It really hasn't been that long when you think about it, though I suppose the lack of a full December publication (owing to it being combined with our massive November Outturn) makes it feel that way. It was a stellar year in 2025, many firsts, many adventures, and many, many Society casks! But onwards and upwards; as we move into the new year, there's plenty to look forward to — Music & Malts will be returning in a few months' time, closely followed by our second-ever Whisky Wanderers Festivals, and of course, our new Flavour Profiles (but you'll have to wait a bit longer until they come around).

In the meantime, I've put together an incredible January issue for you to all look out for and start the year off on a good foot. Nine brand new bottles to ease you all into the new year with Cask 100.46 leading the charge as Malt of the Month — a milestone Distillery code matured in an ex-Australian Shiraz barrique (think prune juice, sautéed apples, and a colour that you just have to see to believe!) — our long-anticipated Heresy release Batch 24 Underwater Barbecue (matured exclusively using Orkney and Islay spirit) which has already been tantalising palates around Australia at various preview events.

Two standouts that will certainly be getting a lot of attention are 10.277 — unpeated spirit in the Oily & Coastal flavour profile and matured in sherry wood, I mean, come on, this is going to fly off the site — and Cask 105.44 Honey Jam, a 35-year-old single-cask Speyside release with big and beautiful sweet brunch flavours. We have only 12 of these bottles in the country and on sale for \$1,299!



At this point, you're probably thinking "Adam, how could this month get any better?" — WELL, I've got some good news for you. If you purchase **any January Outturn** bottling, you'll have the option to add on a single Mystery Malt bottling for just \$164! This will be an add-on available on every product page for January Outturn releases; you can add as many as you want — for example, buy two January Outturn bottles, add two mystery malts at \$164 each. Just for this month, and exclusively for newly released bottlings.

We say this every year, but there are big things in motion for 2026, and members will have plenty to look forward to. But, for now, check out Outturn, check out the virtual tasting kit, grab a mystery malt add-on, and I'll see you in person or online.

# DISTILLERY 100 WITH AN AUSSIE TWIST!

### TASTING NOTES

The colour has to be seen to be believed. Aroma descriptors followed suit – strawberry pop tarts just out of the toaster, blackcurrant squash and, slightly more upmarket, a champagne, cranberry, and cognac and bitter orange liqueur cocktail. On the palate this was fairly tannic and astringent at first before it developed a chunky sweetness of prune juice, and sautéed apples with brown sugar and cinnamon. Water added an afternoon tea with scones, clotted cream and strawberry jam next to a pot of rosehip tea. On the palate, the still grippy tannins were now well balanced by a fruity sweetness. Following seven years in an ex-bourbon hogshead, we transferred this whisky into a first fill Australian shiraz barrique.

### FROM THE TEAM

We've been sitting on this one for a few weeks, and are so excited to finally release this truly sublime 100.46 for Malt of the Month. Malt of the Month, for those who are a bit newer to the SMWS, is our monthly bottling that we love, recommend, and have a few to go around. But being (usually) single cask, it's always less to go around than we'd like. This month, we've gone with 100.46 Strawberry Pop Tarts. A 12-year-old single malt from distillery 100; a gorgeous Keith-based distillery in Speyside, Scotland. You almost never hear a peep out of this site, as almost none of it ever makes its way into the market as a single malt, but instead is predominantly blended into J&B. Our lucky stars, however, mean that not only do we get to see it through the SMWS as a cask strength single malt, but additionally matured in a phenomenal Australian 1st fill ex-Shiraz wine barrique. The colour on this truly needs to be seen to be believed. Wholly matured in Scotland, and lovingly matched up between Scottish spirit, Australian wood, and then back here for you to enjoy. Don't miss this.

