THE ARTIST: FRANCIS MBELLA



There is in Francis Mbella a rare stillness, a depth that speaks before the brush even touches the canvas.

He was born in Douala in 1961, into a universe already steeped in artistry. The son of a sculptor-painter and a mother devoted to fashion design, creativity coursed through his veins long before he ever held a brush.

From the very beginning, Francis revealed a rare sensibility, never through display, always through depth. While the city pulsed with rhythm, movement, and sound, he turned inward, seeking harmony with nature. There, time would dissolve as he immersed himself in creation, each gesture an exploration, each moment a pursuit of meaning and inspiration. For him, creation was never an escape. It was a dialogue with the world and the truest way to exist.





There is in Francis Mbella an unshakable presence, a quiet force. A discipline so rare it feels timeless, almost ancestral. Every brushstroke unfolds as meditation, he paints silences, secrets, and echoes. While the world rushes forward, Francis chooses depth. THE TECHNIQUE: TAPIOCA RELIEFS

At the École des Beaux-Arts in Paris, Francis Mbella went beyond refinement to establish a singular artistic identity.


He united the mastery of classical oil painting with the raw unpredictability of tapioca. From this fusion emerged his signature: the Tapioca Reliefs, a process where matter itself becomes language, giving his works singular depth and texture, where substance speaks as art.

The result is a surface both luminous and profound, sculpted and refined, capturing light and energy in ways that feel alive, resonant, unforgettable. Each canvas goes beyond representation, becoming an echo of emotions and unfolding as an experience of sensation and harmony.





TPC ART HOUSE: THE LEGACY




Among Francis Mbella's most intimate creations are the portraits of his own children, conceived as inner testaments of love, memory, and vision.


Within these portraits lies both the origin and the promise of his journey, an intimate genesis that now finds new resonance through TPC Art House, extending his vision into the future.


