I've just returned from Cleveland, Tennessee and Southern Africa - two places that don't share a border on any map, yet met beautifully in the flow of calling and covenant. Ministry has a way of weaving distant places together through faithful relationships and moments only God could arrange.

For over thirty years, I've walked in friendship with Perry Stone. The youth outreach of his ministry, Omega Center International, hosts an annual gathering called WarriorFest - a weekend set apart for the next generation. It draws young people from across the nation into an atmosphere where hearts are awakened and futures begin to take shape.

This year, 2,600 youth were present, and the room carried a tangible sense of the supernatural. I had the honor of speaking in the Saturday morning session, sharing a message on forgiveness and restoration, choosing to release those who have wounded us and reclaim the life that follows. The response was powerful. Hundreds stepped forward, making a decision to forgive, let go, and live again!

Our time in Africa carried a kind of joy that doesn't fit neatly into words. It was more than a trip, it was a convergence of lifelong friendships, shared mission, and a milestone I'll never forget. I found myself celebrating my 60th birthday across two nations in a single day, which feels about right for a life that's rarely stayed within borders.

We began in South Africa, reconnecting with friends from Healing Place Church in Baton Rouge. From there, the journey unfolded into Mozambique and then Eswatini for a church dedication. Each nation holds its own story, its own weight of memory, and a deep

place in my heart. These aren't just destinations to me; they are sacred ground marked by years of ministry, relationship, and the unmistakable fingerprints of God at work.

There's something deeply rewarding about reconnecting with old friends while watching new relationships take root. What continues to mark my years in Southern Africa is this: relationships built there carry a rare strength. Time doesn't weaken them, and distance doesn't dilute them. If anything, they seem to grow deeper, steadier, and more enduring with every passing season.