This started out as two bourbon hogsheads of single malt Scotch whisky. One was transferred at 12 years old to a first-fill Spanish oak oloroso hogshead, while the other was transferred at 13 years old to a first-fill American oak oloroso hogshead. The casks were then married together before bottling. The result gives a wonderful nose, combining geraniums and ginger, gooseberry and gorse, lemon curd and liquorice, poached pears, plum sauce and polished oak. The palate, with nice chewy textures, meanders from pineapple, pink grapefruit and gin-based fruit cup to brown sugar, blackcurrant jam and strawberry angel delight, with cinnamon, ginger, cayenne and pink antiseptic, fluoride-free toothpaste toothpaste to finish.

Madeira cake came dipped in molten white chocolate and sprinkled with chunks of glacé cherries. On the palate, a syrupy-sweet opening salvo, with vanilla and hot cross buns joined by almond butter and a pinch of mace. With water, we found sugar cane soaking in freshly squeezed lemon juice, fruit loaf and pears. The palate matched this, with a continuation of Madeira cake and a hint of juniper, ginger and peaches too.

### TASTING NOTES


This had a bountiful aroma at first, one chock full of smoke-laced flowers, liquorice, smouldering heather, sweeter sherry impressions and singed orange peel. We also found deeper tones of barbecue smoke, coconut shavings, suncream and silky trails of distant peat smoke. Water brought wet moss, sandalwood, shoreline freshness, wet seaweed and wood-smoked ham. The neat palate balanced sweetness and salinity very evenly, with rich umami broths, charred shellfish, dark chocolate-coated stem ginger, salted caramel and smoked butter. With reduction came seawater, soy sauce, peat embers, cloves, and fragrant wood smoke from a beach bonfire.

### FROM THE TEAM

This small-batch blended malt was created by bringing together the worlds of bourbon and oloroso cask maturation, along with spirit from the islands of Orkney and Islay. There are Spanish and American oak influences in here that complement the savoury smoke, leaving a post-barbecue glow. A gustatory dram, sure to delight peat heads and foodies alike. This Heresy release had some shadow previews around the country in late 2025 and the resounding response was “When is this releasing? Can I order it now?!”. Well, it’s releasing on the 9th of January, and we’ve got a good allocation to go around!

The starting point for this small batch was two bourbon barrels of single malt Scotch whisky. We transferred one into a first-fill American oak oloroso hogshead and the other into a second-fill Spanish oak PX hogshead. The casks were then married together before bottling. The nose turned out fresh and fruity – fruit chewing gum, honeydew melon, orange and pear drops, with complicating elements of beeswax, lemongrass and chamomile, plus the promise of sweetness: crème brûlée, banoffee pie, white chocolate and foamy bananas. The palate gave us sherbet lemons, candied nuts and syrupy pears and peaches, with a dry finish of eucalyptus, tobacco, sweet chilli, cinnamon and cassia bark.

Constructed from chocolate cake fire bricks mortared with dark chocolate fondant, the barbecue was in full glow as it scorched pineapple rings and fresh coconut. Fuelling the flames with runny treacle and bourbon whisky, a burst of heat engulfed ripe mango slices and pain au raisin pastries. With a little water to control the heat we sat back to enjoy a rich mug of black coffee, served with delicious rum and raisin fudge. Sweet aromas joined the party from apricot jam on poached pears, before some lingering spicy notes, while cardamom pods stewed in a large pot of black chai tea, garnished with a few eucalyptus leaves for freshness.

### TASTING NOTES

Hungarian csíramalé (caramel) was served atop walnut paste and accompanied by a glass of peach and white grape juice. The nose was full of sweetness. With a luxurious runny honey on the palate, we paused for the appearance of refreshing melon and pineapple, followed by cherry jam. Water offered a warm cedar on the nose, joined by lemon juice and sugared almonds. Sparkling orange blossom water now cleansed the palate, opening up to coconut, bubblegum and apple.

