Course Renovations

This week has certainly thrown us a few curve balls with Mother Nature giving all she had, however, we managed to get the coring done together with the scheduled sand-slitting on several fairways.

The boys have worked long hours (nearly 600) over the past 4 days and have done a great job.

All greens have had the following applications;

- Hollow-cored with 19mm tines to a depth of 4 inches
- Verti-drained with 12mm solid tines to a depth of 8 inches
- Air injected to a depth of 12 inches
- On average 5.5 tons of sand applied per green
- All sand was broomed, swept and levelled
- Fertiliser applied

In all, we applied 120 tons of sand, 1.2 tons of calcium, 600kg of magnesium, 500kg of potassium to the greens.

With each day, the sand will dry and disperse over the greens surface to allow us to perform sand top-ups where required with more brooming to occur next week.

We hope to be able to apply the first cut to greens Wednesday or Thursday next week.

Fairways 3, 5, 6, 7, 8, 10, 15, 16 and 18 have had portions of their fairways sand-slitted to aid in draining water from the fairway to the drainage points.

This task proved more difficult than first thought as contractors found the going very tough with sub surface profiles in some areas being quite hard which in turn did not give as smooth a finish as hoped.

The boys spent considerable time flattening out ruts and raised turf to smooth out the surface as best we could. You will see great improvement with growth over the next two weeks on the fairways.

In total over 250 tons of sand was used on the fairways.

Tees have been air injected, and tees and fairways fertilised for the spring growth period around the corner.


