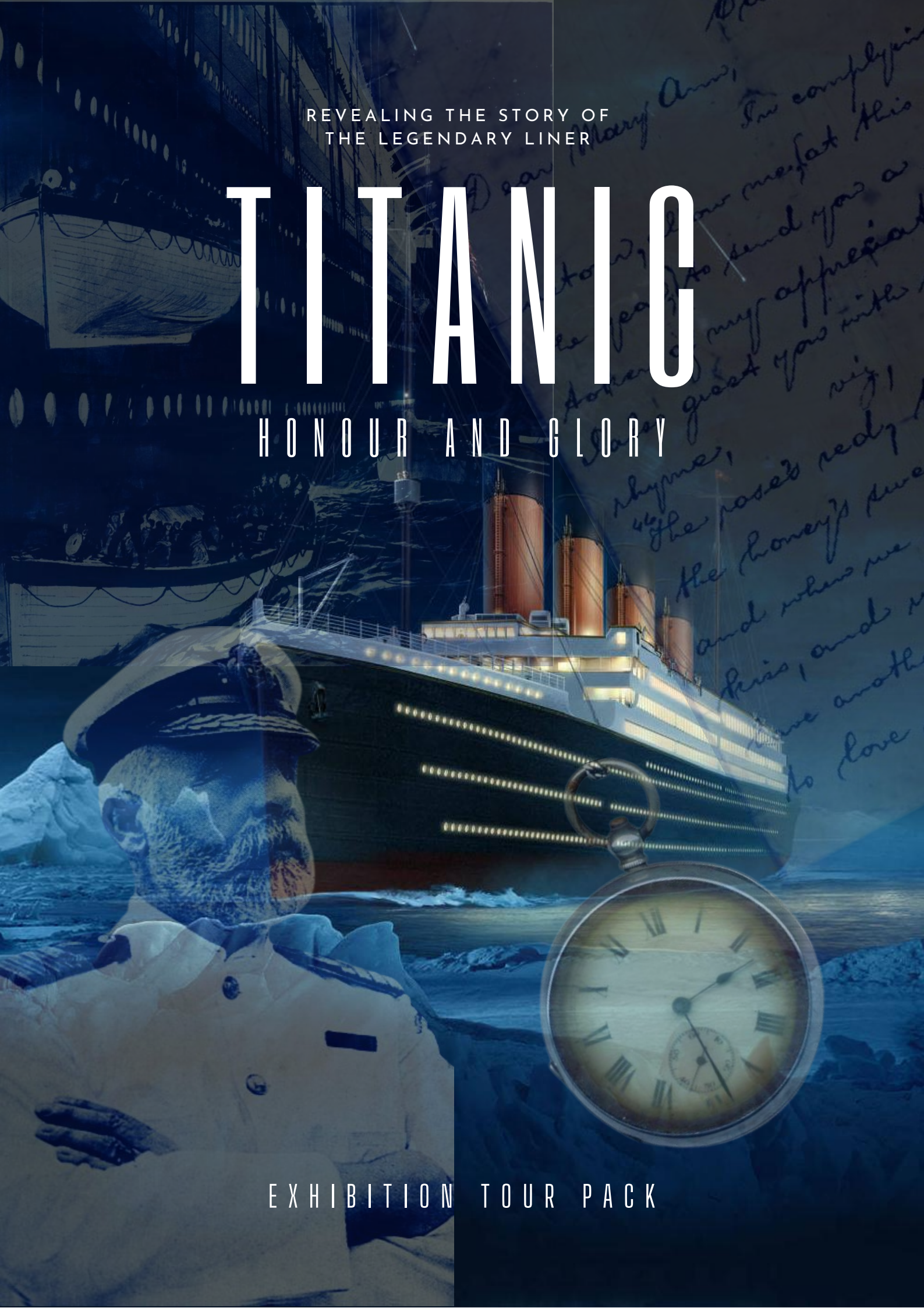

Titanic Honour & Glory is a national touring Titanic and White Star Line exhibition, which prides itself in preserving the history of the Titanic, her sister ships Olympic, Britannic and the White Star Line fleet of ships, that once sailed under the distinctive swallow tailed flag of the legendary White Star Line.

