time leaving the job and people I loved.

We are empty-nesters, so saying goodbye to my job teaching ESOL college students felt like losing my ministry and purpose. But God had other plans, and the brought us to Calvary!

We immediately felt like Calvary was home. I attended The Gathering and started working out in the Women's Fitness group. The women welcomed me, and I quickly made friends with sweet sisters. I soon learned about a potential ESOL program for an underprivileged immigrant community and jumped in. The very first student I interviewed answered a question about fear saying, 'I've been worrying about dying and going to hell.' I immediately saw how I could teach not only the language but the gospel in this program!

I'm in awe at how God lined up so many things in my life. I was lonely, sad, and feeling useless. He gave me community, joy, purpose, and focus. And now we're about to teach the second round of ESOL, and I can't wait to share the hope and love of Christ to many more immigrants. I give Him all the glory and thank Him for the work He's doing in and through Calvary Chapel!

WHAT ARE OUTREACH GROUPS?

Outreach groups adapt to the needs of the community. These groups meet in places like coffee shops, schools, businesses, and civic centers. The goal is to use these spaces to meet a need or provide a service for the people in our cities—education, financial advice, parenting resources, marriage counseling, art and music development, fitness, etc.

WHY OUTREACH GROUPS?

Jeremiah 29:7 tells us to seek the peace and prosperity of our city. We believe this looks like not only praying for our city, but going deeper into our community to see how we can help meet needs. And as we help people manage their finances, raise the next generation, promote healthy marriages, and teach others to communicate more effectively, two things will happen: Communities will flourish and the gospel will go forth.

This year, there have been a total of **19** outreach groups with almost **400** participants and **65** volunteers in Brazilian, Spanish, Creole, and English speaking communities.

Here are a few examples of outreach groups that have impacted Local communities:

- **11** ESOL (English as a Second Language) groups with more than **250** participants in various locations throughout Broward County
- **3** Alpha groups with **80+** participants at different locations
- 2 groups consisting of business leaders in different locations
- **1** workshop group for married couples in West Boca
- 1 parenting group and 1 financial peace group in mobile home communities

GREAT LEADERS SERVE WHO THEY LEAD

enerosity breeds generosity—this has been the motto for our local business leader partners. In 2021, a program called LeaderShare was developed in order to partner with and empower the business owners in our South Florida communities. These are your peers—the small business you buy your Christmas gifts from, even those who help you navigate through the housing market or a legal document. LeaderShare was created to disciple those who influence our communities on a daily basis through their vocation.

This ethos is exactly what inspired Doug and Rhonda, two local business owners, to make an investment into their staff that went beyond what they brought to the table every day at

work. They decided to partner with Calvary and the LeaderShare team to offer Financial Peace University to their staff free of charge. They expressed their motivation was to ultimately give back to their employees who serve them so well day in and day out.

Since 2021, LeaderShare served over 98 business leaders just like Doug and Ronda.

Through LeaderShare, God is calling people to Himself. He is giving emerging professionals a chance to advance in their fields while allowing established professionals to advance His kingdom—and you have the opportunity to be part of that story as well.

We had an amazing response.
The Leader Share team was
so wonderful. They facilitated

our own employees stand up and share

FINDING A CHURCH TO CALL HOME

our generosity for our community goes beyond your neighbors at and around Calvary. One of the redemptive outreach programs at Calvary is the Jail and Prison Ministry. This ministry serves to invest in those who may feel forgotten and cast aside by the people around them. The goal is to make sure these men and women know they're loved by Jesus by building relationships with those who are in local detention centers.

Shara Carara, our women's ministry leader, explained, "Usually when we go to the jail, we will burn DVDs of the sermons at Calvary so they can watch church every week, or we'll bring in a guest speaker." However, this Easter she witnessed seeds not only being planted, but sprouting as the women served were able to hear the gospel live for the first time during their time there!

We're making an impact in so many ways for the people in detention centers and those working there. This year, over 400 meals were provided to the staff at two of the Broward Sheriff's Office local jails as an appreciation for their tireless work and partnership. This would not have been possible without the generosity of people like you.

The women were able to watch service live for the first time on the Saturday night during Easter weekend and, during the welcome, Pastor Doug took the time to say, 'Welcome to the ladies in the Lifestyle Program at the Paul Rein detention facility.'

The women watching exploded with joy!

They burst out screaming! All 25 of

these women couldn't stop talking about
how they felt so special. They felt like

they were a part of a church."



The asked me, 'Son of man, do you see this? Then he led me back to the bank of the river. When I arrived there, I saw a great number of trees on each side of the river. CHANGING OUR WORLD

Through your generosity to the Global Outreach fund, the gospel flowed throughout the world to reach those who may have never experienced the love of Jesus in a tangible way before.

GLOBAL MISSIONS IMPACT

In 2021, a total of **\$699,000** was sent around the world to support our missionaries and the global church.

