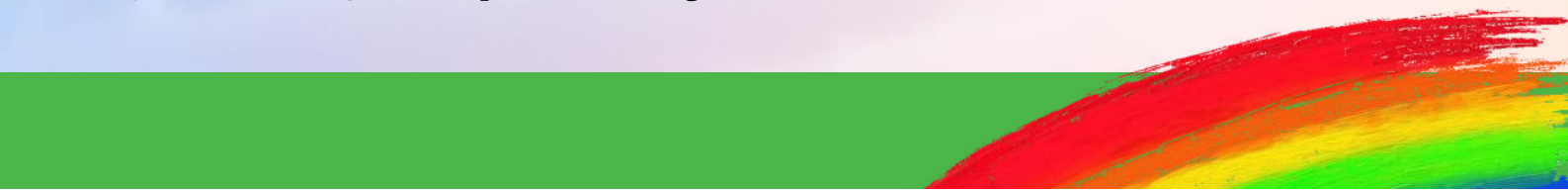

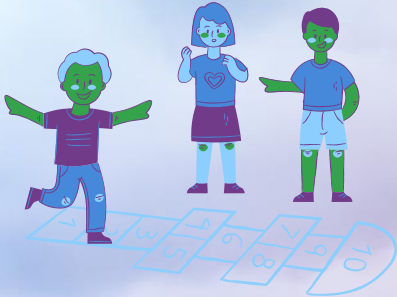
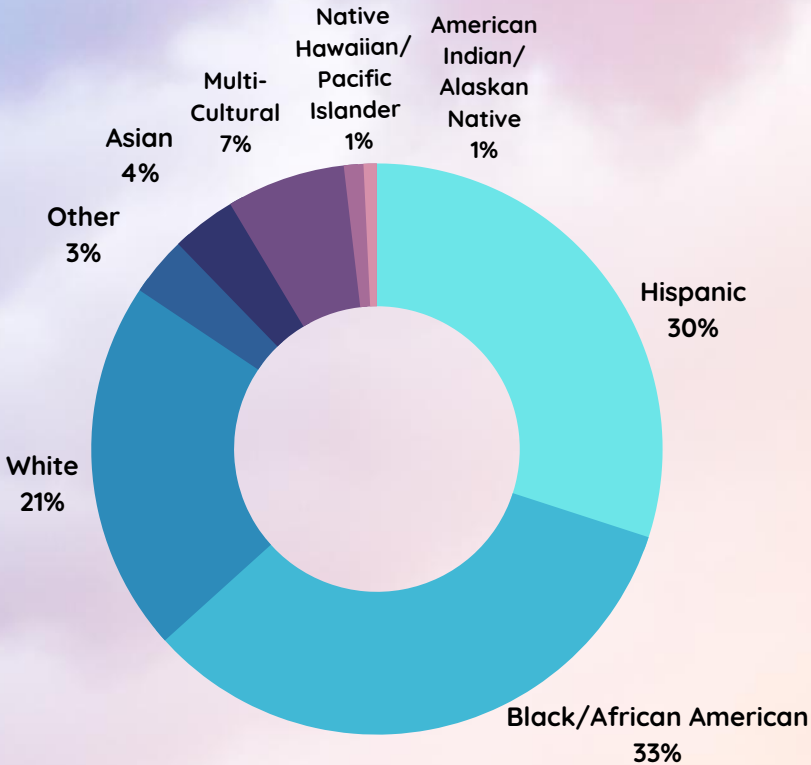

Children Served by Race/Ethnicity:

