Primarily, we are relieved that no one was injured or worse!

We have been flooded with messages, phonecalls and emails of sympathy and encouragement, and we have been strengthened from the support we have received from; clients, friends, staff, other opticians and neighbouring business owners.

Many of you have travelled to our Chessington branch, and have been patiently waiting for us to come back. We are forever thankful!

Up until September we had been forward with pushing our insurance company's which have finally settled up, and works have begun on re-building our flagship store.

As the dust finally settles, we have a clearer vision of what the future holds for us. Out of every bad situation, there is always the vision good and for Twickenham and delivering our unique styling service to our beyond community and looks bright.