### FROM THE TEAM

It's not every day that the Tasting Panel is unanimous about anything. But when reviewing the notes and the first thing that catches your eye is a panellist's big, bold "BEAUTIFUL!" as the first descriptor for the nose, you know you have something very precious. Distilled in 1988 from stills powered by the naked flame — which some say helps produce a fruitier distillate — this is one of those relics of another era that should not be ignored. While it lands in the Society's Sweet, Fruity & Mellow flavour profile, it displays the hallmarks of age and great maturity.

Honey, caramel, ripe melon and pineapple saturate the nose, while on the palate there is a balance of darker notes, with exotic cedar wood, nutty almond aromas and refreshing mentholic notes leading to more intense fruity flavours. Whether you're looking for a superb sipper or a dram with gravitas and groove in equal measure, this is it. Sometimes the better stories are the simpler ones, and this one is a reminder that the humble old bourbon hogshead can reveal some mouthwatering flavours. 35 years in a single cask for just \$1,299...maybe 2026 is your year?

The inviting nose conjured a melange of aromas – candied orange slices, cherries dipped in chocolate, walnut bread, ginger-infused jaffa cakes and, always in the background, a hot toddy with brandy. It was “very potent”, like a bone-dry martini where the glass gets rinsed with vermouth and then discarded. In the aftertaste we sipped a rich and highly caffeinated Turkish coffee spiced with cardamom. Following the liberal addition of water, we imagined chopping the firewood for that night’s stay in our log cabin. Resting, we sat on the pine cone-covered forest floor and enjoyed sourdough pumpernickel bread and bärentatzen: a soft, spicy chocolate cookie in the shape of a bear’s paw.

A complex orchestration of honeysuckle, pomegranate and earl grey tea harmonised with sizzling pork chops, glazed with manuka honey and served with sweet apple sauce on an antique writing desk. Base notes of candied orange peel, smashed hazelnuts and virgin olive oil created rich yet silky textures that perfectly carried the other flavours. A small dash of water established an ensemble of sweet ginger wine, maple syrup and marmalade, alongside a quartet of cassia bark, marzipan, Christmas cake and pineapple flambéed in armagnac. The sticky, syrupy notes reached a delightful crescendo before an encore of dark chocolate, toasted almonds and tobacco. At 28 years of age, we combined selected casks from the same distillery. We then returned the single malt into a variety of different casks to develop further. This is one of those casks.

### TASTING NOTES

A cocktail of grapes, sour plum candy and evaporated milk was being shaken nearby, its scent mingled with the bouquet of luxury floral hand cream. The palate was mouthwatering, with sherbet lemons and orange, clove and toffee, and rose jelly doughnuts. Water introduced plums to the nose, along with hot linoleum, vanilla and oregano biscuits, cut grass and paraffin candles. We could now taste rum 'n' raisin ice cream, pencil shavings soaking in coconut milk, and lemon curd.



### FROM THE TEAM

Oh, just simply divine! A juicy and floral 22-year-old single-cask, panel-approved, Premium-livery bottling. Some citrus and brioche dough combined with toffee ice cream and coconut milk. The spirit from this distillery is so underrated, yet every bottling we put out is just oozing with elegance. The last 72 we saw was a 40-year-old single-cask, this one has been matured for 22 years exclusively in a 1st fill ex-bourbon barrel. We have a solid number of them in the country, and this is your chance to own such a whisky at the incredible price of \$379. Check out Zac's cask review on our YouTube channel!

We found this one presented on the lighter side, with a lovely, low-level hum of vanilla, spiced marmalade and butterscotch. With a little time we also noted cream soda, fabric softener and foam strawberry sweeties. Reduction brought out a sprightly lemon zest note, with menthol tobacco, pine cones and chamois leather adding a little more weight. The mouth was quite wood-forward with lots of nice cupboard spices, freshly sawn oak, toasted coconut and some nicely exotic suggestions of mango and grapefruit. Water enhanced these fruitier notes and maintained the mango and pineapple flavours, with spiced vanilla, sponge cake, wood resins and camphor all in the background.

