
On the other hand, there are those who by title are parents, but for some reason have left home; this day is not to point them out and question them, but to make them reflect on the importance of their role as parents.



ulce Nombre de Copan. Two and a half hours from the city of San Pedro Sula on the CA-4 highway in the western part of the country, is the municipality of Dulce Nombre de Copan, which has a cultural heritage based on puriculture, coffee growing, cattle raising and wood art.

Becerra, a native of this municipality. Another of the characteristics of the municipality of Copaneco is its catholic church, which is a connection between the past and the current community of Dulcenombrina.

The idea of the mural comes from the current mayor José Misael Ardon Ulloa, a young entrepreneur of the area who aspires to bring development to the community of Dulcembrina. The tourism commission, presided by Mrs. Iris Bueso and Mrs. Marilyn Duarte, also collaborated.

Dulce Nombre has a population of 7 thousand inhabitants between neighborhoods, colonies, hamlets and villages.

We spoke with Mayor Misael Ardon and he told us the challenges he faces in this new mandate, "one of them is the paving of the detour to the area, promoting tourism and bringing economic development".

One of the strategies is the mural painting that has attracted the attention of locals and neighbors and has made many of the town's children return

The legacy that the mayor wishes to leave in this picturesque town is "to promote a world of opportunities for the neighbors of the community and to encourage the entrepreneurial culture".

# The double life of a single parent



owadays, being a single parent almost normal for society, but what does it mean to be a single parent and what are the repercussions? These can be divorce, physical loss of the mother, abandonment and other life circumstances, so you must carry out both roles: you must perform household chores and work to provide for your children, while remaining the authority figure. In addition, single parents face criticisms, prejudices, challenges and pressures from society, which in turn creates fears and frustrations.

All this is triggered by being considered incapable of performing all these tasks alone, since society makes them believe that without the figure of a mother, children are doomed to live a life without love and good care.

On the other hand, the absence of a mother figure can have repercussions in children's lives, such as poor school performance, poor interpersonal relationships, feelings of loneliness, and they may even feel guilty about the situation. In spite of this, single parents look for ways to make their children feel that they are not alone and try to find in themselves the positive memories that marked their childhood, in order to recreate them with their children and thus create better bonds.

Whatever formula you are using to cope, remember that you are doing it right; because there is no manual for parenting.

Finally, here's some advice from a single dad who went through the same situation. "I guess my single dad advice is: be kind to yourself. If you're going through a tough time, don't dramatize or let your fears take over. Believe me, I know it's hard, but try this: focus on the present, get through one day at a time. Or even, one hour at a time. Get through that (and you will, I'm sure) and then deal with the next hour."








# Alex Villela, the writer and collector



Fifteen years ago, Villela decided to venture into the world of digital writing and international literary groups and remained so until June 2022, when he published his first physical book, which is available on Amazon and in some bookstores in Tegucigalpa and Spain.

The theme of his works consists of personal experiences, with some successes, as well as the spiritual, tragedy, illness and the yearning of the human being to transcend the physical, so his works convey a metaphysical, spiritual message and describes the absurdity of life in an artistic way; he describes the human subconscious through surrealism and magical rea-

#### eing a father is one of the best things that has happened to many men, regardless of the fact that for some life situations they have had to separate from their wives. Such is the case of John Franklin Girón, a man who was married to his wife for three years, but for some reasons they decided to separate. According to Girón, the separation was difficult because of having a daughter, having to leave his home and the distance he would now have with his daughter, since she stayed with her mother. The separation was by mutual agreement and they separated as a couple, not as

parents. In the face of the situation,

both were mature and during the pandemic, his daughter stayed with him in order to receive her classes. Girón comes from a broken home, so he knows how difficult it is not to have a father, to be there in the process of formation, which ultimately brings repercussions in the lives of children. But this is not her case and she currently gives thanks to God because both of them have

coped with the separation in a healthy way. For Girón his life before having children was an ordinary life, meaningless, with nothing more than goals for him, but when he had his daughter, his life changed and now he visualizes their life, what he will give her in terms of education, where he will get to support her, especially that love that has no price, because according to him, you do not need money to be a good father; because although money is a fundamental part to support the basic needs of children, it is more important to share moral, spiritual and civic values to children.

