

Children Served by Race/Ethnicity:









Children Served by City:







## SUBSIDIZED CHILD CARE PROGRAM










In October 2022, for the first time in SFCS history, all families on our waiting list were invited to apply for subsidized child care services, thanks to the additional funding we received.

Since then, all new waiting list applicants are invited to apply for services within 30 days.








Children Served by Race & Ethnicity:


