With various power settings and functions we've yet to see, the Sonic Screwdriver is the ultimate indispensable tool to have when adventuring through time and space!

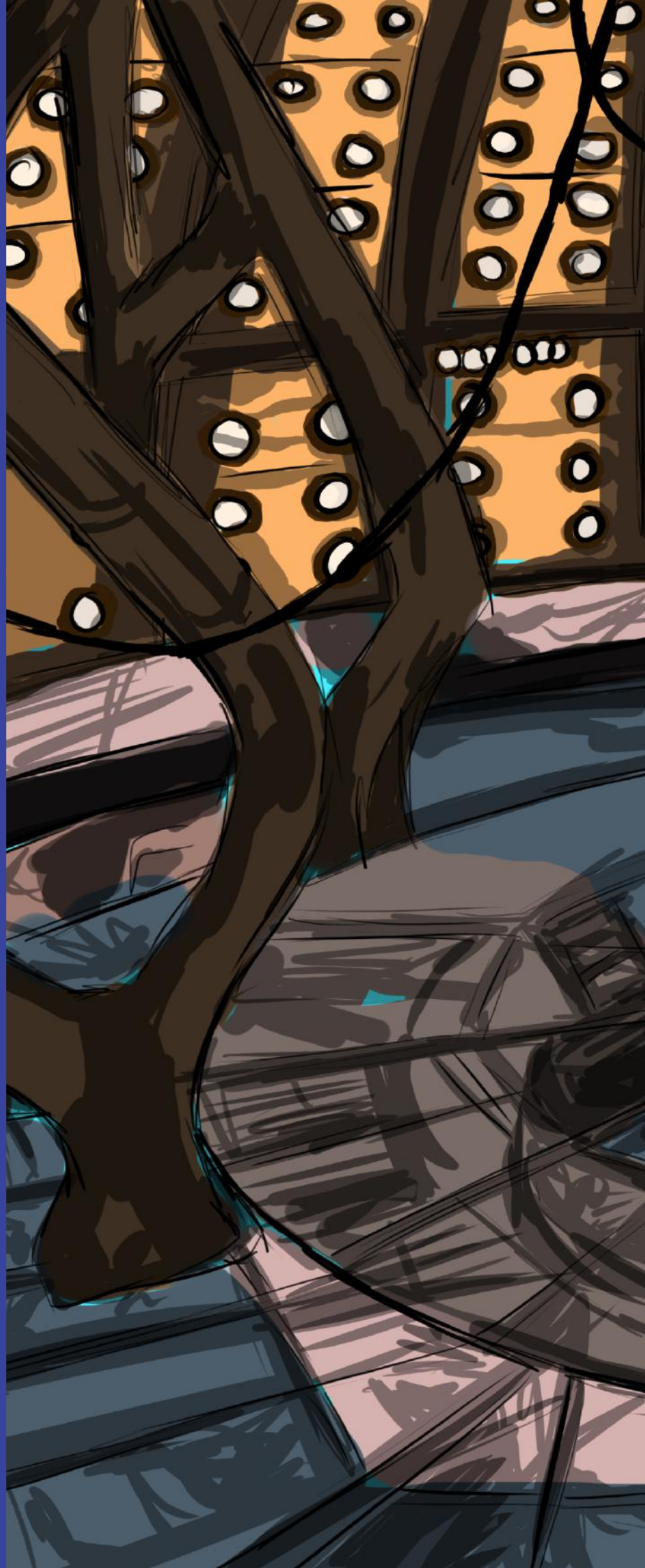
IT DOESN'T DO WOOD

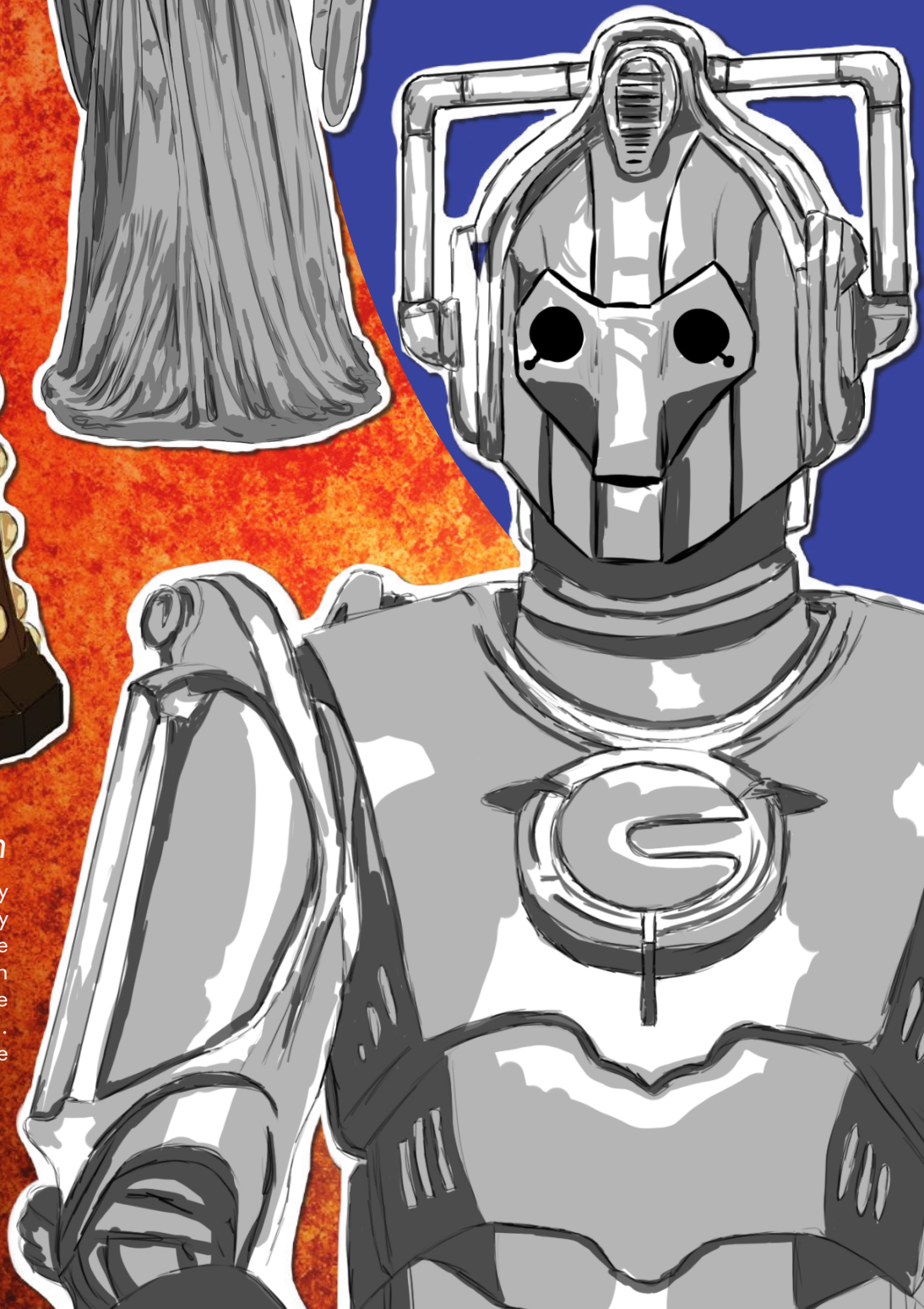
Cybermen

Cybermen are cybernetically augmented humanoids. They want to upgrade all compatible lifeforms so that cybermen can rule the galaxy. They are devoid of all human emotion. They have been around since the first Doctor.



Weeping Angels

Weeping Angels are a powerful species of quantum-locked humanoids. They can only move when they aren't being observed. They kill their victims by dropping them into the past and letting them live out their full lives, allowing the angels to feast on the time energy given off. Angels are also known to kill by snapping their victims' necks.



Regeneration

Regeneration happens at the end of a time lord's life where they can be 'reborn' with a different face, allowing them to live multiple lives.

The Tenth Doctor, who had previously regenerated and kept the same face during the Planetary Relocation Incident, met his regeneration into the Eleventh Doctor as a result of radiation poisoning intentionally incurred to save the life of Wilfred Mott after thwarting Rassilon's Final Sanction (Lord president of the Time Lord's High Council).
