





## SPORTS HONOURS

Our students excel in a variety of sports with standout achievements at the National, Regional, and Local levels. For AY 24–25, highlights include the Overall Championship Trophy in ISSO Swimming with 27 medals, alongside 25 gold, 1 silver, and 1 bronze at the DSO Swimming Championship. In the ISSO Football Tournament, our U14 Girls team secured both gold and bronze, while the ISSO Volleyball Tournament brought a gold and bronze across U17 and U19 teams. The ISSO Taekwondo Championship saw a silver at the national level, complemented by 1 gold and 1 silver. Further accomplishments include gold in the ISSO Judo U17 Boys and ISSO Tennis U14 Boys, as well as a bronze in Athletics (Track & Field).
