

The threats are palpable in the country. How could a misguided Ukrainian anti-aircraft missile hit the small village of Przewodów? What danger is posed by the Wagner group stationed in Belarus? And could the threat from Belarus ultimately be even more dangerous for Poland than the Russian war in Ukraine?

Andriy still hasn't been able to visit her grave - Mariupol and its surroundings have been under occupation for a year now. How does this city live? Who is left in it? What have the invaders done to Mariupol and its people?

The state of Europe is bad, to say the least. Almost everywhere, right-wing populists are coming ever closer to power or have already taken it over. The fatal thing about this is that we do not realize, or only seem to realize, that a state is becoming autocratic, reactionary or even a dictatorship when it is almost too late. 

Then, inexplicably, they burned down their houses and the megasites were abandoned. Did the inhabitants fall victim to a plague? Did the climate change so that they could no longer feed their inhabitants? Or did violence and wars lead to their decline? Through targeted excavations, an international research team is looking for answers.



Since Steven Spielberg's "Schindler's List", the whole world knows the story of Oskar Schindler, the German factory owner who saved over a thousand Jews during the Nazi era. But hardly anyone knows that Oskar Schindler saved the Jews together with his wife Emilie. How can it be that she bravely risked her life for others and at the same time failed to free herself from a toxic relationship with her husband for decades? The film explores this question from different perspectives throughout time and tells the story of how Oskar Schindler becomes a celebrated hero and Emilie Schindler dies impoverished and almost unknown in 2001.



A PRIEST'S DIARY

THE EXECUTED OF OCCUPIED PARIS

By August 1944, when Paris was liberated by the allies. Franz Stock had recorded a total of 863 shootings he witnessed in his diary. The German occupiers had appointed him as chaplain to those they had imprisoned in the Paris and condemned to death: resistance fighters, hostages, spies. He gives back what was taken from them in the first place: their dignity. The documentary seamlessly incorporates Franz Stock and his diary entries into the daily lives in occupied Paris from 1940 to 1944. The use of impactful newsreel clips, colorful home movies by Germans, French and Americans, as well as impressive silent film fragments from German and US sources that the makers discovered during their extensive research adds depth to the narrative.



The Berlin Quadriga of the Brandenburg Gate underwent a remarkable transformation from a symbol of peace to a triumphant monument. How did it come about that it was first taken from Berlin to Paris as a war trophy by Napoleon, but then forgotten in a depot and almost stayed in Paris forever? It was only during this period of involuntary absence that the work of art became a symbol of Prussia and of the victory over France. The Brandenburg Gate was transformed into a hotspot of German history. Time and again, the horse and carriage has been the focus of attention, as stolen goods, as a backdrop for imperial parades and Nazi marches as well as a symbol during the Cold War and the frenzy of reunification.



FROM CRADLE TO STATE CARE

EAST GERMANY'S SOCIALIST NURSERY SYSTEM

The young socialist republic needs workers, especially women. But what to do with the many babies when the mothers have to go back to work just six weeks after giving birth? The idea that saves the day seems simple and efficient at the same time: weekly nurseries are created. Anyone can now drop their child off at one of these facilities from 5 a.m. on Monday morning and pick it up again around 6 p.m. on Friday. The former nursery children take us back to the past and tell us about the fears they still carry with them today. A pediatric psychiatrist, an ethicist, an educationalist and a social scientist shed scientific light on the 40-year history of the GDR nurseries and examine the consequences for those affected.

PERGAMON ALTAR

A LOOTED MONUMENT?

In 1864, a German engineer discovered the remains of a lost wonder of the world, the Altar of Pergamon, in the west of the Ottoman Empire. Berlin wanted what was left for its Museum Island, and got it! The replica in the Pergamon Museum continues to impress visitors to this day. The documentary accompanies art historian and looted art expert Bénédicte Savoy on her research: Did the reliefs once come to Germany through political pressure and bribery?

"The most hideous hate images are hanging in my home. It's my way of coping with the trauma of the Shoah," Langerman says. In about 60 years he has gathered several thousand antisemitic objects. Where do the widespread stereotypes of Jews come from? What has led to the deepseated hatred? And why do anti-Jewish stereotypes persist to this day? Arthur, the seeker, does not let these questions rest. In our documentary, he travels to various places to search for clues.





THE HIDDEN HORROR OF SOBIBOR EXTERMINATION CAMP


Auschwitz and Birkenau are names of concentration camps, that are firmly anchored in our memory, while the name Sobibor fell into oblivion. Sobibor extermination camp was established by the Nazis in eastern Poland in 1942, with the aim of "efficiently" murdering Polish Jews and Roma. It was part of "Aktion Reinhard," considered by many researchers and historians to be the "core of the Holocaust." Until recently there were no pictorial records from Sobibor because the Nazis had destroyed the camps in order to cover the traces of their crimes forever. This changed with the groundbreaking discovery of a photo collection of the deputy camp director Johann Niemann in 2020.

UNLOCKED HEART

"Through and through in the broken environment of desires. Hustlers, transvestites. the mentally ill, alcoholics. That's where I feel at home. That's the world that needs to be captured." When the artist and photographer Jürgen Baldiga died of AIDS in 1993, he left behind what was probably the most extensive body of work on HIV, AIDS, homosexuality, and subculture in West Berlin in the 1980s and 1990s. The film tells the story of the artist in all his contradictions and provides an insight into a Berlin subculture that would have been forgotten without him. It is the portrait of a unique artist - at a time when an HIV infection was not only a certain death sentence, but also led to a renewed stigmatization of gay lifestyles.

THE BOLSHOI SYSTEM

Explore the world behind the curtains of the prestigious Bolshoi Theater, considered the pinnacle of Russia's high culture and a microcosm of Russian society. Captured in the year and a half leading up to Russia's invasion of Ukraine, this documentary is a portrait of Russian society before the war of aggression and an examination of the role Russian culture played in the preparations for war. Against the backdrop of current events, it deals with the individual relationships of artists within the political system. Through conversations with Olga Smirnova, prima ballerina and the only member of the ensemble to leave Russia, and Wadim Schurawljow, former head of artistic programming at the Bolshoi Theater, this film offers a unique perspective into Russia's esteemed theater





TRAUMA AND TRIUMPH IN BAROQUE ART

It is probably the most famous #MeToo crime in the Baroque art world. The victim is the eighteen-year-old painter Artemisia Gentileschi. The perpetrator: a well-known artist colleague of Artemisia's father. "Forcibly deflowered and repeatedly carnally recognized" - in March 1612, Roman court officials documented the entire course of the trial as precisely as the accusation. Despite such trauma and societal constraints for women in the 17th century, Gentileschi rose to prominence as the first female member of the Accademia di Arte del Disegno. To this day, the groundbreaking Italian Baroque painter is known for masterful depictions of powerful women in mythology and biblical narratives.