The exhibition contains over 7,000 unique artefacts, making it one of the the largest collections of rare Titanic and White Star Line artifacts in the world. In addition to original artifacts, it also has magnificent movie props and costumes from the recent 1997 James Cameron movie, Titanic.

The exhibition brings history to life, as each visitor will personally come face to face with history as they discover the story of Titanic, through real artifacts and personal stories.

Visitors also experience the grandeur of the gilded age of transatlantic travel as they view awe inspiring examples of her luxurious interior fittings.

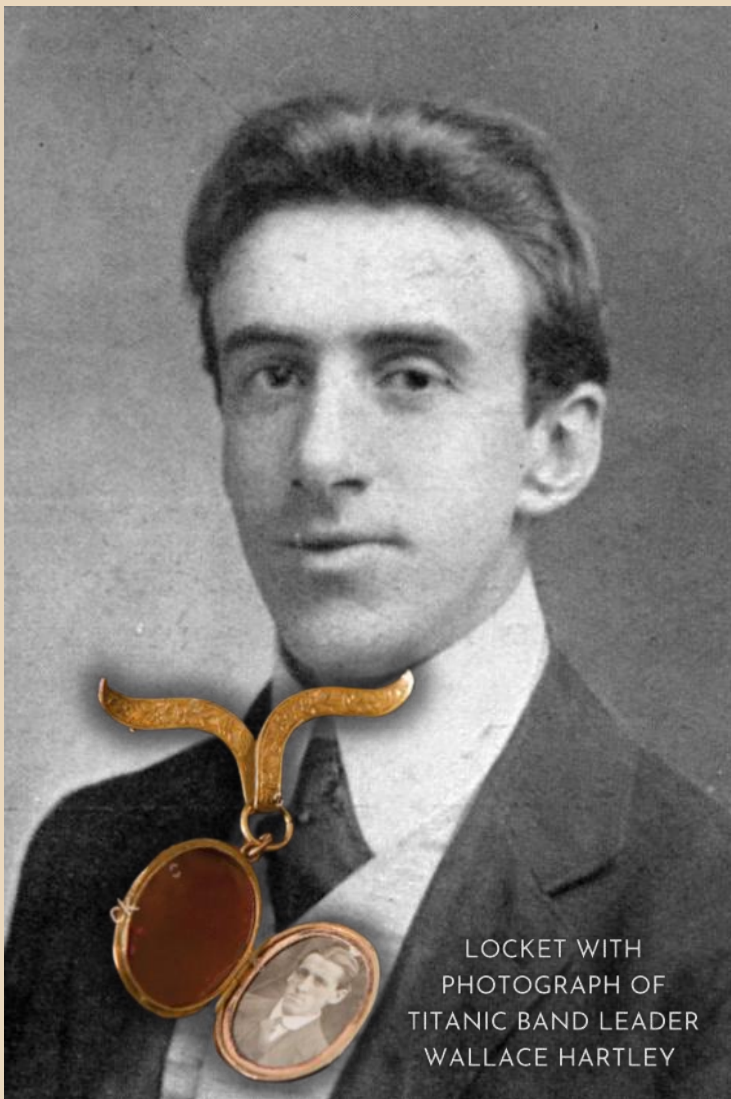

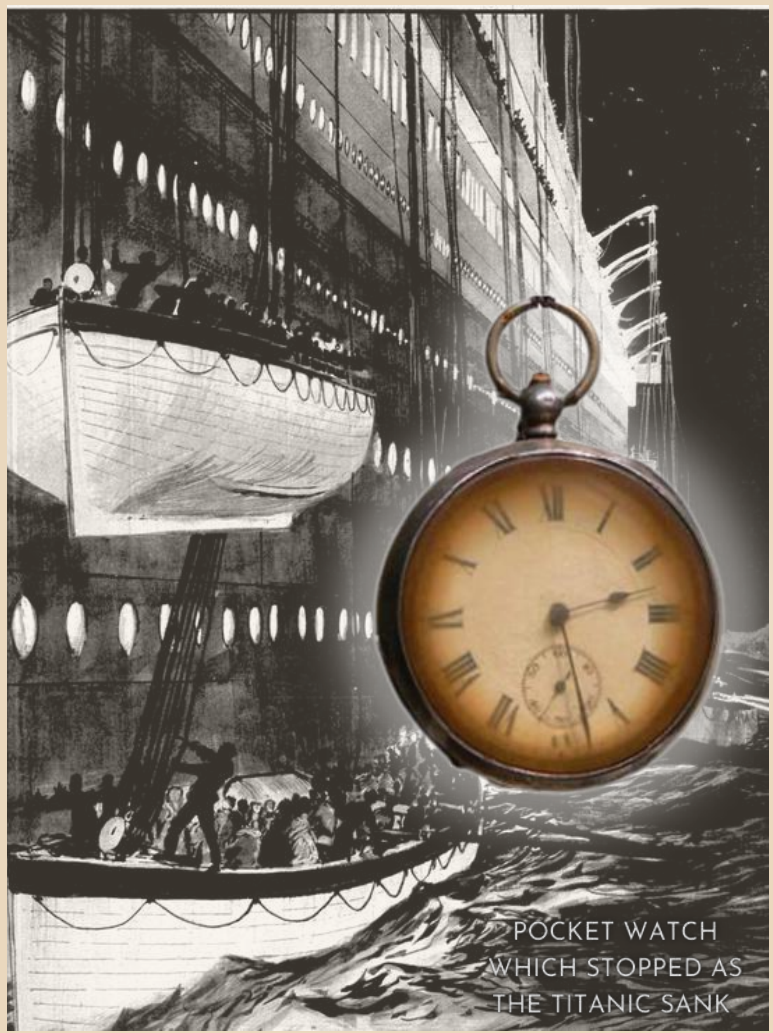

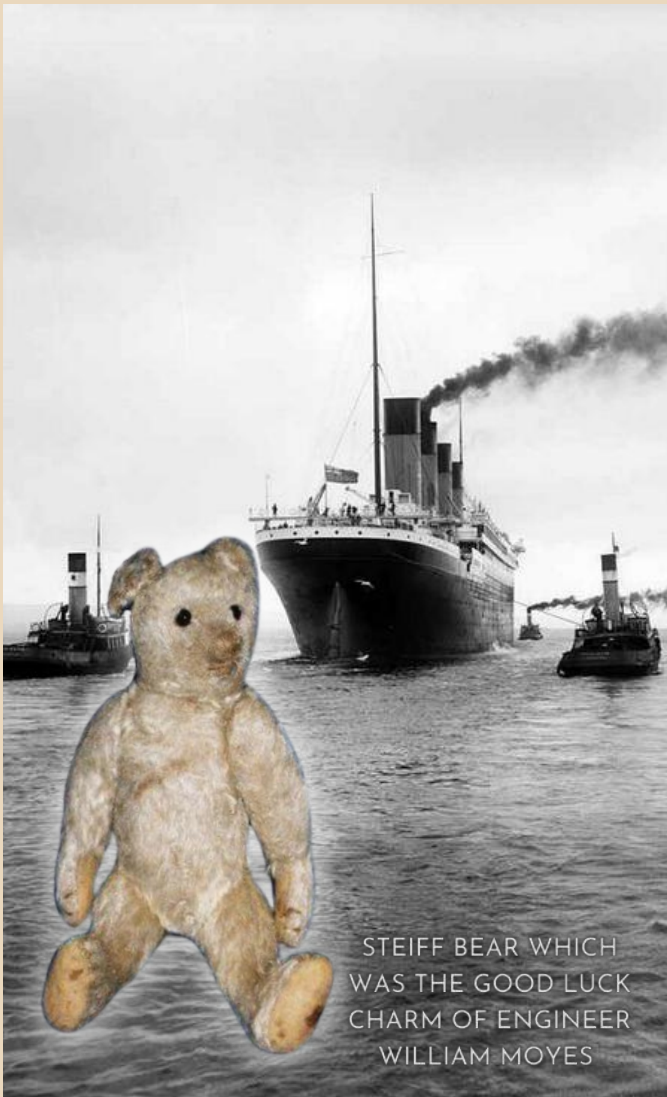

