

Performances that run past curfew by five minutes result in a \$20,000 fine, with every additional minute upping the total by \$1,000

Coachella fined \$117,000 for violating curfew agreement with Indio, California. Performances ran past curfew by 22-25 minutes each night during the festival's first weekend. The agreement between Goldenvoice and the city of Indio in 2013 stipulated a \$20,000 fine for every five-minute extension past curfew, with an additional \$1,000 for every minute thereafter. The fine goes to the Indio General Fund for public works, infrastructure, and fire department. Frank Ocean's set was delayed due to an ankle injury during rehearsals, resulting in a post-midnight finish.



France's summer festivals will feature Pikip's Solar Speakers, a solar-powered mobile DJ booth created by Pantin-based company Pikip. The "Off-Grid" DJ kit uses photovoltaic cells on the roof to support two CDJs, two turntables, a mixer, amp, and speakers that can power a crowd of 1,500 for 10 hours on a single charge. Founder Julien Feuillet said they discovered horn speakers that produce a powerful sound using less energy. The Solar Speakers were previously used in illegal raves before being scaled up for larger events like Gay Pride in Marseille.

60% of musicians are already using Al to make music, study finds 47% of users interviewed by distribution music company Ditto Music said they would use Al for their songwriting.

Ditto Music's recent study of over 1,200 users revealed that 60% of musicians are already using Al for music-related tasks. Of those interviewed, 77% would use Al for album artwork, 66% for mixing and mastering, 62% for music production, and 47% for songwriting.

CEO Lee Parsons praised musicians for embracing technology and Ditto's dedication to providing the latest tools and support for artists. In other news, researchers at Google have developed MusicLM, an Al tool that generates complex songs from text captions.

# Black Coffee to make history as the first South African DJ to perform at Madison Square Garden, NY, this October.

Black Coffee, a Grammy award-winning DJ, has longed to perform at New York's Madison Square Garden and his dream will soon come to fruition later this year. He will be the first South African DJ/producer to headline the venue, which has a capacity of over 20,700 people. The "Drive" hitmaker shared the exciting news on Instagram, expressing his joy about performing his music and sound at the highest level possible and reaching the largest audience imaginable. Black Coffee also stated that his debut at Madison Square Garden has been a dream of his for many years and he is excited that it is finally becoming a reality.



Mr Thela, a local DJ and producer hailing from Samora Machel, Phillipi in Cape Town, is set to bring the vibrant sound of Gqom to South Korea. Following in the footsteps of Grammy Awardwinning South African artists like Zakes Bantwini, Nomcebo Zikode, and Wouter Kellerman, Mr Thela is preparing for his first international gig in Seoul and Songtan this March.

At just 23 years old, Simphiwe Sihawu (Mr Thela's real name) is already making waves in the music industry. His solo project Tronics Land Series 1 was released in November 2022, and he gained recognition for his joint album Make Cape Town Great Again with DJ Mshayi, which features a new Gqom gospel sound while staying true to the genre's roots in KwaZulu-Natal.

The album's lead track iParty became a hit across the country and was even picked up by streaming giant Netflix for the soundtrack of the movie Jiva. Make Cape Town Great Again was certified platinum by the Recording Industry of South Africa (RiSA) and was nominated for Best Gqom Album at the South African Music Awards (Sama) 2021. With his talent and success, Mr Thela is another shining example of South Africa's thriving music industry and its global impact.

### **BASS MOTION CONTROL**

RCF has made significant strides in achieving solid low-end performance in the main speaker with its new Bass Motion Control (BMC). Instead of the high-pass filter found in most speakers, which can alter the phase behavior of the cone, BMC creates a complete map of the dynamic behavior that only limits over excursions. This feature provides total freedom of signal reproduction for the woofer, resulting in stronger lowend reinforcement.

#### **FIRPHASE TECHNOLOGY**

RCF's proprietary FiRPHASE technology allows for coherent distribution of sound for all listeners without phase distortions. By measuring the speaker phase, the ART 9 speakers adapt the phase without altering equalization. They can also take into account the weak points of the transducers and the resonances/cancellations of the cabinet. This feature ensures a clean, crisp, and powerful sound that enhances performance and business.

#### **EQ AND MIXER SECTION**

RCF has kept the back of the ART 9 series simple, featuring a single combo XLR/TRS input and balanced line output, a power indication and overload/clip light, a volume knob, and an EQ selector. Users can choose between a linear response, a boosted setting, and a stage mode for monitor use.

# The ART 9 series features three models, each designed to suit different applications.

### **RCF ART 910-A**

The RCF ART 910-A is the smallest speaker in the series but can deliver a respectable 130 dB SPL. Its True Resistive Waveguide provides 100-degree x 60-degree coverage with the 1.75" compression driver, and despite its smaller 10" woofer, it still extends down to 50 Hz on the low end. Its compact size makes it easy to transport and set up, making it ideal for small gigs, coffee shops, or restaurants.