That is why he shares quality time with his daughter. During recesses he goes to drop off her lunch at school and later she visits him at work and spends as much time with him as she wants. Sunday is a family day, in which they share and do recreational activities, also, she shares her spiritual formation by going to church. With her ex-partner, Giron agrees that they can go out as a functional family.

"We cannot destroy the emotional part of our children, we must forget about ourselves and think about our children, that this is their time so they can play and share," she said in relation to their outings. In that sense, she emphasized that, when there is a separation of spouse, they separate as a couple, but not from the children. "For me, my daughter is one of the great blessings that God has been able to give me, to try to be a better person, to learn to be a father"; that is why he likes a song that is very sound for Father's Day, which is "Lord I want to be like you, because he wants to be






# Honduran Wilmer Cárcamo stands out in the United Kingdom for his brand Caribe Coffee Co.

ilmer Cárcamo is a proud Ceibeño, Honduran, husband, father, entrepreneur, investor and representative of our beautiful country Honduras in foreign lands. CEO & Co-Founder of Caribe Coffee Co. a UK based company with multiple national awards and recently with participation in the famous BBC show DRAGONS' DEN. Receiving an offer from Billionaire "Peter Jones". Born in very limited conditions where many times he had nothing to eat, but all these limitations led him to create a creative and dreamy personality. After graduating from the Manuel Bonilla Institute in 2007 as a Commercial Expert and Public Accountant and working since he was 10 years old to be able to help at home. Cárcamo says he had the opportunity to travel to the Cayman Islands with the help of family that has been important in his life. He recalls that he started cleaning floors in a supermarket in the Cayman Islands without speaking English, but after hard work 3 years later he became the manager of the same supermarket where he started cleaning floors. All this happened after working up to 20 hours a day and touching every department of the same supermarket including dredge driver. After that he decided with his wife and children, to immigrate to the UK due to medical circumstances of my eldest son and start from scratch, he decided to invest in a new venture, "Caribe Coffee Co.". Within his venture he is the key person in Caribe Coffee Co. since he is in charge of the commercial relations with direct importers of specialty coffee, roasters and coffee distributors in the United Kingdom. His vision is to improve the commercial links between Honduran and UK coffee producers. In doing so to elevate their position in the coffee industry and improve their livelihoods. Something he feels strongly about because he knows first hand the difficulties that families in our developing countries can face. His strengths lie in market strategy, advertising, leadership and the use of social media to effectively and positively grow businesses. "At the moment our company

### How did the idea for Caribe Coffee CO come about?

It came about after emigrating from the Grand Cayman Islands to the United Kingdom due to medical circumstances of his eldest son (Maddox). He suffers from a very rare genetic condition (only less than 200 people in the world). This led us to make extreme changes as a family and entrepreneurs, we left everything in the Cayman Islands including our construction company (turning over 6 figures a year in the first year) and started from scratch in the UK as all our savings were invested in our son's health. Seeing the need for better coffees and understanding the market we decided to invest the last of our savings (£5,000) to start importing coffee directly from Honduras to the UK. The beginnings were in local markets during one of the harshest winters in the UK with a 2' x 6' foot table offering free coffee samples.

#### Why the name?

The name was created because of the place where my wife and I met and that was in the Caribbean, an important part of our country Honduras.

### What is the strength of Caribe Coffee CO?

The strength is the online sales (wholesale and retail) of Specialty coffees exclusively from Honduras and the creation of Media (Advertising).

What is the secret of your products? The quality of the product, but the biggest secret is that we understand our customers and to be able to offer that quality in the best way. Excellent Customer Service is very important.


#### How has the acceptance of your business been?

In addition, it has a structure that includes a 501(c)3 corporation Sandy Lightouse Ministries Inc. in the United States and a non-governmental organization of the same name

# Andy Lopez the man passionate about rescuing people on the island of Roatan


Andy Lopez discovered a passion for rescuing people at a very young age, that same passion has led him to volunteer his time.






old, in this month of March and 58 years of marriage with his wife Fredesvinda Brito.