HIRE DETAILS

Booking is straight forward, simply send an email to us with your dates and we will send you confirmation together with a deposit invoice (usually 20%). Bookings are accepted subject to contract approval on a first come basis.

A 30% fee is payable if you decide to cancel within 3 months of your start date. Full fee remains payable if you decide to cancel within 1 month of your start date.

Tour dates - Please let us know if you require to be updated regarding exhibition tour dates and locations.

Transportation and insurance - We offer the collection on a 'dry hire' basis with pick up and delivery usually to and from Central Scotland. A 7.5T Luton Box Van with tail lift is recommended.

Contents Insurance, Public Liability, and standard indemnities against loss, liability and expense associated with third party claims, is the responsibility of the venue, whilst in transit and during the exhibition period.

The Hirer will indemnify the owners of the exhibition and hold it harmless against all claims, liabilities, losses, costs, damages, expenses, including consultants and legal fees and court costs, demands, causes of action, or indirectly arising out of or related to whatsoever which may be brought against it by any person arising out of the hire or the event.

4 weeks - £1,650 / 6 weeks - £2,000
 8 weeks - £2,500 / 10 weeks - £3,000
 12 weeks - £3,500.

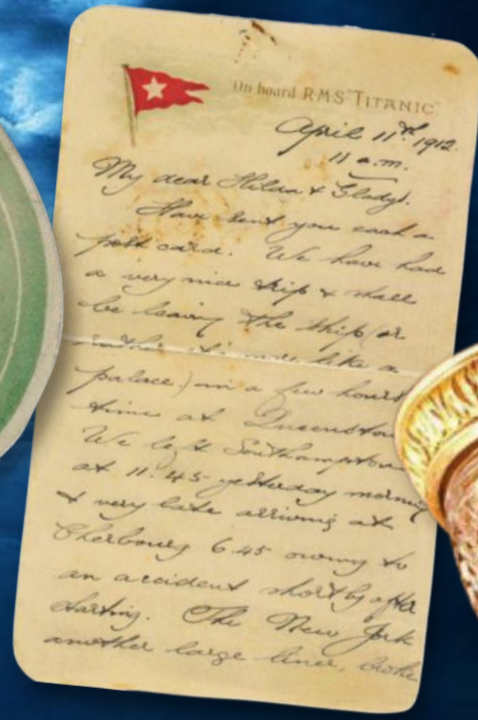
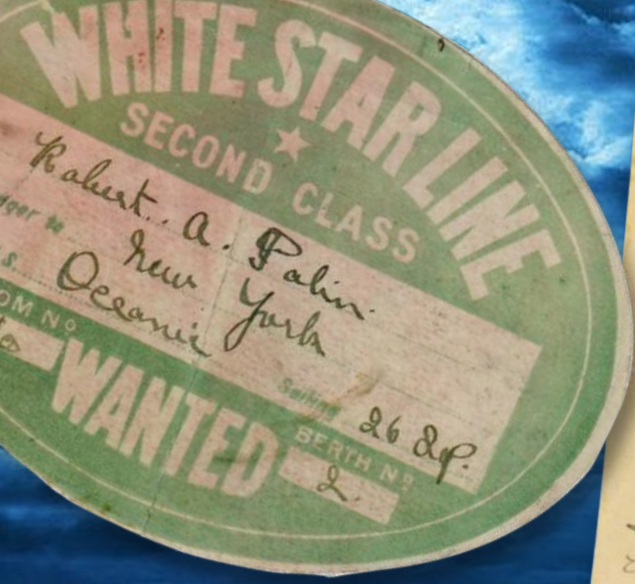