76 missionary partners spread the gospel in **4** continents and **22** countries.

29 people went on **4** different mission trips across the globe.

22 people responded to crises and assisted in6 emergency relief trips.

In the continued partnership with Emmanuel Baptist Bahamas Relief Effort, over **\$60,000** in financial support was given through our ministry partner, National Christian Foundation. These funds directly support the community as they rebuild from the disaster that struck them as a result of Hurricane Dorian in August of 2019.

In 2021, **\$852,000** was distributed through the Global Outreach fund to equip our non-profit partners such as:

Ukraine Project:

Provided medical supplies to soldiers and to aid refugees with food, hotels, transportation, and help with long-term housing.

OneHope Project Lumiere:

Assisted a local church in a French-speaking area in West Africa and a church in India.

Made Clean Project:

Supported a washing machine ministry that serves refugee camps and a children's ministry in Bekaa Valley, Lebanon. To date, over **476** washes have happened in **18** different camps.

Church Plant in Antioquia, Mexico:

Helped assist with start-up and building costs.

Pastor Missionary in Cuba:

Helped 20 churches get recognized by the Cuban government.

Convoy of Hope:

Purchased supplies for families in crises in Ukraine.

Harbor House Foundation:

Helped Ukraine women and children in Germany, Italy, and beyond.

World Relief:

Supported the Afghan Resettlement Program.

Pathway to Joy:

Helped prep a home in Romania to receive Ukrainian families.

PastorServe:

Supported a conference in Haiti.



BRINGING THE HOPE OF JESUS TO CHILDREN IN POVERTY

Poverty robs children of their health, education, opportunities, and hope for the future. This is not God's heart. How do we know this? Because the Bible tells us over and over again that God's heart is inclined toward those who are marginalized, oppressed, and hurting. And as His people, He's positioned us to bring help, healing, and refreshment to those in need.

Compassion International seeks to release children from poverty in Jesus' name and reach them with the gospel. In partnership with Compassion International, this year we launched our very first Compassion Child projects at two of our international church plants in Mexico and El Salvador.

Because of your generosity, over 750 children

at both sites were sponsored during Missions

Week in January and The Gathering in February.

For both church plants, this provides a unique opportunity not only to serve children trying to survive extreme poverty, but an opportunity to serve entire families. When children receive an education, health care, food, and are able to engage in holistic activities and learning about Jesus, parents can tangibly see the love of Christ through the church in action. Each child becomes known, loved, and protected, hears and experiences the gospel consistently, and, over time, most come to know Him personally.

AUNIQUE MISSIONS OPPORTUNITY

LYSA MCMILLAN'S STORY:

As we grow in our care for and generosity toward the poor, and actively make disciples of all nations, our church family benefits greatly. These partnerships created the unique opportunity for us to go on a short-term mission trip to Mexico or El Salvador to serve these church plants and the Compassion children and for child sponsors to meet and minister to their child in person!

I had the privilege to do this. Hosted by Pastor Jorge Bustamante, I was able to celebrate the launch of the Compassion Child Project in El Salvador with Pastor Doug and Suzanne Sauder. More than 400 were in attendance—200 children plus their families along with the mayor, school principal, Compassion staff, and other community leaders.

For me, the most meaningful moment was when Pastor Doug called parents to lay hands on their children while he prayed and dedicated each one to the Lord's care and guidance and for their lives to bring impact and change to their nation. It was especially powerful because I had the rare privilege to pray for my newly-sponsored child, Mateo, as his mom was not able to be there.

I was overcome with emotion as I realized my sponsorship of Mateo is so much more than \$38 a month. Instead, it's a divine opportunity to be a spiritual mon, investing in every aspect of his and his family's vulnerable lives, and to be a tangible part of releasing them from poverty in Jesus' name.

BECOMING MORE AGILE ACROSS THE GLOBE

THE AGILE PROGRAM

In the wake of Category 5 Hurricane Maria, Puerto Rico experienced a natural disaster that was considered to be the worst the islands had ever faced in recorded history. Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale sent resources and finances to help assist the islands during this time, and through this effort, AGILE was born.

AGILE is an innovative program created in collaboration with our ministry partners that provides online entrepreneurship training—based on biblical principles—to help students identify their gifts and build businesses in their hometowns that can flourish. AGILE takes students ages 12–18 through a 10-unit program that helps them build the framework of a small business.

Along with Africa and Italy, AGILE is currently being piloted in approximately five to six schools in Broward County as an after-school program. AGILE actively helps students gain practical training and experience in leadership and entrepreneurship. These skills, along with confidence, are needed for people who are growing up in complex situations, encumbered with many disadvantages and obstacles. The AGILE program works to motivate the entrepreneurial tendencies within students and ignite a spark to see their dreams come to life by providing them a way out of any disadvantages they face such as lack of access to finance and markets, lack of access to education, and an absence of mentors.