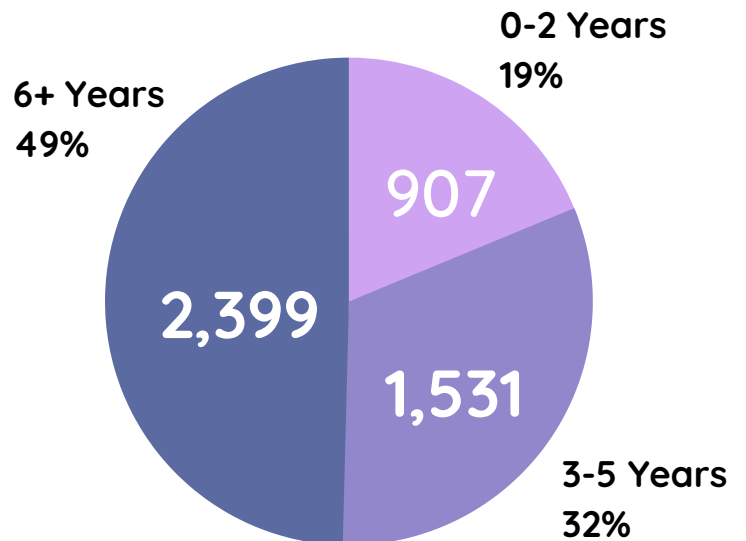




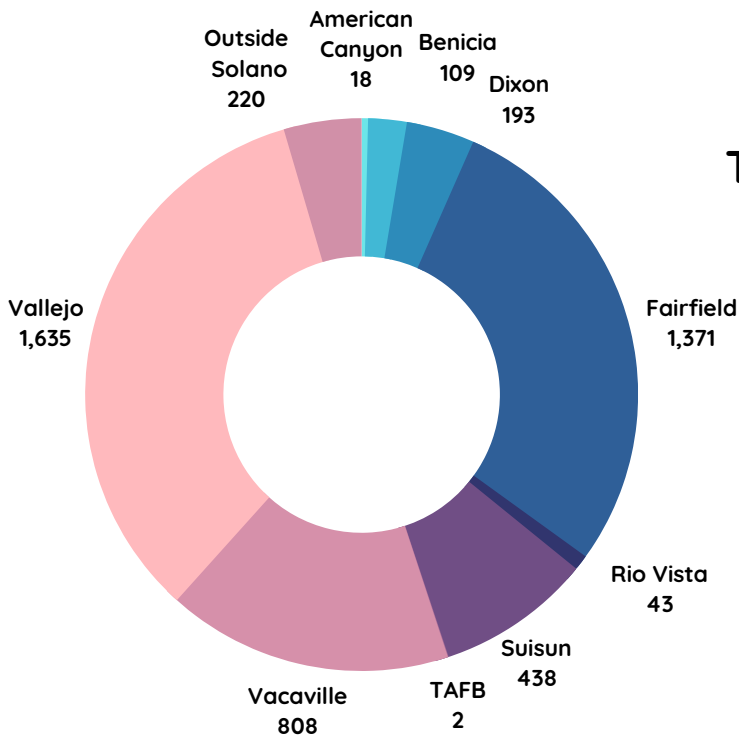
SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE PROGRAM

