



Pool Chemicals

The chemical balance of your water should be keep in the following ranges:

- Total Alkalinity - 80 - 120 ppm (parts per million)
- PH —7.2—7.6
- Free Chlorine — 1.0 — 3.0 ppm
- Calcium Harness (sum of all the calcium dissolved in water)- 100 -400 ppm ● Chlorine Stabilizer (cyanuric acid) — minimum 30 ppm

Additional pool equipment

- Auto Cleaners — It is recommended that no wheeled or automatic pool cleaners be placed in the pool for the first 14 days. If desired, you may use a manual vacuum and hose after 14 days as well.
- Salt Systems — No salt should be added to the pool until 28 days after plaster application. Chlorine Tablets in a floater will provide enough sanitizer in the pool water in most applications, until you can add salt to the recommended levels.
