This scholarship is awarded to a first-year resident studying science at The University of Queensland who has obtained outstanding results and is continuing to study a Bachelor of Science degree in her second year.

The recipient must:

- 1. consistently demonstrate a high level of commitment to their academic studies
- 2. provide The Women's College with their results at the end of each semester within two weeks of the release of results
- 3. actively participate in any scheduled scholarship activities which may include presenting to the College Council, writing to College donors on how the scholarship has been used to support their College experience and/or engaging in any College fundraising promotional activity.

Termination of Scholarship:

Failure to meet any of the terms and conditions as outlined above may result in termination of the scholarship at the discretion of the Head of College.