### **RCF ART 912-A**

The 912-A is the next size up, featuring a 12" woofer for greater lowend pressurization. Many of the other specifications are similar to the 910-A, including the dispersion pattern, frequency response range, and maximum SPL. However, the RCF ART 912-A is capable of delivering a slightly higher power output, with a peak power of 1400 watts and a continuous power of 700 watts. This makes it a great choice for larger venues or events where more low-end power is required. The RCF ART 912-A also features a unique design that allows it to be used as a main PA speaker or as a floor monitor, thanks to its asymmetrical shape and angled cabinet design.

## **RCF ART 932-A**

The ART 932-A is a dual 12" woofer model that provides excellent lowend response with its large 3" voice coil. The dispersion pattern is slightly different than the 910/912-A, with a 90-degree x 60-degree coverage pattern that makes it well-suited for applications that require longer throw distances.

Its increased output also makes it a great fit for larger venues and outdoor events. The 932-A has enough power to perform as a standalone main speaker, but can also be used as a high-output monitor for larger stages.

### **RCF ART 935-A**

The RCF ART 935-A is a tri-amped speaker that features a 15" woofer, a 4" midrange driver, and a 1.75" compression driver. This configuration offers more power and versatility, making it a popular choice for larger live sound applications such as festivals, concerts, and outdoor events.

The StreamSet's mic uses Audio-Technica's 20 Series capsule, which sits about an inch from the mouth, providing a super-present sound, and resists plosives and mechanical noise The dynamic range of the StreamSet capsule means it won't be the weak link in the signal chain, even in loud environments. The USB version of the headset itself has no hard HPF rolloff of the low end and is resistant to distortion, even at high volumes.

StreamSet is a workhorse, looks wellsuited to extended use, and its Audio-Technica logo on the earcups tells its audience and colleagues that the user is serious about sound.

# **HOW TO BEATMATCH:**

# The basics done well.

f you've ever been to a club or party where a DJ is playing music, you've likely experienced beatmatching. It's a fundamental technique that every aspiring DJ must learn to master if they want to create seamless transitions between tracks and keep the dance floor moving.

Beatmatching involves synchronizing the tempo (speed) and phase (beat placement) of two or more tracks so that they play in perfect harmony. It's a combination of technical ability and musical understanding, and it takes time and practice to master. But with the right guidance and approach, anyone can learn how to beatmatch.

The core concept of beatmatching is ensuring that two tracks play at the same speed when the DJ wants to mix songs together. This lets the listeners stay in the groove when they're dancing, and prevents clunky transitions where the beat is all over the place and the music's flow is interrupted.

There are two main components of beatmatching: tempo matching and beat alignment. Tempo matching involves making sure the BPM (beats per minute) is the same between the first track and the second track. If the tracks playing have the same tempo (for example, 120BPM), you can transition between them while keeping the same groove rolling.

The second component is beat alignment - making sure the beats within a bar are synchronized between the two songs. For example, most music is counted in four - 1, 2, 3, 4. You want to make sure that beats 1 to 4 are all aligned between the first playing track and the next track before you bring up the volume of the second track and start your transition.

Beatmatching is important for several reasons. By playing tracks at the same BPM, the DJ can create seamless transitions where it seems like two songs are blended into one. This is important because it prevents clunky transitions where the beat is all over the place and the music's flow is interrupted.

Another important reason for beatmatching is to make sure that the instrumentation, particularly the rhythm section, is aligned between track B and A. It's not just about getting two tracks to play at the same speed, but also that the arrangements are lined up in a complimentary way.

For example, you want to make sure that the kick drums and snare drums of both tracks are in the same place, otherwise, it will make for a confusing transition that interrupts the groove of the dance floor. If two tracks are beat matched and the songs still clash, you can use EQ mixing to improve the transition.

Here is a step-by-step method for a novice DJ to learn how to beatmatch:

- Start with two tracks that have a similar tempo and structure. This will make it easier to match the beats.
- Listen to the first track and identify the downbeat (the first beat of the bar). Tap your foot or nod your head along with the beat to get a feel for the rhythm.
- Cue the second track and listen to it through headphones. Find the downbeat and use the pitch fader to adjust the tempo of the track so that it matches the tempo of the first track.
- Once you have matched the tempo, listen for the beat of the second track and try to align it with the beat of the first track. Use the jog wheel or vinyl to manually adjust the placement of the beat until it is perfectly in sync with the first track.
- Listen to the tracks together through headphones and adjust the tempo and phase as needed until they sound like they are playing as one cohesive mix.
- Once the tracks are beatmatched, you can begin to blend them together by gradually bringing in the volume of the second track and slowly fading out the first track. Use EQ and volume controls to ensure that the two tracks complement each other and create a seamless transition.
- Practice beatmatching with different genres and tempos to develop your skills and expand your musical knowledge.

Beatmatching is a skill that takes time and practice to master, so don't get discouraged if it doesn't come easily at first. Keep practicing and experimenting with different techniques, and you'll soon be able to mix tracks like a pro.