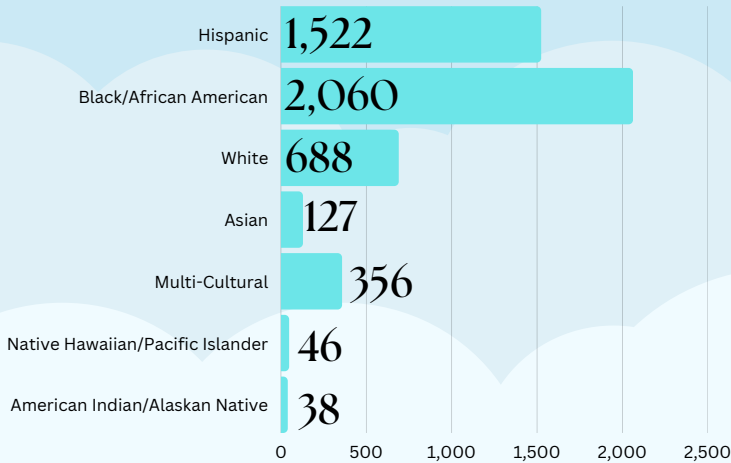

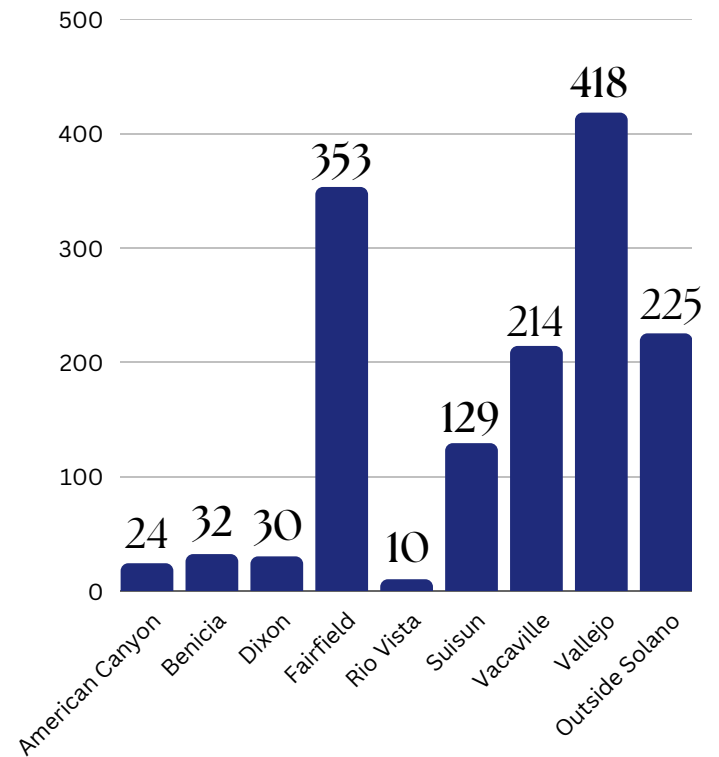
SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE PROGRAM

Since then, all new waiting list applicants are invited to apply for services within 30 days.

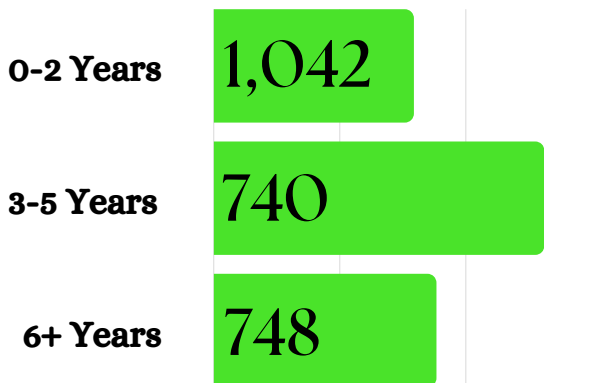
We continue to enroll new families from the waiting list daily.



