## RPD STATION BOND FOLLOW-UP INITIATIVE

The City of Rexburg's recent police station bond received strong majority support but did not meet the required 66⅔% supermajority. Voter turnout was relatively low (approximately 17% of registered voters), and support varied across precincts. City leaders are seeking to better understand why some residents chose not to vote or voted "no," where information gaps may exist, and how any future proposal could be structured and explained with greater clarity. To gather this feedback, the City will be distributing a community survey available January 5–18 via text message, email, and on the City's website. City leaders value resident input and encourage you to take a few moments to complete the survey and share your thoughts.

## WINTER ROADS ON YOUR MIND?

We recently sat down with Rexburg’s Streets Department Foreman, Police Patrol Lieutenant, Public Works Director, and Chief Financial Officer to talk about all things winter street care.



What does the City do to take care of our streets during snow? Before snow? After? What are the challenges? We talked about all the ins and outs of winter street care, and it was very insightful!

Largely, we learned that Streets crews work throughout the night to remove snow from roads throughout the City anytime an average accumulation is 1.5" or greater in December and January. They work at night to avoid the hazards of the day and to work more efficiently than having to work around daytime traffic, especially in intersections. Even with that, they still have tasks they’re taking care of during the day, like sanding icy roads, preparing brine, and more. Our Streets Foreman reported a 14-hour day at the time of our interview, and it wasn’t even a snow day!

While we concede that we’re all certainly human, we hope this information helps assure residents that our crews are out there and working hard to help lighten the winter load this season.

## NO OVERNIGHT STREET PARKING IS IN EFFECT!

From December 15th to March 1st, overnight parking is not permitted on Rexburg streets or alleys according to City Ordinance #1030.

This helps our Street Department crews efficiently remove snow from our roads during times when hazards are at a minimum. The process to remove snow following a qualifying “weather event” (2" or greater”) from every street in the City is a vast effort we’re all grateful to them for.