# 1. Can you tell us about your journey as a DJ? How did you get started in this industry?

My journey started in music production, the DJing really stemmed from that. As a young teenager I found dance music and started messing around making it. I met my girlfriend (now wife) who played some of my tracks to her brother James G who was in the industry. Through that I got my first few releases and the rest is history.

# 2. What do you think sets you apart from other DJs in the industry?

It's getting tougher and tougher to stand out in the dance music industry because the barrier to entry is much lower. It's not something that really sets me apart necessarily, but I think my production is the main differentiating factor. A lot of people find me through the music I make, which in the current climate is super important.

# 3. How do you go about preparing for a set or a gig?

I'll keep a few playlists up to date with my own music at the top of the list. I'll usually have a good idea of which track I'll be opening with, maybe the second or third, and the closing track. Everything else between I figure out in the moment by feeling out the energy level in the room and watching people's reactions.

4. Can you share with us some of your most memorable performances or experiences as a DJ?

Playing Coachella recently is 100% the most important show I have ever played in my career and an absolute high point. I've had some amazing moments though, from playing my first show outside of my home town and realising my music was reaching further than Joburg, to my first show outside of South Africa in Mozambique, to my first shows off the African continent in Brazil and Australia - and tons in between.

One that I will never forget was a show I played on a rooftop in Sao Paolo. It wasn't huge, around 600 people, but the energy was electric!



5. How do you stay up-todate with the latest music trends and incorporate them into your sets?

Really there is nothing else to it other than being aware. Following the right playlists on Spotify and keeping an eye on the Beatport charts are also great. TikTok is of course an important tool as well. As a DJ, if you can get the content delivered to your feed which is relevant to dance music and the subgenres you are interested in it can be a great way to pick up which tracks are gaining momentum.

6. How do you keep the energy level high and the crowd engaged during your performances?

I set up hot cues on every track I play out so I can jump to different sections of it if I see the crowd energy dip. It works like a push and pull though, there needs to be contrast. Playing a few high energy records with drums and percussion that runs through pretty much the whole time works great to keep the crowd moving, but too much of that without any relief is fatiguing. Moving to a few groovier records with some chunk but less energy for a little while will make the move back to higher energy records even more impactful.

# 7. What advice would you give to someone who is just starting out as a DJ?

Figure out what sets you apart and play to that strength. You've got to find your edge. If you have the time and capacity, learning to produce music/working with someone will really help as that will be the product that people will find you through.

# 8. What do you think is the most important skill for a DJ to have?

The technical side of DJing is much easier than it used to be, but creating and maintaining a vibe in a room is the most important skill. Nothing will beat playing the right record at the right time.

# 9. How do you handle mistakes during a performance?

I make mistakes, everybody does! All you can do is work quickly to compose yourself, don't get flustered, fix what you can as quickly as you can and just keep going. Think ahead to the next record, push the mistake to the back of your mind. You'll have time to reflect on it after the set, during your set is not the time to dwell on it. Chances are most people didn't even notice!

# 10. What are your plans for the future, both as a DJ and in your personal life?

Career-wise it's taken a step up so I am going to see how far this can go. We have some big things planned and there is more of a team behind me now than there has been in the past, so I am very much looking forward to the future. In my personal life, my wife and I recently moved to the UK and are setting up our lives there now which we are really enjoying. Just going to take each day as it comes!

Turntables are the essence of DJ-ing! Although digital media players now reign supreme in the DJ booths of most clubs and festivals, many DJs still maintain their vinyl collection and prefer spinning and scratching on real turntables. Here's our list of some of the best DJ turntables available today.

#### **QUICK FACTS: DJ TURNTABLES**

DJ turntables are still an important tool for many DJs. But what makes a good DJ turntable? One indispensable feature is pitch control for manipulating the tempo (BPM) of the playing record. In addition to this, the turntable should start and stop very quickly.

Furthermore, when "nudging" and slowing down the record (important to keep the beat), you must be able to maintain full control over the vinyl.

In DJng, it is very important that the record continues to play smoothly after it is held and then released.

Good DJ turntables are direct-drive (the motor directly drives the shaft) and maintain the selected RPM very accurately. Some models have a curved tonearm, while others feature a straight one.

The shape of the tonearm determines which type of cartridge and needle must be used. Mixing DJs usually prefer turntables with curved tonearms, while scratch DJs often swear by straight arms.

In order for the needle to sit firmly in the groove, you need to be able to precisely adjust the counterweight on the tonearm. "Antiskating" is also important in this context - a counterforce that depends on the tonearm position.

For techniques such as scratching, it's essential that the needle doesn't skip! Low frequencies and resonances also shouldn't affect the needle and the tonearm too much.

Good stability is another requirement for a DJ turntable. The feet should have good shock absorption and ideally be height-adjustable. Some DJ turntables offer a built-in phono preamp and thus directly provide a line-level output signal.