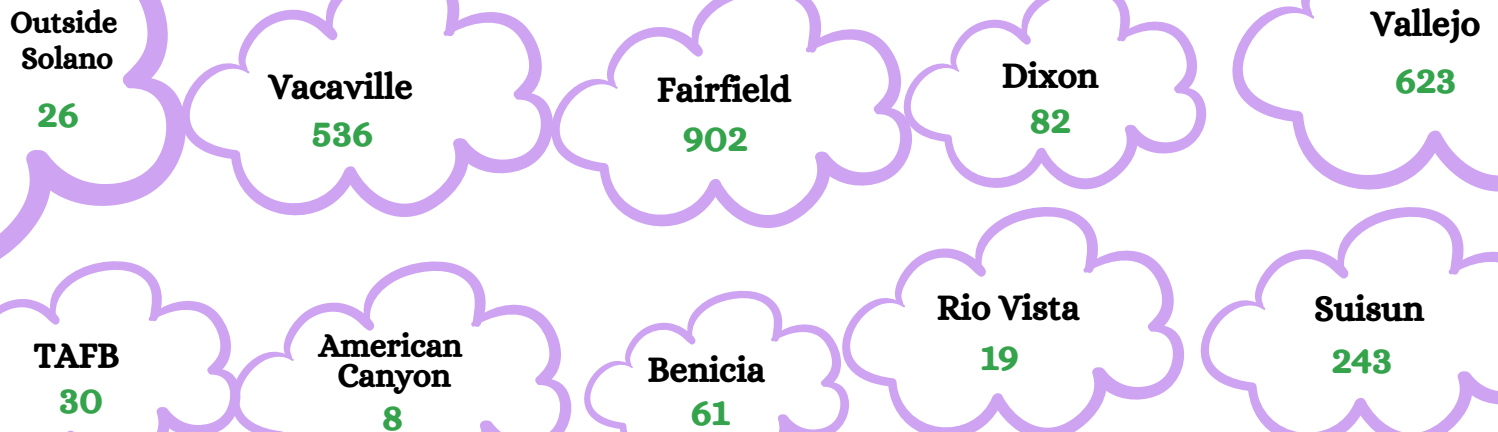

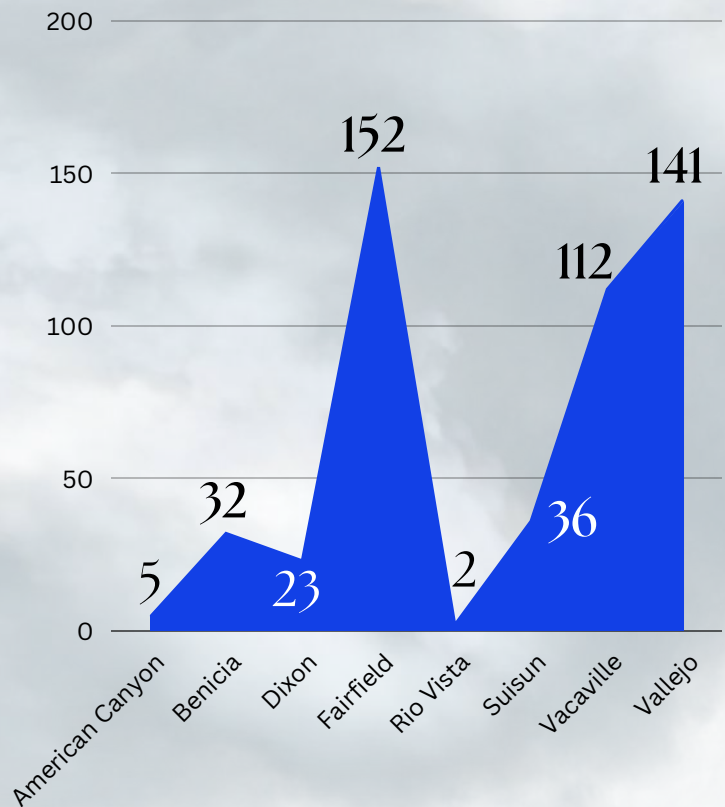

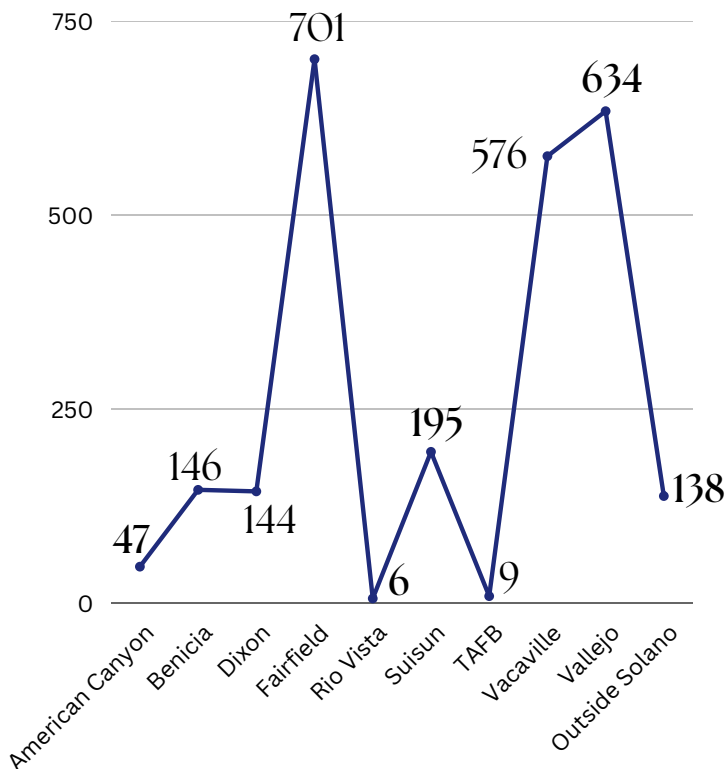

