


HISTORY OF SPIP HISTORY OF SPIP HISTORY OF SPIP

SPIP officially opened in March 2010 as the ideal alternative International Programme of Thailand on the campus of Srinakharinwirot University, Bangkok. The programme was established with the strong support and supervision of Prasarnmit Demonstration School (secondary) entirely based on the Cambridge Curriculum . Originally comprising of currentry just 70 students at the start, SPIP has since grown to more than 450, now.

Over the past sixty years, the Prasarnmit Demonstration School (secondary) has been widely recognized as an institution of considerable quality and this has lead to the high standard quality of SPIP as well. SPIP's academic programmeis primarily structured for students who wish to enter universities abroad or outstanding international programmes at Thai Universities. The SPIP programme is accredited by the Thai Ministry of Education (MOE) which recognizes the SPIP diploma as equivalent to the Thai secondary school certificate

As a Cambridge International Centre, accredited by Cambridge International Examinations, SPIP is eligible to conduct Cambridge IGCSE and A level examinations and Cambridge Checkpoint tests. The Cambridge IGCSEs are recognized by the MOE as being equivalent to the Thai Secondary School Certificate.