One of our partners in Africa, Joe Bonga, Director of ICY Africa, has seen how this program has helped change the lives of kids in Africa. "It's transformational when young people are empowered to design their own path in line with their destiny and callings. [AGILE is helping us to] empower a new breed of leadership . . . it's helping us to create a movement in Africa that affects all the important areas while raising their individual self-worth and dignity."

This program is creating space for kids to follow their passions and fight for what they believe in, while still being able to support their families. For example, it has created an opportunity for Miriam who is an advocate in her country of Bungoma for gender equality looking to end all forms of gender-based violence (GBV) and female genital mutilation (FGM) by the year 2026. She is passionate about ending

domestic violence and encouraging women to step up and make their voice heard as leaders and decision makers.

This program also makes space for women like Vivian who is able to teach the people around her how to use their practical gifts instead of being limited to the opportunities laid before them. Vivian lives in a community that struggles with poverty and gender inequality. Many of the women in the village find they have to sell themselves and their bodies just to survive. With a heart to see change happen, not just in the lives of these women but future generations, she teaches them how to make crafts and then helps them sell their wares for income.

AGILE is currently changing the lives of students in three different countries and is expected to expand to the Dominican Republic, Lebanon, Pakistan, and southwest Florida.

UKRAINE RESETTLEMENT INITIATIVE

GOING AFTER THE ONE: PURSUIT OF PEACE IN PAIN

n February of 2022, our hearts broke for our global family in Ukraine who began facing the realities of war. Millions of families have been separated and forced to leave their homes without the promise of return.

Your generosity has and continues to provide hope and assistance to Ukrainian families affected by the war. Every effort, financial contribution, and prayer serves to advance the gospel and care for those in crisis. In the first six months of this effort to provide relief, nearly \$460,000 was sent to assist in resettling these families and providing food, hotels, transportation, medical supplies for the Ukranian soldiers, and long-term housing for the refugees.

In the immediate aftermath of this invasion, Calvary Chapel Fort Lauderdale sent three border teams to the Ukrainian-Poland border to assist with receiving families from our Ukraine church partners and provide hotel, meals, and transportation to Germany, Italy, and other parts of Europe from March through May 2022. Michael Snyder (who went with one of the border teams) shared this:

With Calvary's work in Poland, it was as if God was working in hyperspeed as you could literally see Him opening and closing doors almost on an hourly basis to lead us to the families we were supposed to help. Never in my life have I been so dependent upon Him.

Coming back from Poland I've realized that life seems to have more and more inequities. That's what we all see when we turn on the news. That's what I looked at when working with the refugees. The fact is, there is no human rationale adequate for resolving what I saw. Mental gymnastics will never adequately address the situation like the one Ukraine and its people are facing today. There is no possible way for me to give you all the answers to a situation like that, but there is one answer: the peace of God. That's why the apostle Paul says, 'Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts" (Colossians 3:15 NIV) and also "God, which transcends all understanding, will guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus' (Philippians 4:7 NIV). The peace of Christ is adequate when nothing else is. When you have Christ's peace in your heart, it rules over the inequities, the questions, the frustrations, and so many other things in our lives.

Calvary is currently working with two long-term housing projects for these refugees in Bessenbach, Germany, as well as in Naples, Catania and other surrounding areas in Italy. Your generous support made it possible for hundreds of Ukrainian refugees to not only have their physical needs met during this traumatic time but to also propel the gospel in their lives.

THE GEZ FAMILY STORY

My name is Lyudmila, and I'm a mother of two children. On February 24, 2022 my husband Vladimir woke me up with the words, "Get up, hurry up, get ready and leave." We discussed the possibility that a war could start, but we didn't think it would be so sudden.

It was 4am when explosions sounded in all large cities. My children (Darina, 7 years old, and Dominika, 2 years old) were crying because they didn't understand why we were so scared and rushing from one room to another trying to gather our things. At first, we went to a safer region, but after having two small children stay in a cold basement/bomb shelter, we realized this was not entirely safe either, so we went to Poland.

At the border, we didn't even really say goodbye to my husband because a crowd of people pushed us with bags to the checkpoint. My husband had to stay and go into the Ukrainian Army. I understood all the responsibility would be on me, but I absolutely did not know where we should go.

It was very scary. I was in banic, I started to cry and get nervous, but my husband kept saying to me, "Don't worry, God will take care of you and our children." And He did.

After crossing the border, Polish volunteers met us and sent us to a place to eat and gave us a place to sleep. I saw God's care in everything.

Later, my husband called me and said there was an opportunity to go to Germany to live in a castle. It was so unexpected, but I realized it was from the Lord. But our adventures did not end there. During the flight, our eldest daughter got an intestinal infection. She was ill the entire flight, and when we arrived we were sent straight to the hospital, not to the castle. But God is good, as we soon were able to return to the castle. Lukas, the castle manager, picked up my luggage and was there to help us—I'm very grateful to him for that.