An array of aromas greeted the Panel – juniper, freshly cut pine trees, lime cordial and roses, as well as candy floss and ground almonds. To taste we had a margarita of tequila, triple sec, sugar and fresh lime juice. We then moistened the rim of the glass with a lime wedge and dip rimmed it in a sugar-salt mixture. Following reduction, the scent of roses was joined by nutmeg, allspice and cedar next to freesia and pears. On the palate, we now found an east European plum brandy called slivovitz aged in oak casks, giving it a harmonious fruit flavour with subtle woody undertones.

### TASTING NOTES

The wonderful aroma was brimming with bright, citric fruit acids, coastal freshness, waxes, salted peanuts and cashews. We also got nicely leathery impressions of texture and waxiness behind that wall of freshness. With water we found that it opened up and revealed lovely aromatic notes of sea greens, white flowers, chalky beach pebbles and mineral salts. The neat palate was immediately big and assertively powerful. It was also very oily in texture, with lots of sunflower and mineral elements, coastal vibrancy, waxiness and an increasing salinity. With water we got a tinge of cider apple funkiness, more mixed salted nuts and more of those fantastic salty and mineral qualities. Some medicinal notes and gorse flowers too. This was matured in a bourbon hogshead for nine years before being transferred to a second fill American oak PX hogshead.



### FROM THE TEAM

Our last Outturn featured one of the first DRDF (Deep, Rich & Dried Fruits) bottlings from Distillery 10 that we've seen in quite a while...this month we're upping those stakes with Cask 10.277 Fire without smoke. Nine years in an ex-bourbon hogshead and another two years in a 2nd fill ex-American oak Pedro Ximénez (a thick, syrupy sherry variety) hogshead... think daisies in a fresh meadow, plenty of minerality, an oily, waxy texture, and the iconic salinity of an Islay Oily & Coastal. This will vanish on Outturn day. Oily & Coastal sherried Islay malt...don't miss it.

We found this one immediately bright and smoky, with a chiselled, bone-dry peat profile. There was also a wonderful coastal edge that brought persistent freshness, brittle smoke, bubblegum, aniseed distillate and bath salts. We all really enjoyed this one! With water it maintained this sharp and salty balance, but added in notes of salted peanuts, seawater, grapefruit and charred pineapple. The neat palate was superbly clean, sharp and pristinely peaty, with a big streak of medicine in the form of bandages and ointments. With water it got surprisingly waxier in texture, along with a 'farmier' profile and a broader, richer peat flavour. We noted camphor, lanolin, pickling brine and malt vinegar.

### TASTING NOTES

Perhaps unusually for gin, this had enough interest and flavour to be enjoyed neat. Panellists noses quickly identified juniper and pine freshness, before we picked up perfumed sweets (parma violets, fruit jellies, sherbet straws), boudoir suggestions of potpourri and lavender bath bombs, and orange peel and cloves in a wooden box. The ozone freshness and sherbet suggested flying saucers on a boat. The taste combined candy store sweetness (lemon bonbons, rose and lemon Turkish delight) with department store perfume counters and herbal hints of rosemary, thyme and green chartreuse. The finish stayed sweet but also became chalky and drying, conjuring up coltsfoot rock and cinnamon.



### FROM THE TEAM

It's unusual for us to feature a gin in Outturn (yes, we do produce single-cask, cask-strength gin), and even more unusual to give it a spotlight and little local write up...but this is really something quite unique and intriguing. For starters, it spent FOUR years in wood (a 2nd fill ex-bourbon barrel). A fresh pour immediately on the nose gives lavender and lemon citrus hard candy lollies with some creamy white chocolate (and a touch of aniseed, like white chocolate & raspberry liquorice bullets). The palate is so soft, goes down a real treat and honestly tastes like Bubble O'Bill Ice-cream. This is an incredible sipper to have neat over summer. Add some ice, add some tonic or soda, and you'll be set. 36 bottles to go around — pick yours up on Jan 9!