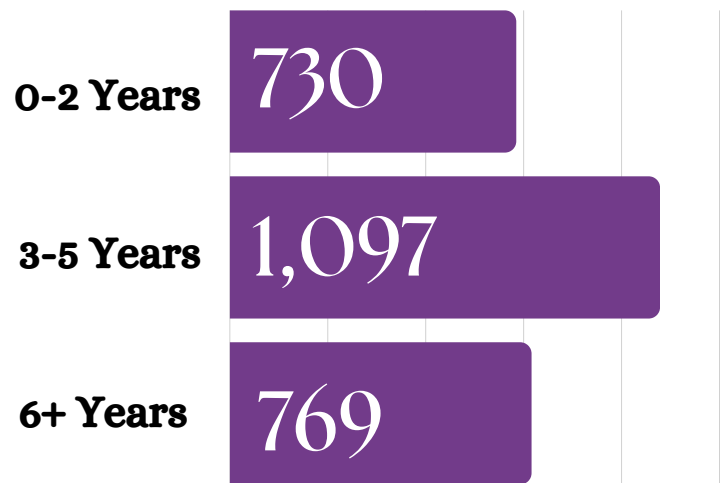


CHILD & ADULT CARE FOOD PROGRAM(CACFP)

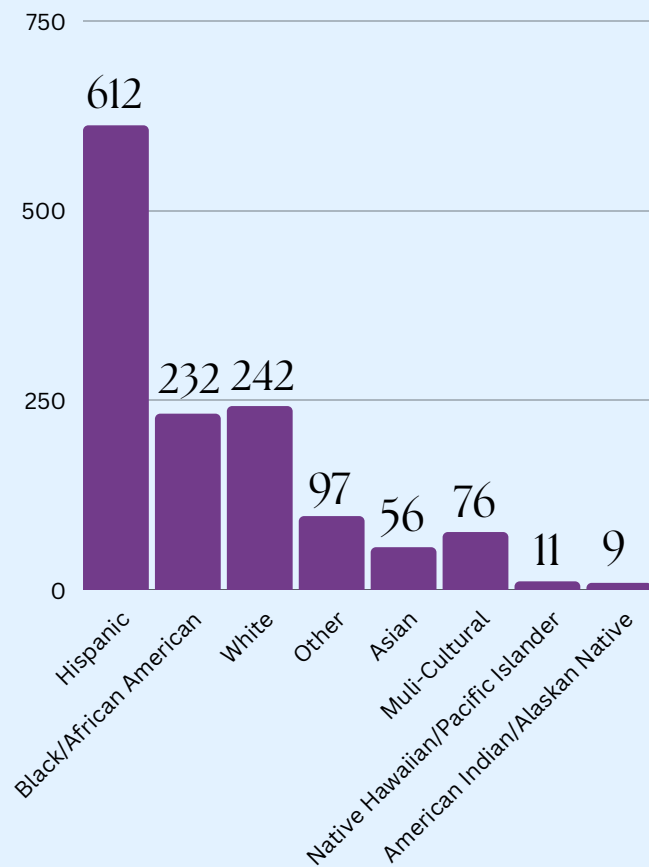

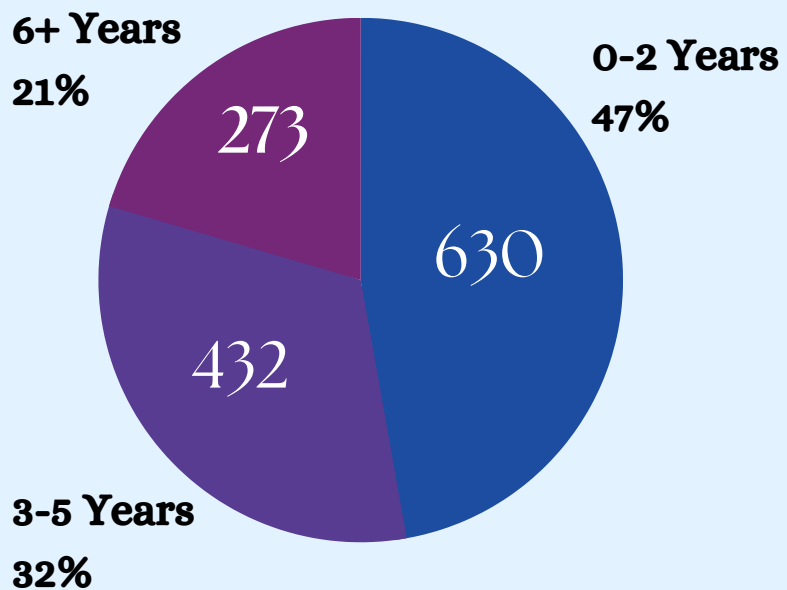
