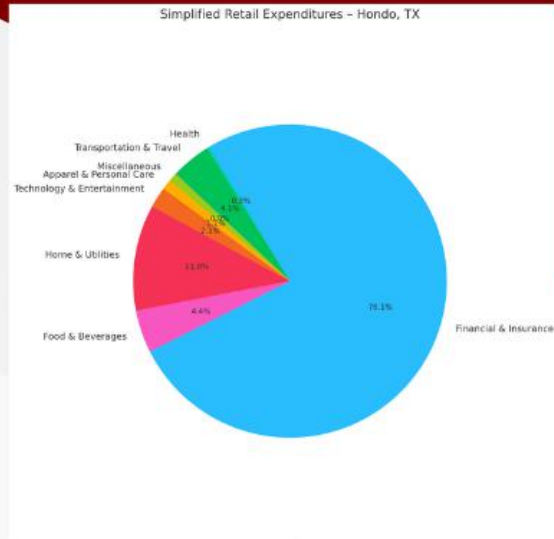
And the best part? James Avery continues to be a family-owned company, staying true to its roots while creating beautiful, meaningful pieces that last a lifetime.

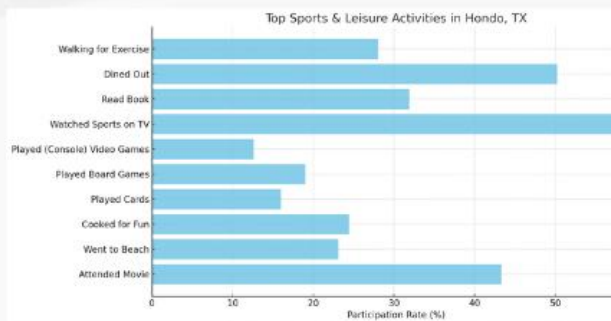
DOLLARS & DAILY LIFE

In Hondo, TX, the largest share of consumer spending goes to Financial & Insurance services, followed by Home & Utilities and Food & Beverages. These three categories make up the majority of total expenditures. Technology & Entertainment and Transportation & Travel also represent significant portions, while Apparel & Personal Care, Health, and Miscellaneous account for smaller shares of overall spending. This reflects a community focused on foundational needs, financial planning, and home maintenance.



LEISURE LENS

In Hondo, TX, residents are highly engaged in leisure activities that center around entertainment and relaxation. Watching sports on TV [58%], dining out [50%], and attending movies [43%] are especially popular. Other common pastimes include reading books, cooking for fun, and walking for exercise, reflecting a community that values both recreation and at-home enjoyment.



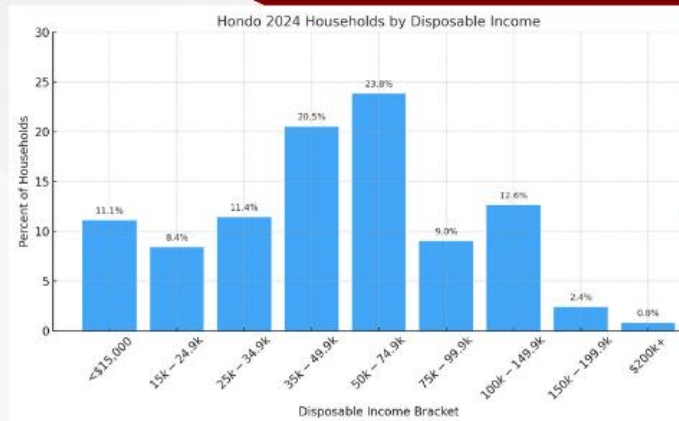

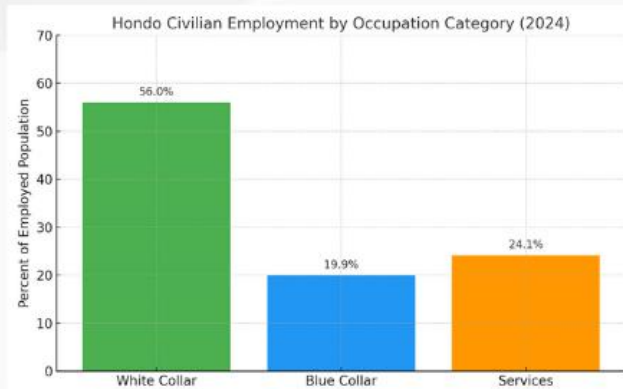
HOUSEHOLD WALLETS

Hondo's median disposable income in 2024 is \$48,640, with an average of \$59,424. The largest share of households [23.8%] fall in the \$50,000–\$74,999 income range. Over 30% of households earn less than \$35,000, while only 15.8% make \$100,000 or more. Income tends to peak among residents aged 45–54, then declines with age.



WORKFORCE SNAPSHOT

Hondo's 2024 labor force includes 2,783 individuals, with a low unemployment rate of 2.4% and a 40.3% participation rate among residents age 16 and older. Most workers are employed in white-collar [56%] and service [24.1%] occupations. Key strengths include education, healthcare, and public administration, with high employment compared to national averages. The city also has a high economic dependency ratio, suggesting a large number of dependents relative to working-age residents.

EXPANDED HONDO FACADE IMPROVEMENT GRANT
